SUBJECT: Interview between G.E.C.C. Representatives Messrs. Garfinkle, Denning and Goodwin and Representatives of the Federal Reserve Bank, including the writer, at Sacramento, held April 10, 1942.

April 15, 1942

From the attached memorandum it will be observed that all of the six cases under discussion were the result of sales of refrigerators, etc., to people located in the Vacaville area. In each one of these instances, the General Electric people had taken the J.A.C.L. Representative for that area with them while interviewing the persons who were purchasing electrical appliances on a contract basis.

According to the General Electric men, all of the transactions were completed to the entire satisfaction of the customer.

The reason for the meeting was occasioned by one of the customers after having signed an agreement, comtlaining that he was not satisfied with the transaction which had transpired.

There is no doubt that legally the General Electric people are acting within their rights or that proper agreements were obtained, which we understand provided for the waiver of General Electric's rights insofar as deficiency judgments were concerned. The General Electric people assured us that refrigerators, etc., were being held by them and that the evacuee in question could at any time sell the refrigerator for the best price he could get, providing of course, that their balance was paid off. In other words, the repossessions were not the ordinary type, wherein the individual would no longer have the right to negotiate or attempt to salvage some part of his investment.

It must be borne in mind that in only one instance out of those brought before us by the General Electric people, had the evacuee made any complaint whatsoever, and that this case is being worked on with the idea in mind of giving every assistance possible to the evacuee.

Obviously the creditors feel that some steps must be taken to protect the amount of their interest in these electrical appliances, and are following the only procedure which appears to remain open to them. They promised all assistance possible in any transaction wherein the evacuee was dissatisfied.

MEMORANDUM

June 19, 1942

SUBJECT: Telephonic conversation with Walter Groesbeck. Hourself 9151

June 19, 19,2, the writer received a call from Mr. Walter Groesbeck of Berkeley.

Mr. Groesbeck stated that he now sought help in the forwarding of warious Japanese goods stored privately in two churches for which he was pastor. He was informed of the existence of the War Relocation Authority, that agency's function in the evacuation program, and referred to them for disposition of this particular problem.

It then developed that this appeared to be a secondary reason for Mr. Groesbeck's call, the primary cause being to notify us that he had been classified as 1-A by his local draft board and was therefore soliciting any assistance that we might be able to render. It appeared that upon receipt of this classification, Mr. Groesbeck contacted his local draft board whose Chairman is Prof. Man Radin of the University of California. The Secretary of the board informed him that his case would be considered next Tuesday evening, June 23, and that a letter from him, together with a letter from outside disinterested parties addressed to the board, would be of considerable help in securing a deferment. Mr. Groesbeck inquired as to our position in such a matter and whether we would be interested in sending a letter. The writer informed him that the Bank as such could not justifiably take an official stand in his case but that we were well aware of his activity in protecting Japanese interests in the East Bay. We suggested that he promptly arrange a meeting with the more prominent Japanese at Tanforan, looking towards a mutually satisfactory procedure for a disposition of the forwarding problem and also a letter to be signed by these Japanese requesting a deferment. I also suggested that Mr. Groesbeck contact the W. C. C. A. headquarters at the Hotel Whitcomb, stating his case to them with the thought that they might see fit to develop further an official attitude towards a deferment of at least a temporary nature. Both of these measures were urged upon Mr. Groesbeck with the recommendation that they be undertaken promptly. He informed the writer that a complete set of books was available, disclosing the record of operations for various enterprises in the East Bay, and that he proposed calling Mr. Rae Vader of the Foreign Funds Control Investigative Unit locking towards an examination of those books by that unit. The writer approved of this step and suggested that Mr. Vader might later contact this department after such conversation had occurred.

The talk with Groesbeck was concluded at this point and the writer referred the entire matter to Mr. Herbert Armstrong who, after a discussion, called Mr. Vader and apprised him of the foregoing facts. Mr. Vader agreed to refer Groesbeck back to this department after his contemplated call, intending to express the thought that this department might be instrumental in obtaining some sort of a temporary deferment, predicated upon his activity in East Bay property affairs.

The following information has been received from the Berkeley, California Police Department:

"Subject: WILLIAM WAITER GROESBECK, 1914-B Francisco Street, telephone Barkeley 0333-W, voluntary agent of evacuee Japanese

"On April 12, 1942, Mr. MASON CASE, local representative of the Federal Reserve Bank of San Francisco, office located at 2461 Shattuck Avenue, Berkeley, reported to our investigator that the subject named person has come to his office seeking information in regard to acting as agent for Japanese evacuees.

