

I give below a memorandum of the action taken at Board meeting yesterday on above subject:

"Letter dated December 9th from the Federal Reserve Agent at St. Louis, requesting that he be advised as to whether or not the newly created County of Humphreys, Miss., would be assigned to the Sixth or Eighth Federal Reserve District. The Secretary reported that there are no member banks located in the newly created county.

On motion duly seconded, it was voted that whatever member banks may hereafter be located in the County of Humphreys, Miss., be made members of the Federal Reserve Bank of St. Louis."

I understand there is a prescribed form to be gone through in a case of this kind, and I would appreciate it very much if you will let me have a formal minute to cover this point in the proper manner.

Kumphun aran The Federal Reserve Board, on December 12, voted to assign to the Eighth Federal Reserve District the new county of Humphreys in the State of Mississippi, comprising territory formerly included partially in each of Sharkey, Yazoo, Washington, Sunflower and Holmes Counties; and that notwithstanding the changes in the boundary lines, the determination of the Reserve Bank Organization Committee, which defined the Sixth Federal Reserve District as including among other things "all that part of Mississippi located south of the northern boundary of the following counties: Issaquena, Sharkey, Yazoo, Kemper, Madison, Deake, and Neshoba", should apply to all that part of Mississippi located south of the northern boundaries of the counties specified above, as defined after the creation of the new county of Humphreys.

Having been advised of the creation of the new County of Humphreys in the State of Mississippi, comprising territory formerly included partially in each of Sharkey, Yazoo, Washington, Sunflower and Holmes Counties, the Federal Reserve Board on December 12 voted to assign the new county to the Eighth Federal Reserve District.

The Board further defined the boundary of the Sixth Federal Reserve District as the northern boundary of the Counties of Issaquena, Sharkey, Yazoo, Kemper, Madison, Deake, and Neshoba, after the creation of the new County of Humphreys.

Due to the creation of a new county in the State of Mississippi, known as Humphreys County, which is compresed of portions of the counties of Washington, Sunflower and Holmes in the 8th Federal Reserve District and Sharkey and Yazoo in the 6th Federal Reserve Districts, the Federal Reserve Board under date of December 12,1919 ordered that the newly created county of Humphreys should be assigned to the 8th Federal Reserve (or St. Louis) District.

The boundary of the 8th Federal Reserve District in the State of Mississippi is, therefore, the southern boundary of the following counties: Washington, Humphreys, Holmes, Attala, Winston and Noxumbee.

ORDER DEFINING THE BOUNDARY LINE RETWEEN THE SIXTH AND RIGHTH PEDERAL RESERVE DIS-TRICTS.

Organization Committee made April 2, 1914, in accordance with the terms of Section 2 of the Federal Reserve Act, it was determined that the Sixth Federal Reserve District shall include "the States of Alabama, Georgia, and Florida; all that part of Tennesses located east of the Western boundary of the following counties; Stewart, Houston, Wayne, Humphreys, and Perry; all that part of Mississippi located south of the porthern boundary of the following counties: Issaquena, Sharkey, Tasoo, Kespar, Madison, Leske, and Nashaba; and all of the south - eastern part of Louisiana located east of the western boundary of the following parishes: Points Coupes, Therville, Assumption and Terrebonne, with the city of Atlanta, Ga., as the location of the Federal Reserve bank"; and

WHEREAS it was further determined that the Eighth Federal Reserve District shall include "the State of Arkansas; all that part of Missouri located east of the western boundary of the following counties; Harrison, Daviess, Caldwell, Ray, Lafayette, Johnson, Henry, St. Clair,

Cedar, Dade, Lawrence, and Barry; all that part of Illinois not included in district No. 7; all that part of Indiana not included in district No. 7; all that part of Kentucky not included in district No. 4; all that part of Tennesses not included in district No. 6; and all that part of Mississippi not included in district No. 6, with the city of St. Louis, No., as the location of the Federal Reserve banks; and

WHEREAS the Federal Reserve Board has been advised that certain parts of the northern boundaries of Sharkey and Yazoo Counties, Mississippi, which have heretofore formed part of the boundary line between the Sixth and Eighth Districts, have been moved further south in order to permit of the organization of a new county named "Humphreys" which new county comprises territory formerly included partially in each of Sharkey, Yasoo, Washington, Sunflower and Holmes Counties; and

WHEREAS the Federal Reserve Board is authorized under the torms of Section 2 of the Federal Reserve Act from time to time to readjust the Districts created by the Reserve Bank Organization Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

- Bank Organization Committee which defines the Sixth Federal Reserve District as to include among other things, "all that part of Mississippi located south of the northern boundary of the following counties: Issaquena, Sharkey, Yasoo, Kemper, Madison, Leake, and Meshoba", shall and is hereby unde to apply to all that part of Mississippi located south of the northern boundary of the counties specified as defined after the creation of the county of Humphreys, so that the Eighth Federal Reserve District as determined by the Reserve Bank Organization Committee shall necessarily by its terms include all of the newly created county of Humphreys.
- (II) That the Federal Reserve Banks of St. Louis and Atlanta be notified of the fact that because of the change in the northern boundary of the counties of Sharkey and Yasoo, the decision of the Reserve Bank Organisation Committee, together with this order of the Federal Reserve Board, operates so as to place the newly created county of Homphreys in the Eighth Federal Reserve District.
- (III) That a copy of this order be filed with the Comp-

troller of the Currency to be filed with the certificate of the Reserve Bank Organization Committee.


Herewith I send you the latest Rand-McNally map of Mississippi. This shows a new county by the name of "Humphreys", which appears to be made up of parts of the following five counties:


Holmes, Sunflower, and Washington in the Eighth Federal Reserve District, and Sharkey and Yazoo in the Sixth Federal Reserve District.
