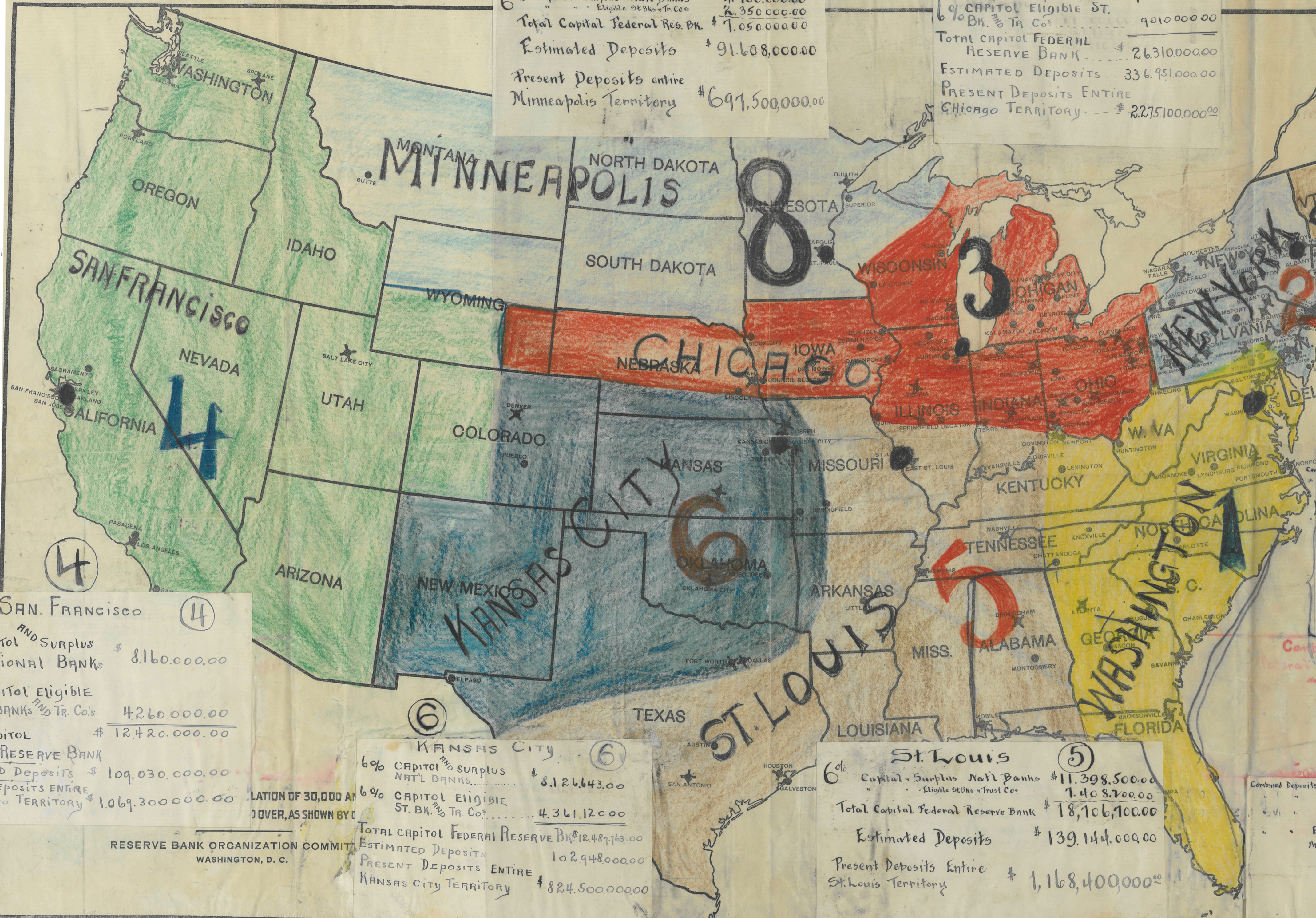

The immensity of this new Banking System viewed as a great unity, staggers the imagination.
 I predict that within twelve months substantially the entire banking power of the United States will be brought together in this gigantic co-operation and co-ordination of America's monetary resources.

I believe that within two years practically all State Banks and Trust Co's, as well as National Banks will enter the System. It will then have a paid up capital of about two hundred million dollars, with a total of consolidated and co-operative resources of twenty billion dollars. Its paid up capital will be greater than the combined capital of the Bank of England, the Bank of France and the Imperial Bank of Germany.

The capital and surplus of the Bank of England is \$87,500,000
 do do Bank of Germany is \$61,500,000
 do do Bank of France is \$41,500,000
 It will represent a gold stock of one billion, four hundred million dollars.
 This is five percent more than the present gold holdings of the three greatest European nations.
 This banking system reinforced by earth's wealthiest nation, will constitute the most powerful factor in the world's finance.
