Whereas, It has come to my attention that there is the possibility of serious unrest among the people of this community, brought about, generally, by a series of situations affecting the financial institutions in other of the cities of our group, and

Whereas, It has further come to my attention, that the Mayors of both Moline and East Moline have issued similar proclamations, and

Whereas, We, of Rook Island, must preserve the stability of our city's financial and business institutions, and

whereas, I feel it my duty as Mayor of the City of Rock Island, to take extraordinary action to protect the banks of our city, as well as the individual citisenry by abatement of the spirit of unrest and apprehension, that might possibly injure the existing finencial houses of the city, and thus bring complete economic chaos to us all, and now,

Therefore, I, Chester Thompson, under the authority vested in me as Mayor of the City of Rock Island, Illinois, do hereby declare a legal holiday throughout the said city of Rock Island, to begin on this date, and continue for a period of fourteen (14) days, during which time the business conducted in the city shall be suspended, except as is generally conducted on other legal holidays, and that these days shall be used by our business interests and citizens in bringing about a better understanding of each other, and each other's problems, so that at the end of this period we may all have a greater confidence in our institutions and in our community.

Given under my hand and the seal of the City of Rock Island, Illinois, this 16th day of January, A. D. 1933.

Bank Moratorium in Michigan extended effective today under the modified terms proclaimed by Governor William A. Comstock, which provide among other limitations that payments to depositors in either commercial or savings departments, shall be limited in amounts in the proportion the total individual deposit bears to the cash on hand, reserve in banks and United States bonds in each such department. Banking institutions may take new deposits, but such will be treated as trust deposits and there shall be opened in each such institution a trust deposit department.

Such deposits shall be payable on demand without interest and held solely for repayment of such depositors. We understand it is discretionary with individual banks whether they reopen under provisions or continue holiday.



As requested in your B 869 of January 19, we are enclosing lists of banks (I) which, without actually closing, obtained depositors waiver agreements or which restricted deposit withdrawals, and (2) which closed during 1932 under a special holiday declared by civil authorities.

The lists contain all the information which we have on these points. The information, as you know, is scattering in nature, and subject to very definite limitations as to completeness and accuracy. The list of banks closed under civil holidays is based almost entirely on information received by our check department. In many cases checks are returned to us marked "Bank on holiday" with no indication as to whether the bank so closed is on a holiday declared by civil authority or by in-/ dividual or collective action of the banks in the community or possibly the county. In many cases we have definite information, derived from our credit department, press notices, random comments on reports of representatives of our bank relations department, to the effect that these holidays are of "civil" origin. In the case of the State of Iowa we have been in touch with the State Banking Department in the hope that the Commissioner might have authentic and reliable information which would enable us to check our own findings, but that official has even less information than we have. In view of curinability to procure complete information, we have been forced to assume that banks on holiday are so on civil authority, but we cannot guarantee that this list does not contain banks which in the Board's definition might be classed as "suspensions," and there exists no effective and reliable channel through which we can procure facts to differentiate in all cases with any certainty between holidays declared on civil authority and those declared individually or collectively by the banks themselves.

On the form, "Banks closed during 1932 under a special holiday declared by civil authorities," the heading "Duration of holiday" has been construed to mean the period for which declared, as it seemed to us that another construction would mean duplication of the data entered under the heading "Date bank closed" and "Date bank resumed operations."



On the form, "Banks which during 1932, without actually closing, obtained depositors' waiver agreements, or which restricted deposit withdrawals," the dates requested have given us some difficulty. Dates given under the heading, "Obtained depositors' waiver agreements," are approximate, and represent in most cases the time at which these agreements were first sought. We have no way of knowing on what dates these agreements were signed and made effective with individual depositors. Under the other two headings, concerned with restrictions of deposit withdrawals, in almost all cases the restrictions invoked dated from a certain specified day "until further notice." We have, therefore, given the originating dates followed by a dash and a question mark to indicate that we do not know the period during which effective. In a number of cases, not even the originating date was given; we were given to understand, merely, that some restriction was at some time invoked—these are marked with a question.

