Dear Mr. Abe:

Referring to our conversation at the Center on September 3 with regard to amount claimed to be due you from Robert Thorsen for 15 days farm labor performed by you and your father, Frank Abe, at the rate of \$5.00 per day, the work in question having been done after the closing of the ranch deal between you and Mr. Thorsen.

In our efforts to be of assistance to you we have interviewed both Mr. Thorsen and Mr. David Gilhooley regarding the matter. Mr. Thorsen claims that he does not owe this account. Mr. Gilhooley states that he agrees with Mr. Thorsen's attitude for the reasons that, first, Mr. Thorsen paid for the labor of a hired hand on the manch for work performed before the property was taken over from you, and second, that farm equipment was not in condition as represented, with particular reference to a cracked motor head, and third, that your father was and is highly pleased with Mr. Thorsen's actions in completing the transaction.

If, after consultation with your father, it is still evident that the above item of \$75.00 is still due you, we would suggest a meeting between you, your father, and Mr. Thorsen.

Regarding the other case involving the amount of \$650.00 acknowledged to be due your father in the deal between Mrs. Chuna and Pierce & Berry and Frank Abe, Attorney Hubert Briggs believes that there is no risk of nonpayment to your father, regardless of the Lowell Berry letter of June 4. Mr. Briggs states that the entire transaction is in your father's name, and that no definite consideration has arisen to complicate the performance of the contract.

However, they are all agreed on the facts and the amounts of money subseribed. We all had a long conference in Mr. Theile's office yesterday afternoon after having spoken to these people singly and in various groups at different times.

1. Tatsuichi Yokoyama, a Japanese citizen who came here the last time in 1920 and the first time in 1903, is married and has 2 children, minors, gave Yamashita \$3,300 in cash to put in this

deal for his 2 children, sisters, Shizuko and Emiko.

2. Masayuki Matsumune, an American citizen born in Calif. in 1916, and Hisaye Matsumune born in Calif. in 1915, who came back from their last trip to Japan in 1932, put in \$1,100.

- 3. Katsuhiro Endo, a citizen, born in Calif. in 1918 who made his last trip to Japan and returned in 1936, had \$1,000 put into this deal for him by his father Kakuso Endo, who is now in custody in No. Dakota.



this car. The registration and ownership certificates show
Engine Number DN 19747 and Serial Number 18-85890; and also a
notation to the effect that the engine has been changed.

This is the automobile which you will recall I discussed with you when I was in Fresno and apparently the Engine Number as actually shown on the automobile is 18-6050, Serial Number the same.

For your information we call your attention to the following comments from the Motor Vehicle Department:

"According to filed records to date 1942 license #8E6370,
Toru Abo, 1433 Kern St., Fresno, registered and legal
owner Ford Coach, engine #DN 19747, 1932. The former
engine number of this car was 1885890, but the change
of engines was made May 15, 1941. Ford cars do not have
serial numbers. We find a Ford Roadster, engine #186050
last registered in 1942 under license # 73T246, Bob Martin,

Dear Mr. Small:

Thank you ever so much for checking with the Vreeland's Studio about my pictures. I received them soon afterwards.

There are many people here in camp who are anxious to have their cooler and other furniture sent up but we have not been able to contact the right people. I was told that you have charge of all the Japanese evacuee property in Imperial Valley. Therefore I am writing to ask how we may have our furniture, which is stored in Japanese M. E. Church in Brawley, sent up.

I have a letter here, which I will enclose, from Mrs. A. Miller of the Miller Apts. in Brawley. She is holding the key to the church but does not have the authority to let the furniture leave the premises.

Your information in regards to this matter would be greatly appreciated. I am especially anxious to have a cooler sent up for it is getting unbearably hot.

We have very funny weather here. It is always hot but on some days we have a strong windstorm which raises so much dust that one cannot see beyond a yard or two. Then there is a rainstorm which floods the place. I have never seen it rain so hard and in such torrents before. The last storm blew the roof off of about 1/5 of the barracks in camp #1. I was told by one of the carpenters that we will have these storms about once a week until the end of August. I really don't mind, in fact I thought it very exciting

After the storm let up we all ran out to salvage the lumber. We use this lumber to fix up the room for it is just like a big barn. We have a hard time getting lumber so we were all glad the storm blew some of the roof off.

Life in camp is very dull but I try to keep occupied. We have movies once a week which isn't too old. We saw the Count of Monte Cristo for the first picture, and I enjoyed it very much, in spite of the fact that I had seen it before. Most of us work in some department or organization in camp. This keeps us quite busy but still I feel as though I was growing stale from lack of interests. It's just like being in hibernation.

I shall not bother you with any more details of camp life. I hope you do not think I meant to complain for I know it is for our own protection that we are in camp.