"Mr. CASE states that GROESBECK was informed by him that he was taking on considerable responsibility if he intended to take over the Japanese properties, that if he intended to receive a commission for the handling of these properties he would be required by State Law to obtain a Real Estate Broker's License, whereupon Mr. GROSSBECK stated that he did not expect to receive a commission but that he believed that when the whole war was over with that possibly the Japanese would like to make him a little 'gift,' whereupon Mr. CASE told him that he had better check further with the various real estate people in Berkeley to determine whether or not such action would be legal, that in his opinion he (CROES-BECK) was heading for considerable trouble. GROESBECK informed Mr. CASE that the Japanese owner of the College Cleaning and Dyeing Works at 2942 College Avenue, Berkeley, had already turned over to him their business and requested that he operate it as their agent. According to Mr. CASE's information, this place of business grosses approximately \$1,500 monthly, net income \$900, and that GROESBECK has lined this business up through the Japanese owner assigning him their power of attorney.

"Mr. A. CPSMBY DONOCH JR., realtor, 2466 Shattuck Avenue, Berkeley, informs our investigator that on April 2 CROESBECK came to his office and stated that Mr. CASE of the Federal Reserve Bank had suggested that he come to DONOCH's and discuss this Japanese property problem, whereu on Mr. DONOCH informed him that in order to handle the property it would be

necessary for him to take out a real estate license. Mr. DONOGH then read the real estate act of the State of California to GROESBECK and also gave him a copy of the act. GROESBECK then informed DONOGH that there would be no charge for his handling the property since the Japanese people paid him a regular salary. DONOGH then told him that if he attempted to handle the property in any other manner than set up in the real estate act it would constitute an evasion of the law and that he (GROESBECK) was headed for trouble, whereupon GROESBECK became angry and informed DONOGH that the Japanese did not want anything to do with the real estate people as they were all crooked. DONOGH asked him for an explanation of this remark and became angry himself, whereupon GROESBECK apologized.

"DONOGH reported the above incident to Mr. CASE. The next appearance that CROESBOCK makes is at the office of JOHN P. RATCLIFF, Fidelity Guarantee Building and Loan Association, 2323 Shattuck Avenue, Berkeley, where he introduced himself as the Young Peoples' Pastor of the Japanese Church in Berkeley and in his statements led Mr. RATCLIFF to believe that CROESBECK is handling at the present time approximately twenty pieces of Japanese property, consisting principally of residences. The occasion for his call at Mr. RATCLIFF's office was that he came in on April 4, 1942, and advised that he was going to handle the property of MITSUKO TAKEO KOGA, 1720 Carlton Street. The loan amounts to \$1,400 and the payment to Fidelity is \$18.50 per month. GROSSBECK informed Mr. RATCLIFF that he was connected with the Japanese people's church and was also employed by Safeway Stores as a clerk, however he anticipated resigning his job as clerk in order that he might have more time to take care of the Japanese properties. He went on to say that the rent from 1720 Carlton Street would be more than enough to keep up the monthly payments. However, if this failed to be the case he would make the payments from his own pocket. Furthermore, that inasmuch as someone had told him that he must obtain a real estate license he planned to do so to be on the safe side. He also stated that he was at the present time living at 1914-B Francisco Street, but expects to move very shortly to the home of K. NAKAJIMA, 2528 Milvie Street, insemuch as he had promised NAKAJIMA to look after his home while he was in the concentration center. NAKAJIMA is generally known as the "Scrap Iron Aing" due to his activities in buying scrap iron and shipping it to Japan.

"In addition to the above properties, he is also handling the Northbrae Cleaners, 2104 Vine Street, Berkeley, owned by J. YAMAGUCHI, 2005 Lincoln Street, Berkeley, subject of FBI reports.

[&]quot;To date it is not known whether or not GROESBECK has violated the real estate act of the State of California, however before continuing our investigation in this connection we wish to advise the Federal Bureau of Investigation of GROESBECK's acts and determine whether or not that office desires to conduct the investigation from the standpoint of the possibility of a Federal violation by GROESBECK.



Rescreption for investigation dated May 2, 1962 purment to a verbal request from Mr. H. S. Everson, Heneger of the Evenue Property Department of the Federal Reserve Book of San Francisco.