Dear Mr. Smead:

In an earlier letter to you today we included as one of the banks taken over by the Iowa Banking Department, in accordance with Senate File 111, 45th General Assembly, the Atlantic State Bank, Atlantic. This bank succeeds the Atlantic National Bank which closed for one day on a holiday plan, pending its conversion into a state bank, reopening the following day as a state bank under the management of the state banking department. As far as we have learned to date, this holiday was not declared by civil authority. As you know, withdrawals of deposits from banks operating under this plan are restricted. However, we are informed that the Atlantic bank is honoring all drafts bearing dates previous We are, therefore, classifying its change of status as a conversion of national bank to state bank, and not including the national bank among our bank suspensions. We hope this solution will be agreeable to you.

There will probably be more of these "conversions," for the purpose of taking advantage of the Iowa law, and we shall, therefore, greatly appreciate your early advice as to their classification.







Pursuant to your request, there is attached a list of member banks reported operating on some form of moratoria, or in some manner restricting withdrawal of deposits. In a few cases it is not definite under what plan bank is operating. Information concerning such institutions was taken from press reports.

There is also attached depositors' agreement which has been approved by the State Banking Department and which is in common usage in the State of Michigan among state banks. Several of the national banks have signed a similar agreement with depositors.

In a few cases, with special reference to Illinois, the board of directors has passed a resolution without obtaining agreement from depositors stating that they will not honor withdrawals except in emergency cases. A similar resolution has been adopted by several county clearing house associations throughout the States of Illinois and Indiana.

We shall be pleased to give you any additional information regarding these several form of moratoria, if you so desire.

In accordance with a new law in Iowa, Senate File No. 111-45th General Assembly, copy of which is enclosed for your convenience, under the terms of which Iowa banks may be taken under the management and operation of the State Banking Department for a period not to exceed one year, ordinarily, the following banks are reported under the management of the Iowa Banking Department:

Under the provisions of this law, as you will note, these banks may, while under the supervision of the banking department, accept new deposits which must be segregated from the old, as must any assets acquired on account of such deposits.

We are not, therefore, for the time being at least, including these banks in our bank suspension records, but are keeping a separate record of them. We should like to learn from you whether or not it will be your policy to regard these as suspensions.

Gentlemen:

Referring to my wire of even date, while our information is not entirely definite in all these particulars, we are advised that at a meeting held yesterday and last night of Group eight of the Iowa Bankers Association, it was determined that all of the banks in the group would go on a holiday, effective today. This group includes Cedar, Clinton, Jackson, Jones, Muscatine, and Scott counties in Iowa. According to our records, there are fifty-one banks in these counties, of which forty-three are non-members. The Davenport Bank & Trust Company advised us a day or two ago that they would not join in such a moratorium.

A conference was held in Des Moines yesterday between various committees of the Iowa Bankers Association, which was to be attended by the Governor and Lieutenant-Governor of the State. We understand that this conference was called by reason of the menace to the whole banking structure in the state, and that much time was devoted to the consideration of measures to meet an emergency which it was expected might arise.

We are advised that this morning a bill is being introduced in the Iowa Legislature to give the Superintendent of Banks complete authority to declare holidays, make adjustments and reorganizations. Without having as yet a copy of this bill, we are given to understand in a general way that his authority would include segregation of certain assets of banks into trust funds, thereby reducing the net deposit liability drastically, and, unless we are misinformed, he would have the authority to do this without the consent of the depositors.

It appears that the Iowa bankers are concerned that the long pending bank troubles may be coming to a head, consequent upon the Davemport and Rock Island situations and the spread of moratoriums, and are endeavoring to be prepared to meet an emergency situation, in a view that otherwise there may be a wholesale closing of banks throughout the state.

