The minutes of the meeting of the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System held on July 18, 1944, were approved unani-mously.

Thorne be appointed as a charwoman in the Secretary's Office on a temporary basis for a period of not to exceed 60 days, with basic salary at the rate of \$1,200 per annum, effective as of the date upon which she enters upon the performance of her duties after having passed satisfactorily the usual physical examination, with the understanding (1) that if anything derogatory develops in the investigation of her references her services may be terminated immediately and (2) that she will not become a member of the retirement system during her temporary appointment.

Memorandum addressed to the Personnel Committee by Mr. Leonard, Director of the Division of Personnel Administration, under date of July 17, 1944, recommending, for the reasons stated in the memorandum, that approval be given to the payment of bills in the amount of \$35 for the physical examination of Ruth Jarvis, maid in the Division, which was made by Dr. Barr, the Board's examining physician, at Mr. Leonard's request.
