On my call at the Turlock Assembly Center today I contacted Mr. Flewelling and Reverend Daito Suzuki about the matter of personal property left in the Buddist Church at 1681 Bush Street. These articles have been placed in the church for the evacues by Mr. Blair of 1815 Sutter Street.

Their problem in this case isn't a problem of watching but of having some one whom they can trust with the key so that articles left in the church can be picked up by Mr. Blair from time to time and forewarded to the evacuees. Mr. David Campi, a special police officer, of 77 Cervantes Street was recommended to them but as they don't have any funds to pay to him I don't imagine that the will be interested.

There are living quarters in the church consisting of a kitchen, bedroom, living room, and a large social hall which they want to offer to some one free of charge if they will keep the key to the main part of the church and release such articles to Mr. Blair as the evacuees order him to foreward to them. Being on the premises they will more or less act as a watchman. Under the circumstances they will have to have some one that they can trust.

The only solution to their problem that I can see is to contact some one through the San Francisco Police Dept. and through them get a recommendation. With rentals in San Francisco hard to obtain It shouldn't be difficult to find some one.

Let me know what further action is taken in the matter.

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

We are informed that the War Relocation Authority is now giving consideration to the matter of forwarding to evacues in War Relocation Projects, the goods which were stored privately by them at the time of their evacuation. The War Relocation Authority is aware of the situation existing in the Watsonville area, and we understand that that agency contemplates sending a representative to the Watsonville area in due course, to look into the matter more particularly.

It is understood that somewhat detailed instructions to the directors of War Relocation Projects are now in the course of preparation and that information on the subject will soon be circulated among the evacues in the relocation projects.

It will be recalled that under Civilian Exclusion Order Number 16, a Civil Control Station was opened April 24, 1942 in the Veterans Memorial Building, Watsonville, California. In the orderly processing of evacuees in your area as well as in all others in Willtary Areas Numbers 1 and 2, heads of families, as they presented themselves at these Control Stations, were handed - in addition to other documents - MCCA Form FRB-2, Personal Property Form, copy of which is enclosed for your information and review. You will note thereon "Instructions To Owner" and, in that section above the space for the signature of the evacues, the clearly set forth terms and conditions, both as to type of property and risk assumed by such evacues. On the reverse side of the Personal Property Form enclosed hersin you will note the inventory schedule providing for the listing of all stored goods. Four copies of these forms were executed by the head of each family prior to evacuation, one being handed to the evacuee prior to his departure. Inasmuch as actual deposit of such property did not, in many cases, actually reach the warehouse until after the evacuee had departed, these inventories were later checked with the property actually placed in storage. Shortly after this checking, receipt forms were sent to all heads of families, in duplicate, one to be signed by the evacues and the other to be returned to our files.

In the event of any discrepancies between the original list filed with us on the WCCA form FRB-2 and the actual goods finally reaching storage, these discrepancies would be carefully set out in the receipt forms referred to above. In this way our files were able to finally disclose not only to the evacuee but to ourselves that the actual stored property as contained in our warehouse reports agreed with that of the evacuee family head.

The extent, therefore, of the interest of this bank in caring for the storage problems of evacuees is clearly evidenced by the completion of these outlined formalities.

In the case of the immediate Watsonville area all heads of families were advised, at the time of processing, that warehouse facilities for the Watsonville area had been provided by this bank at the Elks Association warehouse, Salinas, California. All evacuees at that time, therefore, could either accept the storage facilities of this bank under the conditions contained in WCCA Form FRB-2 Personal Property Form or could decide to privately store such property.

In view of substantial current expenses in adequately guarding warehouses leased by this bank in various outlying areas, it was deemed advisable later to transfer stored goods to larger and more centralized locations, which has been quite generally followed throughout Military Area No. 1.

All property problems relating to evacuees now resident in War Relocation Projects, in which category evacuees from the Watsonville area can properly be grouped, are now under the jurisdiction of the War Relocation Authority, Whitcomb Hotel, San Francisco.