For your information I am enclosing herewith a copy of the proclamation

Whereas, It has further come to my attention, that the Mayors of both Moline and East Moline have issued similar proclamations, and

Whereas, We, of Rook Island, must preserve the stability of our city's financial and business institutions, and

whereas, I feel it my duty as Mayor of the City of Rock Island, to take extraordinary action to protect the banks of our city, as well as the individual citizenry by abatement of the spirit of unrest and apprehension, that might possibly injure the existing financial houses of the city, and thus bring complete economic chaos to us all, and now,

Therefore, I, Chester Thompson, under the authority vested in me as Mayor of the City of Rock Island, Illinois, do hereby deckare a legal holiday throughout the said city of Rock Island, to begin on this date, and continue for a period of fourteen (14) days, during which time the business conducted in the city shall be suspended, except as is generally conducted on other legal holidays, and that these days shall be used by our business interests and citizens in bringing about a better understanding of each other, and each other's problems, so that at the end of this period we may all have a greater confidence in our institutions and in our community.

For your confidential information, I wish to advise you that the Bank of Sturgeon Bay, which is a member bank of the Federal Reserve System, adopted the state's stabilization program and reopened for business on November 10th after a legal holiday declared by the Mayor of Sturgeon Bay extending from November 4th through Wednesday, November 9th. An assessment of 100% was declared by the directors and subscriptions for this amount were signed prior to the opening of the bank November 10th. The depositors were asked to waive 40% of their deposits and accept certificates of deposit for 60% in the reorganized bank. The 40% is represented by a trust fund created cut of the charged-off assets.

For the present, there has been no change in the management and I do not know that any change is being contemplated.

If there is any further information you desire, I will be pleased to hear from you.


Subject: Special Legislation in Michigan providing for banks to operate under custodians

2--8495

An act passed at a special session of the 1932 Michigan State Legislature provides for the reopening of banks in receivership, and the operation of banks not having closed, under a plan known as "custodianship," summarized briefly as follows:

- 1. Not-less than 85 per cent of the depositors must join in the plan.

 (Deposits of the dissenting depositors are placed in charge of a receiver for liquidation.)
- 2. A committee of not to exceed 12 depositors is selected to represent the depositors in carrying the plan into effect.
- 3. The court having jurisdiction appoints a custodian to operate the bank under the plan which may include (a) assessments to stockholders, (b) waivers from depositors, and (c) restriction placed on withdrawal of deposits.
- 4. Pending the court's appointment of a custodian the Bank Commissioner takes charge of the bank.



STATE OF MICHIGAN 56TH LEGISLATURE SPECIAL SESSION OF 1932

HOUSE ENROLLED ACT No. 8

An act to amend act number sixty-six of the public acts of the state of Michigan for the year nineteen hundred twenty-nine, entitled "An act to revise and codify the laws authorizing the business of banking and to establish a banking department for the supervision and regulation of such business, and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act", as amended, being in chapter two hundred thirty-one and sections eleven thousand eight hundred ninety-eight to eleven thousand nine hundred seventy, inclusive, of the compiled laws of nineteen hundred twenty-nine, by adding thereto three new sections to stand as sections sixty-five-a, sixty-five-b and sixty-five-c thereof.

The People of the State of Michigan enact:

Section 1. Act number sixty-six of the public acts of the state of Michigan for the year nineteen hundred twenty-nine, entitled "An act to revise and codify the laws authorizing the business of banking and to establish a banking department for the supervision and regulation of such business, and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act", as amended, being in chapter two hundred thirty-one and sections eleven thousand eight hundred ninety-eight to eleven thousand nine hundred seventy, inclusive, of the compiled laws of nineteen hundred twenty-nine, is hereby amended by adding thereto three new sections to stand as sections sixty-five-a, sixty-five-b and sixty-five-c thereof, said added sections to read as follows:

