Racz be reappointed as a Clerk in that Division, on a permanent basis, with salary at the rate of \$1,980 per annum, effective as of the date upon which she enters upon the performance of her duties after having passed the usual physical examination. The memorandum also stated that Mrs. Racz would again become a member of the Federal Reserve retirement system.

The memorandum recommended that the budget proposed by the New York Bank be approved as submitted.

Telegram to Mr. Dawes, Vice President of the Federal Reserve Bank of Chicago, reading as follows:

"Re your letter May 14 concerning inquiry of First National Bank of Chicago, our opinion is that loan is like many others which we have uniformly held to be in violation of Regulation U. Possibility of eventual amendment to provide for this type of case should not be ruled out although be against the likelihood of such action in time for bank to make this particular loan."