We are enclosing a copy of your letter of inquiry and our reply thereto, to that agency for their consideration. We enclose herein a copy of the communication we have addressed to them with reference to your inquiry.

Gentlemen:

I have been informed that you were custodian of the property belonging to evacuated Japanese. In this city a great many Japanese, if not all, stored their goods in local storage centers such as the gymnasium of our Fapanese Presbyterian Church. In that church it is all arranged by blocks and aisles with the complete inventory so that whipment can be made to their relocation centers.

There has been a lot of misinformation both among the Japanese and among us who are concerned with assisting them and I am writing to you for accurate information.

It has been rumored that goods stored here in this city in other than official centers (in this case is the Elk's Hall Association Warehouse) will not be shipped to relocation centers at government expense. In as much as the Japanese, according to everyone who has been officially and unofficially connected with the evacuation, stored their goods in these local unofficial centers in good faith, expecting them to be forwarded at government expense. I am trying to get to the oottom of the truth. If you can throw any light upon the position occupied by your bank and upon the relationship of the various offices, W.R.A., W.C.C.A, and possible others to this evacuation and storage problem, I will appreciate it very much.

On March 13, 1942 a deed was executed by the Board of Directors of the Japanese Independent Congregational Church, recorded on April 23, 1942, conveying title to the Northern California Congregational Conference. This Conference is an affiliated organization with relationships with all Congregational churches in the area extending from Fresno to Eureka. The business office of the Conference is in the Phelan Building, San Francisco, telephone Exbrook 2757. The superintendent of the Conference, Dr. Harley H. Gill, is now attending a conference in the East but is expected to return in about two weeks.

I wish to express my sincere appreciation for the kind advice and assistance you have given us in settling our business affairs prior to evacuation.

Everything has been arranged to our satisfaction and I wish to report on the following settlements on our hotel at 9032 Second Street.

- 1. We have agreed to execute a power of attorney to the Church Council of Sacramento for the purpose of enabling it to take care of and manage our hotel.
- 2. We have agreed to pay the sum of \$20.00 per month for the management services.
- 3. Dr. Alfred Tonness, Secretary of the Church Council, has agreed to establish a checking account under the name of the Harvey Hotel.
- 4. We have made a deposit of \$50.00 with nine other hotels for the Guarantee Fund which is to be used for the purpose of meeting any operating deficit incurred by our hotel or by any one of the other hotels under the same management.
- 5. Mr. Williams, the manager of the hotel is moving into our home with his family so he can be centrally located and his wife has agreed to work at our hotel making things more satisfactory for us.
- 6. Our owner, Mrs. Karen Rasmussen, has agreed to lower the rent from \$100.00 to \$85.00 a month to make it easier for us to meet expenses during the period in which we have our hotel under another's management.

Since our hotel is small and our income not very large, we were worried about settling our affairs favorably, but we are thankful that the above arrangements have been made and we feel that it was for the best.

They called the office and said that the title to the church and the management of the property was being vested in the San Jose resbytery, with the Rev. Kemper of 43 Nacional Street, Salinas in charge. The gymnasium of the church has furniture from a number of families stored there and they want to keep the furniture there. The Chief of Police of Salinas would prefer to have the bank store all the furniture but as so much of this furniture is the property of people already evacuated, we would be unable to receive it for storage under the present rules and we have so notified the Chief.

There are 3 houses on this property which are going to be rented so that it would not appear that the police problem is going to be so very severe.

Action taken:* We inspected the premises yesterday and had all these gentlemen there and many others busy storing their stuff. We cautioned the vestrymen to be very careful about locking all the doors and windows and barring the doors that appeared at all weak. They are leaving the key with Rev. Kemper who will be in charge and to whome communications should be addressed.



It is quite probable that the desire to cancel is not caused by the fact that this Church is being used as a storehouse at this time. Mr. Kuyper states both agent and Company approved the arrangement before furniture was stored. The storage, itself, appears to be orderly, with parcels and packages well marked. Record of storage is available, affecting from 12 to 15 families, who stored their more valuable items of personal property separately in private storage. Interviewer states families affected are well able to pay for private storage of effects.