STRUBSIS:

William Walter Grossbeck is 30 years of age, an ingrican-born citizen of Halland-Dutch decent and the som of a Free-Methodist Paster. He is a licensed Promober in the Pacific Coast Japaness Conference of the Proc-Methodist Church. He has been given 19 Powers-of-Atturney by Japanese Evecuees in the Oakland-Perkeley area, all members of the church with which he is commercial. These Powers-of-Attorney cover approximately 27 percels of property. He has perchased outright, from one evacues, with a vertal agreement to sell back, a cleaning establishment in Perkeley which he plans to operate. Subject case under the suspicion of the Procuse Property Department because his mane appeared in a large masher of evacues cases and it was felt that he might be profiteering and taking advantage of the evacuees. However, nothing was discovered during this investigation that would indicate that he was acting other than in good faith and in a sincere desire to help the members of his church. As meerly as could be determined the Japanese have turned their property over to subject's care because they trusted his and considered his as a friend. There was ne evidence of convicu.

On April 30, 1942 I interviewed Br. Macon Case of the Nar Savings Department of the Federal Receive Bank of San Francisco and formerly Field Representative for the Swacuse Property Department in Berkeley, California. On May 1, 1942 I contacted by telephone Mr. J. P. Pepper of the Berkeley Police Department. Also on May 1, 1942, subject was questioned at this effice by Supervising Agent, Rae V. Vader and the undersigned. On May 2, 1942 Mr. R. W. Borden and Mr. Joseph C. Tyler of the Evacuse Property Department, San Francisco were interviewed and an inspection made of the files in that office, pertinent to this investigation.

inchment

William Walter Groesbeck was born in lose, February 22, 1912 of Holland-Jutch parents. His father is a Free-Nethodist paster. Subject attended Church School in Kenses for one year after graduation from high school. He went to Los Angeles in 1936 accompanied by his wife, and attended a church school there for an additional year. In 1937 he applied to be sent on a mission to South America; however, he did not have the required four years of college school-tion. In 1936 subject and his wife were effered positions as "Young People's Sponsors" at the Berkeley Japanese Free-Nethodist Church. This position was offered so that subject and his wife could gain clurch experience and at the same time go to school.

Subject and his wife accepted this offer and moved to Derkaley. The couple received \$26.00 a month for their services to the church. Subject becase assistant to Rev. Hishimure, the Japanese Pastery and since he first became associated with the church he has presched the English service each Sunday.

Subject attended school at the University of California during the years 1935 and 1939, completing the four years college education required by his clarch but never obtaining a degree. He now holds a Prescher's License issued by the Japanese Conference of the Presidential Charch.

Due to the small salary received from the church subject had to corn additional living money elsewhere and worked part-time for Safeway Stores Inc. in and around Berkeley. Later, when he left the University he obtained a full-time job with the United Security Detective Agency. This position was obtained as a result of his experience with Safeway Stores and his duties were to callect mail from the various fafeway Stores and to act as bank messenger. Be has now taken a leave of absence from the above position in order to devote his full time to caring for the Japanese property placed in his custody. At the time he applied for this leave he was making \$150.00 a month.

Subject's wife graduated from the University of California and is now teaching at the California School for the Eliza in Berkeley. She is earning \$140.00 a month.

Motives:

Subject stated that while his family has urged him to follow a religious career he has always had a desire to follow a business career and that this opportunity to manage Japanese property appealed to him.

When the evacuation order was given to the East bey Area (East San Francisco Bay) Japanese, Nev. Michiaura asked subject what he intended to do and offered him the alternative of either accompaning the compregation to the resettlement area or to remain behind to look after the evacuees' property, with the recommunication that he take the latter alternative, in as much as Nev. Michiaura was being evacuated with the rest of the congregation and would be with them.

Subject also pointed out that during the four years that he has worked with the Japanese he has grown to like them. He said that he and his wife had made for American friends since coming to Berkeley and that must of their friends were Japanese.

Extent to which Burdling Japanese Property:

At the time when the subject was interviewed he offered 19 Powers-of Attorney for examination. All of these Powers-of-Attorney were from Japanese members of his church. Subject declared that in each instance the evacue had come voluntarily to him and requested that he assume responsibility for their property. It is natural to assume, however, that the evacuese came to the subject on the recommendation of Rev. Kishimura.

The above mentioned Powers-of-Attorney covered some 27 residences as well as one cleaning establishment and one mursery. All of the above mentioned residences are now rented, the majority having been rented by the Japanese before their evacuation, a few of the houses were rented by the subject, although he had little difficulty in doing so, because of the housing shortage in the area. Subject has purchased the cleaning establishment and is at present operating the basiness. The nursery has been leased.

Methods of Mamilian Properties:

Subject has opened a special account with the Elmwood Branch of the American Trust Company in Berkeley, California. All rent memies received are to be deposited in this account with the

exception of instances where the evacuee requested that it be deposited to his credit in a separate account. Subject is paying an liens on certain of the properties and paying maintainance expenses out of rents received, no other deductions are being unit.