Section 65a. If any bank organized hereunder shall have been heretofore or shall hereafter be closed by action of the state banking commissioner or the board of directors and a receiver, either temporary or permanent, be appointed under the provisions of this act, the

depositors thereof representing not less than eighty-five per cent of the deposit liability, by and with the approval and consent of the state banking commissioner, may join in a plan for the reopening or reorganization of said closed bank, or the establishing of a new bank, and may select a committee of not to exceed twelve depositors to represent them for the purpose of carrying such plan into effect. Upon receiving the approval of the plan by the state banking commissioner, said committee or the state banking commissioner may petition the court in which such receivership is pending, setting forth the details of the plan which has been agreed upon and requesting the court to set a day for hearing thereon, and the court shall thereupon make an order fixing a day for the hearing of said petition, notice of which shall be given to the depositors in such bank by publication once in each week for not less than two successive weeks immediately preceding the date of hearing in some newspaper printed in the county where such application is pending, or in such other newspaper, having a general circulation in the county, as the said court may direct and by posting a copy of said notice upon the front door of such bank. The court may adjourn such hearing from time to time, and no further notice shall be required. At the date of hearing, or any adjournment thereof, the court shall take testimony, and if it appears that it is for the best interests of the depositors that said plan be approved, may make an order approving the same and fixing the terms and conditions upon which the receivership may be terminated. In case the plan shall provide for an assessment upon the stockholders of said bank and or the court shall deem an assessment necessary to satisfy the debts of such bank, the said court shall include in its order provisions for an assessment, which shall not exceed the liability of such stockholders for assessments under the provisions of this act, and, thereupon, the receiver shall forthwith proceed to levy and collect such assessment in such manner as the court shall direct. In the event any of the depositors of such bank files written objections to the approval of such plan and refuses to consent thereto, the court at such hearing may direct the receiver to set aside assets of each class of such receivership, in such amounts and character as the court shall find to be just and equitable, and upon such terms as may be just and equitable, shall continue the receivership as to such assets and such depositors, and direct the receiver to turn over the remainder of the assets of such bank in his hands to such new or reorganized bank when directed so to do by the state banking commissioner, and discharge such receiver fom further liability in relation thereto.

Section 65b. The depositors of any bank organized hereunder representing not less than eighty-five per cent of the deposit liability of such bank, by and with the approval and consent of the state banking commissioner, may join in a plan restricting the withdrawal of deposits or providing for the reorganization of such bank or the establishing of a new bank and may select a committee of not to exceed twelve depositors to represent them for the purpose of carrying such plan into effect. If the state banking commissioner shall have knowledge that such a plan of reorganization is in process, and if any or all of the conditions set forth in section sixty-two of this act, authorizing the application for the appointment of a receiver, exist, the state banking commissioner shall communicate such facts to the attorney general, and, with his concurrence, application may be made by the attorney general, in behalf of the commissioner, to a court of v competent jurisdiction for the appointment of a custodian of such bank. Upon presentation of said application to said court, and upon its being made satisfied that any or all of the conditions set forth in section sixty-two of this act, authorizing the appointment of a receiver, exist, and that such a reorganization plan is in process, the said court shall immediately appoint the banking commissioner, his deputy, or one of the banking examiners in the banking department, or some other competent person who shall have the recommendation of the banking commissioner, as custodian and shall determine his bond and prescribe his duties, and may make such further order as shall seem proper. The amount of compensation to be paid to such custodian and the payment thereof shall be in accordance with laws governing the compensation of receivers of banks. The commissioner, pending such action, if it shall be necessary, may forthwith take possession of the books, records and assets of every description of such bank, and hold same, and said books, records and assets shall not be subject to any levies and attachments. The custodian, if any