This morning we have had a call from Mr. Jack C. Lubbook, Special agent of the Fireman's Fund Insurance Company, address, Central Bank Building, Cakland, telephone number, Glencourt 7840.

as I understand Mr. Lubbook's representations, the situation regarding the insurance coverage on the Japanese Christian Church in Stockton measures up as follows:

- 1. The Company prefers to cancel the insurance on the property, and requests that the policies carrying the insurance be returned to them, so that refund of unearned prorated premium may be made to Japanese Christian Church.
- 2. The usual understanding of fire insurance protection is that a certain property is insured under the policy, whereas it is the owner's interest which is insured, the property, itself, being merely the vehicle through which the owner's interest is insured. Therefore, that interest must be definitely known, so that there will be no doubt as to whom insurance shall be made payable in the event of loss. This is one of the reasons for the desire to terminate these particular policies—they were issued merely under the name of "Japanese Christian Church," which name does not clearly indicate just whose interests are insured.
- 3. Without making the promise that a new policy will be issued, the above Representative

Reference is made to your recent undated letter wherein you enclosed a copy of your interview memorandum with the Rev. Masatane Mitani.

In replying to question No. 1 in your letter: "Can an alien withdraw funds from an impounded account in addition to his menthly allowance to move chattels during evacuation? If so what procedure would be followed?"

We assume that you have reference to an account blocked because of the individual not having been in the United States on and at all times since June 17, 1940. The answer would be that any withdrawals in excess of those permitted by General License No. 11, which is \$500.00 a month for living, traveling and similar personal expenses, could be made only after a specific license had been issued by the Federal Reserve Bank of San Francisco for such withdrawals. Applications for such licenses should be filed on Form TFE-1 (Revised) in triplicate. A small of these forms is enclosed for your information and convenience.

The same answer would apply to question No. 2, wherein you ask "Could an alien secure funds from an impounded account to aid a Japanese who is a citizen to buy property?"

You realize, of course, that if the individual could qualify as a generally licensed national under General License No. 68A, no specific license would be necessary.

Reference is made to your letter dated May 11, 1942 addressed to Wartime Civil Control Administration, 707 South Spring Street, Los Angeles, which has come to our attention.

We understand that you are concerned about the propriety of holding religious meetings for evacuees outside of Military Area No. 1.

This matter is one of interest to the Provost Marshal of the Western Defense Command and Fourth Army rather than this bank, inasmuch as the Provost Marshal has jurisdiction over the enforcement of regulations, etc. pertaining to military areas which have been established by the Army authorities.

In the interests of time we have communicated with the Provost Marshal at WCCA Headquarters, Hotel Whitcomb, San Francisco, and are informed by that office that there is no prohibition against religious meetings outside of Military Area No. 1.

The Provost Marshal has requested that we communicate this information to you with the advice that it will, of course, be impossible for the evacuees to cross the line into Military Area No. 1 for such purpose.

We have been directed by R.B. Hood of the F.B. I., 510 So.

Spring Street, Los Angeles, to direct a query put to their office,

to your office. We quote from our letter addressed to them:

"During recent weeks a considerable number of Japanese families from the San Francisco Bay area, and other Zone One points have settled in the vicinity of Visalia. Many of these people were members of Christian Church groups in the placesof their former residence.

"The Visalia Ministerial Union is anxious to meet the religious needs of these people. The Inter-denominational Board has assigned a Miss Evans, who has had years of experience as a missionary in Japan, to work with them in our city.

"The local authorities are inclined to look with favor on the holding of religious meetings for these people, provided the meetings are held in one or several of the established, white churches, but have refeered us to your office (The F.B.I., Fresno, Cal) for clearance before proceeding.

"What we desire to know, therefor, is: Has your office any objection to, or regulation for, the conduct of these services, provided they are not held in a restricted zone?"

We shall appreciate your response to the question raised, as promptly as is possible, as we are anxious to begin work with these new residents.



