Telegram to Mr. Sargent, Secretary of the Federal Reserve Bank of San Francisco, stating that the Board approves the establishment Without change by the bank today of the rates of discount and purchase in its existing schedule.

Letter to Mr. Young, Vice President of the Federal Reserve Bank of Chicago, reading as follows:

"In accordance with the request contained in your letter of June 17, the Board approves the designation of Charles Scanlon as an assistant examiner for the Federal Reserve Bank of Chicago in order that he may be available to lend temporary assistance to your regular examiners when needed. It is understood, of course, that Mr. Scanlon will not be transferred permanently to examining work without the Board's approval."

Approved unanimously.

Telegram to Mr. Henry G. Chalkley, Jr., Lake Charles, Louisiana, reading as follows:

"Board of Governors has appointed you director of New Orleans branch of Federal Reserve Bank of Atlanta for unexpired portion of term ending December 31, 1939. Please wire formal acceptance collect."