be appointed, shall, under the direction of the court, take possession of the books, records, and assets of every description, of such bank, collect all debts, dues and claims belonging to it. Upon receiving the approval of such plan by not less than eighty-five per cent of the deposit liability of said bank, the state banking commissioner, in case application has been made for the appointment of a custodian as aforesaid, may petition said court, and, in case application for the appointment of a custodian has not been made as aforesaid, shall communicate such fact to the attorney general, and, with his concurrence, application may be made by the attorney general, in behalf of the commissioner, to a court of competent jurisdiction, said petition or application to set forth the details of the plan which has been agreed upon and shall request the court to set a day for a hearing thereon, and the court shall thereupon make an order fixing a day for the hearing of said petition or application, notice of which said hearing shall be given to the depositors of such bank by a notice published once each week for not less than two successive weeks immediately preceding the date of hearing in some newspaper printed in the county where such petition or application is pending, or in such other newspaper, having a general circulation in the county, as the said court may direct, and by posting a copy of said notice upon the front door of such bank. The court may adjourn such hearing from time to time, and no further notice shall be required. At the time of the hearing, or any adjournment thereof, the court shall take testimony covering the facts alleged in the petition or application as filed and, if it appears that it is for the best interests of the depositors that said plan be approved, may make an order approving the same. In case the plan shall provide for an assessment upon the stockholders of said bank and or the court shall deem an assessment necessary to satisfy the debts of such bank, the said court shall include in its order provisions for an assessment, which shall not exceed the liability of such stockholders for assessments under the provisions of this act, and, thereupon, the receiver shall forthwith proceed to levy and collect such assessment in such manner as the court shall direct. If a custodian has not been appointed as hereinbefore provided, the state banking commissioner may also ask in such application for the appointment of a custodian to take charge of the assets of said bank and conserve the same. The said court shall thereupon appoint the banking commissioner, his deputy or one of the banking examiners in the banking department, or some other competent person who shall have the recommendation of the banking commissioner, as custodian and shall determine his bond and prescribe his duties, and may make such further order as shall seem proper. The amount of compensation to be paid to such custodian and the payment thereof shall be in accordance with laws governing the compensation of receivers of banks. The commissioner, pending such action, if it shall be necessary, may forthwith take possession of the books, records and assets of every description of such bank, and hold same, and said books, records and assets shall not be subject to any levies and attachments. The custodian, if any be appointed, shall, under the direction of the court, take possession of the books, records, and assets of every description, of such bank, collect all debts, dues and claims belonging to it. In the event any of the depositors of such bank files written objection to the approval of such plan and refuses to consent thereto, the court at such hearing may order set aside assets of each class of such bank, in such amounts and character as the court shall find to be just and equitable, which such assets so set aside shall be continued in the hands of the custodian appointed as hereinbefore provided, who. on the petition of the state banking commissioner, shall be appointed by the court as receiver of the assets so set aside, for the purpose of liquidating the same and payment of the claims of such objectors from the proceeds thereof, and shall duly qualify as such, and said court, upon such terms as may be just and equitable, shall authorize such receiver to liquidate any of such assets so set aside, for the purpose of discharging the liability of the bank toward such objectors, and said court shall further order that the remaining assets of such bank shall be discharged of the liability of the bank toward any such objectors.

Section 65c. If in any bank referred to in the preceding sections, there shall be deposits of public money belonging to the state of Michigan or any political subdivision thereof, it shall be lawful for the state treasurer by and with the consent of the state administrative board if such deposit belongs to the state, and the treasurer of any

political subdivision thereof by and with the consent of the governing body of such political subdivision, to which any such deposit may belong, to join with other depositors of such bank in a plan for the reopening or reorganizing thereof or the establishment of a new bank, and or the restricting of the withdrawal of deposits, as hereinbefore provided, and for such purpose said respective treasurer may bind said state or political subdivision thereof as the case may be after being duly authorized so to do as above provided, to limit withdrawals from such deposit over a period of time and in accordance with such plan as may have been agreed to by the other depositors of the said bank. The term "governing body" as herein used shall be deemed to be the board of supervisors of a county, the council, common council, commission or board of trustees of a city or village, the township board of a township, or the board of education or district board of a school district.

This act is ordered to take immediate effect.

Subject bank, as previously reported to you, closed for reorganization on November 7. They have secured waivers of 40 per cent from depositors, and the balance, or 60 per cent, is restricted over a period of months.

There is enclosed copy of letter received from the bank stating that all bonds are now carried at market value, and that all doubtful and estimated losses in loans, in addition to the large workume of slow loans, have been removed.