The Jackson Sunday School, owned by T. Koyama now at Manzanar. The taxes are exempt on that property and Insurance is good for another year. Mr. Henry Ehrhardt of Elk Grove is looking after Mr. Koyama's ranch and home and also the Sunday School building.

The Elk Grove language school is being taken care of by Mr. Beach of the Beach's Garage of Elk Grove. Insurance has been paid for that property for two years.

Samuel Tsukamoto No. 8548 would like to have his bed and mattress which was stored with the Federal Reserve Bank sent to him soon. Dear Mr. Everson: Referring to our discussion of yesterday morning, I am Chairman of a Committee under the Executive Committee of the Department of Morale of the Civilian Defense Council, which deals with racial and nationality problems in San Francisco. I left with you a report dated February 18, 1942 which was made prior to the President's Executive Order placing the alien situation under the War Department and before the War Department had announced publicly that it was in charge. Accordingly, our report was at my request given no publicity and is of no moment except for your information as to how our Committee felt about the situation. There is a very fine and substantial group of citizens in San Francisco and the Bay Community which has worked for years with our foreign population along social service lines and which group is not at all in sympathy with the conclusions of our particular Committee. At my request, this group

with the conclusions of our particular Committee. At my request, this group formed itself into a committee with Dr. Mary H. Layman as Chairman, and I showed you a letter signed by Dr. Layman in which certain information was requested. Following my discussion with you, I wrote Dr. Layman in part as follows:

(1) An alien property custodian has been appointed affecting foreign property, but this does not apply to property within our community. There is established at 500 California Street, on the ground floor of the Financial Center Building, an efficient, easily accessible "Information Bureau" which is charged with the duty of advising on business matters and assisting probable evacuees on protecting their business rights. This office should be freely used by probable evacuees. From personal experience, I know that it is well and efficiently staffed and a great deal of confusion can be alleviated if those who are about to be evacuated go to that office with their problems. There will be many questions that cannot be answered. This office is really an evacuee property department of the San Francisco Federal Reserve Bank and cannot express opinions or give advice on problems which are under the War Department.

(2) "Many members of the Civilian Defense Council are working to bring about Reviewing Boards to consider hardship cases, not only in connection with impending

evacuation, but also in connection with those who have not been able to achieve citizenship status because of administrative delays in governmental offices and other similar reasons. I personally believe that such Boards will be set up, but I have no authority to make any statement that they will be established and it would be a mistake to hold out any encouragement that the Boards will be established. If they are established, it will be because of the Government's conclusion that the causes of justice could be served in so doing, without damage to our military security. All we can assure you is that the matter is in competent hands.

(3) "I think you will agree that accurate and factual information is now daily in all of our newspapers and that the actual situation is being well placed before the public. I am enclosing clippings from the Call-Bulletin of last night and the Chronicle of this morning, which illustrate definitely that the authorities are trying to place the matter clearly before those affected. You will find the authorities eager to properly set forth all information possible, and any further suggestions that your Committee may have on this situation I know will be welcomed."

I am giving you this information for your records. If my understanding of the situation as I have related it to Dr. Layman is inaccurate, I will appreciate your advising me.

It may be from time-to-time that I will want to consult you or ask that some member of Dr. Layman's group meet with you, but I know how busy you are and will trouble you as little as possible.

Report of Committee on Racial and Nationality Problem in San Francisco

A Committee composed of Mrs. E. S. Heller, Mrs. A. S. Musante and Leland W. Cutler, Chairman, has been appointed by the Executive Committee of the Department of Morale of the Civilian Defense Council of San Francisco, to deal with racial and nationality problems in San Francisco. This Committee met in Mr. Cutler's office on Wednesday, February 18, 1942 at 3:30 o'clock, and by invitation were joined by Mr. Victor Sbragia, Mr. Chauncey Tramutolo and Mr. Joseph Kertz.

