


Approved.

The Vice Governor presented a letter dated October 25th, from the Chairman of the Board of Directors of the Federal Reserve Bank of Chicago, written in response to the Board's letter of October 23rd, regarding the application filed with the Board by Mr. Murray Macleod, for permission to serve at the same time as director and officer of the Portage Park National Bank of Chicago, the Irving Park National Bank of Chicago, and the Albany Park National Bank of Chicago; also, applications filed with the Board by Messrs. Charles O. Loucks, Leroy F. Washburn, Oliver L. Watson, John J. Walsh, and W. D. Smyser, for permission to serve at the same time as officer and Director of the Portage Park National Bank of Chicago, and of the Irving Park National Bank, also of Chicago.

It was voted to approve the applications of the above named parties subject to ratification of the Committee's action at the next meeting of the Board.