On basis of last report, 40 per cent waiver would eliminate approximately \$1,019,000. Classification of assets based on report of January 25, 1932, is slow \$557,000, doubtful \$172,000, estimated losses \$177,600. This does not include, however, depreciation in current issues of \$472,000.

This correction will place the bank in at least a semisatisfactory condition. As soon as possible we intend to have our representative make a credit investigation of this institution and shall promptly advise you as to his findings.

There is also enclosed copy of depositors' agreement.

Referring to your wire of today and our subsequent telephone conversation, I am enclosing, herewith, copy of a memorandum which we handed to the Federal Reserve Board Examiners under date of September 26, 1932, regarding the moratorium situation in this district, as far as we had information. You will note that this list includes 179 member banks, and there are also 650 nonmember banks which we are informed are on some kind of a moratorium. The list of the member banks attached also gives a memorandum on the last page of banks which were formerly operating under some form of restriction and which have since closed.

We wish you to understand that we do not certify the correctness of this list, as in many cases it is based on information, particularly with reference to nonmember banks, which we have obtained by accident, through press reports or otherwise; neither is it necessarily accurate because banks are from time to time changing the nature of their moratoria and other banks are going on some form of moratoria without our knowledge. Indeed, I understand that the National Bank Examiners themselves frequently do not know of a bank being on a moratorium until it is examined.

The State Departments as well as the National Department are not officially recognizing these actions excepting in Michigan and Wisconsin, where laws have been passed recognizing certain forms of them. It is obvious, therefore, that we could not expect the State Departments to commit themselves in writing to a recognition of this situation by advising us as to the condition in each one of these banks and the nature of their action. There is no official notice of these moratoria because they are not officially recognized.

These moratoria vary in their nature greatly in different states and in different localities. In Michigan, as I have suggested, there has been a law passed providing for a custodianship during the period of reorganization, and in Wisconsin a law has been passed providing for what they call a "Stabilization Scheme." I have heretofore written the Board about both of these actions and have sent copies of the laws. Beyond this, these moratoria all over the district may consist of refusals to pay by public proclamation (often signed by all the banks in the county or the local clearing houses), temporary public holidays, signed waivers by depositors, refusal to pay time deposits, running http://frase.slouisled.org/

basis say of 5 per cent monthly on commercial deposits, refusals to pay in individual cases without public announcement, payment of only part of a depositor's demands by refusal of the bank to make full payment, and many other forms.

As I advised you over the telephone, we could not hope to get the detailed information you desire from the State Departments, who do not officially recognize these situations and in many cases do not even know about them. We could not expect the 3,460 banks in this district, of which about 75 per cent are nonmembers, to commit themselves by giving us accurate information as to their own action even if we requested it of them.

To get the exact detail which you suggest in each one of these numberous types of moratoria and in each individual case, would seem to necessitate a personal call on every bank in the district, and it is probable that in most cases the banks would be loath to disclose the extent of their action because much of it is technically a violation of the law.

It is of course obvious that a number of banks which are in reasonably good condition have been forced to go on a moratorium by reason of their neighboring banks taking that action, and have done so reluctantly. Curiously, when a bank has gone on a moratorium which has tied up existing deposits over a period of years and, however, which contemplates that any new deposits will be subject to call, the reaction sometimes has been against the neighboring bank which has not gone on a moratorium, in the fear that it would later do so and the deposits thus be tied up there. We have heard of cases like this where a depositor had withdrawn money from a bank which was not on a moratorium and made his deposit in the bank which had gone through the reorganization and whose new deposits were not to be tied up.

We are revising this list from time to time and expect to have another revision about November 15. In the meantime, I understand from our telephone conversation that you would like to have what we have on this matter, and this is about as far as we can go without an immense amount of work which would probably not produce a true picture at that. It is quite likely that we could dig out some more information in the case of the individual member banks if you need it.

I am sure you understand that we want to cooperate in any way we can and if, on receipt of this information, you have anything further to suggest, we shall be glad to consider it. I presume, however, that for practical purposes, the information we enclose will give you what you want substantially as much as the complete details would.