This meeting followed a conference which Mr. Cutler, Mr. Sbragia and Mr. McAuliffe, Chairman of the Morale Committee, had with Mayor Rossi, Tuesday afternoon in the Mayor's office. At that time Mayor Rossi read a telegram from Congressman John H. Tolan of the same date, reading as follows:

"ACTING UPON REQUEST OF DEPARTMENTS CONCERNED AND VOTE OF HOUSE TODAY THIS COMMITTEE OF WHICH I AM CHAIRMAN WILL OPEN HEARINGS IN SAN FRANCISCO SATURDAY FEBRUARY 21, TO OBTAIN FULLEST POSSIBLE INFORMATION REGARDING PROBLEMS ATTENDING REMOVAL OF ALIEN POPULATIONS FROM COASTAL AREAS. COMMITTEE DESIRES OPINION OF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICIALS AND REPRESENTATIVES OF COMMUNITIES AFFECTED. REQUEST THAT YOU APPEAR AS A WITNESS ON DATE DESIGNATED. COMMITTEE STAFF REPRESENTATIVE WILL BE AVAILABLE FOR CONFERENCE THURSDAY. SUGGEST YOU PREPARE OUTLINE OF PROBLEM AS YOU SEE IT, FOR DISCUSSION THEN, YOUR COOPERATION WILL BE DEEPLY APPRECIATED."

Mayor Rossi has asked this Committee, in conjunction with Messrs. Sbragia, Tramutolo and Kertz, to outline the alien problem in San Francisco, as we see it, and make such recommendations as seem best suited to the situation.

The problem of alien enemies in our midst is self-evident; not only is the physical safety of our people affected but very distinctly is the morale of our people affected. We feel very strongly that the problem divides itself into two classes:

The <u>First</u> is the Japanese problem, which is so imminent and dangerous that it should, in our opinion, be treated separately from that of the Italian and German problem, and should be dealt with immediately. If an ordered way can be found to bring it about, it is our belief that every Japanese should be removed from this community, alien and citizen alike. Hardships and injustices will naturally be encountered, but the safety of our own people is paramount and the injustices will not in any fashion be in proportion to the resulting safety of our own citizens. We fully realize the gravity of our recommendation and how it will likely disturb for years to come, the ideals of democracy which America has tried to instill in its citizens of Japanese origin. We are mindful, however, of the protective treatment with which our Government will surround the evacuation and the good care which will be given to the evacues in any area selected.

Secondly: Very dangerous problems are presented by the Germans and Italians in our community. We commend the work of the Department of Justice and the Federal Bureau of Investigation in dealing with these situations, and we urge that the work be prosecuted with renewed vigor, to the end that aliens and citizens alike of these races, be subjected to the closest scrutiny, and removed when any evidence of disloyalty is found. This applies to all nationalities and all elements in the community. We have in our community, citizens of unquestioned standing of all nationalities, who will help the constituted officials in every possible way, but who cannot take the responsibility of deciding who should be removed and who should remain. The Morale Committee of the Civilian Defense Council, is in touch with these citizens and will gladly recommend to the officials the names of worthy people, for whose loyalty the members of the Morale Committee will vouch.

We urge upon the members of Congress meeting for this hearing, that earnest efforts be put forth to increase the staff of the local offices of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, the Department of Naturalization, and the Department of Immigration. All of these offices are under-staffed and over-worked and the dependency which this community has upon these three organizations, together with all the Departments under the Department of Justice, is beyond description.

In submitting the above recommendations, the six of us are unanimous.

This Committee instructs Mr. Cutler to discuss with the Mayor, and the Staff Representative of the Congressional Committee, and also the Congressional Committee, if proper, the seriousness of happenings to aliens on and after February 24th, and to urge that some solution of the problem then arising, be immediately brought about. This refers to fishermen, janitors, garbage collectors, produce and vegetable workers in markets, and countless alien workmen in various fields, who will have to have specific permits to go about their occupations after 9 P.M., if the ordinary commercial processes are to be maintained. Quite aside from manual workers, there are quite a number of alien professionals, such as doctors, who will have to make calls after curfew, etc. There are only a few days in which to have regulations promulgated for these activities.