A set of books is being set-up by the subject with the assistance of an accountant and individual accounts will be kept. A statement will be mailed monthly to each evacues showing the receipts and expenditures to each account.

Subject stated that he has requested no commissions for the management of evacuee property although commissions have been offered him. However, the evacuese have given "gifts", in the form of cash, to him, these have averaged \$10.00 each, he estimates that the total of these "gifts" will amount to somewhere in the neighborhood of \$200.00 or \$300.00. Then asked if he thought that he would receive further "gifte" in the future, subjest replied that he had no idea, and that it was up to the evacuees. Subject is accepting these "gifts" because he feels that he has earned them. This system of "gifts" in lieu of commissions evidently is to get around a complaint registered by several Oakland Berkeley real estate men to the Evacues Property Department, particularly a Mr. Domogh, Secretary of the Berkeley Real Estate Board. This complaint is to the effect that, subject is engaging in the business of a real estate broker without a license, in violation of the California Real Estate Law. It is believed that the above possible violation of the California law is not of concern to say Agency of the United States Covernment but rather to the enforcement agencies of the local authorities. The facts of the case at hand were referred to the Berkeley Police Department by Mr. Masson Case, formerly of the Evacuee Property Department. A Mr. J. P. Pepper of the Berkeley Police Department conducted an investigation into the activities of the subject and informed the undersigned by telephone on May 1, 1942 that his investigation had revealed no violations. Subject plans to take the examination for Real Estate Brokers License as soon as he has had time to study the required subjects and thus prevent any further criticisms of the above sature.

In addition to the above activities, subject has purchased the College Cleaners and Dyers of 2942 College Avenue, Berkeley. This establishment has been operated by four Japanese partners since 1910. These Japanese operated a complete cleaning and dying plant and conjucted a retail pick-up and delivery business. Subject purchased this business under two provisions: First, there is a vertal agreement to sell-back the business when the former owners are permitted to return. Second, the cleaning plant equipment located in the back of the store is to be locked up and not used. Subject is to compute a retail business, doing pressing and alteration work in the shop and letting-out his cleaning work to a

wholesaler. A reduction in rent was granted subject on the part of the premises not to be used, said portion to be rent free in consideration, by the owner of the property, for the long tenancy of the owners of the equipment.

Subject obtained this business for a consideration of \$700.00 in cash and has a Mill of Sale showing purchase of the front store equipment and one delivery truck. The \$700.00 was raised by berrowing \$400.00 on the subject's personal car and \$300.00 on the delivery truck, which was purchased as part of the cleaning business. The certificate of ownership of said delivery truck having been turned over to subject prior to the closing of the deal in order that he could raise the necessary cash. Said transaction speaking very well for the comfidence which these evacuous have in the subject. The gross business of this cleaning establishment, according to the subject, has amounted to \$1500,00 in recent months with total emenses of approximately \$550.00. However, subject estimates him expanses will be close to \$1000.00 due to the fact that he will have to pay for cleaning work as well as for help, as contrasted to the former conditions where the owners had done all of the work themselves.

Subject plans to, or has by time of writing, moved into the home of one <u>E. Mahajima</u> at 2528 Milvia Street, Berkeley, California. The evacuoe, Makajima, is a very mealthy Japanese, formerly in the scrap-iron business. His home is reguled to be very lumurious and contains many art treasurers. Subject will pay a rent of \$40.00 a month which is far below the rental value of the property. Subject pointed out that he obtained the home at this low rental because Makajima did not desire to rent but was interested primarily in having someone in the house who will take care of its valuable contents.

Subject has also spent considerable time in collecting bills owing to his Japanese friends and helping then dispose of certain property. He stated that since the evacuation order he has been working might and day so that these Japanese might get their financial affairs cleaned up.

Comelesions

It is not believed that the large number of Powers-of-Attorney given to the subject, in itself, justifies a suspicion of profiteering, when consideration is given to his commections and position of trust with the Japanece through their church. Nor was anything revealed during this investigation which would indicate that he was acting in bad feith or attempting to force these Japanese into anhing decisions: against their own judgment.

While it is uniquitedly true that the subject has had little business experience and probably does not fully realize the res-

possibility he is undertaking, he does realise his can limitations and is attempting to go about the business in a proper and conscientious summer. He will probably give the evacuoes more consideration than a disinterested agent would, especially in view of the anti-Japanese feeling in this locality.

Then subject has had sufficient time to set up his books of account an emmination will be made of said books and a supplemental report submitted.

