Minutes of the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System on Tuesday, February 17, 1959. The Board met in the Special Library at 10:00 a.m.

Meeting with Federal Advisory Council. This meeting was called for the purpose of considering certain questions of procedure in connection with the meeting of the Board and the Federal Advisory Council to be held at 10:30 a.m.

On February 5, 1959, the Board had tentatively decided to raise informally with the Council the question whether the procedure for preparing the agenda for Board-Council meetings might be improved. With this in mind, Mr. Sherman had distributed to the Board under yesterday's date a memorandum to which was attached a statement with respect to meetings of the Council and the Board made by Chairman Eccles on behalf of the Board at the joint meeting on November 6, 1946, along with a pertinent excerpt from the Council's response dated December 3, 1946. These attachments reflected the considerations that resulted in the procedures currently followed, and a review of

them had led Chairman Martin to feel that it would be desirable for the Board to consider further the advisability of raising the subject of agenda procedure at this time.

Following comments on this matter by Chairman Martin, unanimous agreement was expressed with his suggestion that the subject not be raised with the Council today.

Further discussion concerned the two topics that had been placed on the agenda for today's joint meeting at the request of the Federal Advisory Council; namely, the desirability of including in proposed legislation on reserve requirements a provision eliminating the central reserve city classification and the suggested change in check collection time schedules of the Federal Reserve Banks to increase the maximum deferment from two days to three days.

At the conclusion of the discussion, it was <u>agreed</u> that comments on the two topics would be made along the lines set forth in the minutes of the meeting of the Board and the Council.

The meeting then adjourned.