The above party was mentioned in numerous interviews emanating from the Berkeley office as an interested friend of the Japanese who was willing to accept power of attorney. At the time I called on the Berkeley office the latter part of March, our representative, Mason Case, again referred to this man with considerable suspicion. It appeared to him and to Mr. Donogh, Secretary of the Berkeley Seal Satate Board, that Grossbeck was not altogether qualified for the appointmentake was undertaking. Furthermore, in Donogh's opinion, Grossbeck could bear investigating as he had made the voluntary statement to Donogh that he was accepting no consideration for his activities.

It became evident to the writer early in April that Grossback was not confining his activities to Borkeloy slone, as verious interviews ranging all the way from Richmond to Hayward indicated that he was acting on behalf of evacuous during their absence. On April 13 Grossback was made the subject of a letter from our Berkeley representative further emphasizing his suspicions and calling specific cases to our attention wherein Groesbook had accepted such attorneyship with no apparent comprehension of the responsibility. For example: he apparently stated to the Mason-McDuffie Company, prominent realtors, that he was operating the cleaning establishment of Mr. E. Sakasoto at 8942 College avenue without any consideration. apparently he has held no experience in the conduct of this business, although it is known to be a substantial enterprise. The letter further stated that Mr. Case had contacted J. P. Pepper of the Berkeley police, who was making an investigation of this sen. At the time the writer notified the Pal of this case in a conversation consisting of a very brief outline of the facts and a statement of his name and address as known to us.

A subsequent letter was received from the Perheley office dated april 17, prespeed by the information that Grossbeck had moved into the home of a scrap dealer, hamely: E. Ecknims. address, 2525 Milvia Street, Berkeley. On April 23 I discussed this situation at length with Mr. Case who was in our office at the time. He expressed further alarm and felt that we should at least make every effort to know this man was thoroughly investigated. I concurred in this opinion; and in view of the feeling of Mr. Bonogh, who had contributed a very real service to our Berkeley operation, and in view of the apparent wide-spread activities of this man, again called the FBI. The case was discussed in detail and full information was rendered them with regard to known powers of attorney which he had accepted, his occupation of the Makajima residence, etc. The Agent for the FBI informed me they would immediately contact Pepper and pursue this case aggressively.

On April 28 we reserved a 'phone call in this office from Mr. Grossbeen asking for our cooperation in a difficulty erising with the California State Realty Board. It appeared that he had been maked by them to pass the necessary tests and take out the necessary licenses requested of any broker dealing in real estate. I suggested that he contact our representatives in the Berksley Control Station, Messrs. Dake and Mack, and discuss the problem with them. I then called Mr. Case, who stated that in all probability Mr. Denogh had prevailed upon the California State Board to take this action as a means of exploring the case. Next. I 'phoned Mr. Dake and informed his of the expected visit from Grossbeck and the salient features behind his expected call.

Since writing the above reports your representative's attention has been called to Mr. Groesbeek by Mr. Hendricks, of the Oakland office, Mr. Domogh, Secretary of the Berkeley Real Estate Board and the Masen-McDuffie Company, whose reports coupled with the personal interviews had with this young man seemed to justify some investigation of his background and activities.

Mr. Greesbeck advised us that he had leased the equipment in the cleaning establishment of Mr. Kakuchi Sakamotoat 2942 College Avenue, Berkeley, without any consideration for the use of same beyond maintaining the business, in which he has had no experience, and in servicing their customers during their evacuation. Your representative discussed the matter by telephone with the San Francisco office some days ago and suggested it might be well to have an F.B.I. check-up. As we have heard nothing in the meantime, and as Mr. Grossbeck is apparently very sative, your representative discussed the situation with Mr. J. P. Pepper of the Berkeley police, who works very closely with the F.B.I. is this area, in order to forestall what might conceivably result in an unhappy situation.

Should interest net be so paid it shall thereafter bear like interest as the principal. Should default be made in payment of interest when due, the whole sum of principal and interest shall, at the option of the holder of this note, become immediately due. Principal and interest payable in United States gold coin. If suit or action shall be instituted in any Court to collect any sum becoming due on this note, the undersigned promise to pay such sum as the Court may adjudge reasonable as attorney's fees in said suit or action. claim some right, title or interest in or lien upon said real property, but that all of the interests and liens of said defendants, if any, are subject and junior to the lien of said deed of trust.

That plaintiff has been compelled to and has employed attorney to commence and maintain this action.

WHEREFORE, plaintiff demands judgment against the defendants as follows:

- 1. That plaintiff recover judgement against the defendants, Tachie Goya and M. I am enclosing a copy of the summons No. 480420 issued by the Superior Court of the State of California in Los Angeles for plaintiff, Edwin N. Fletcher, Jr., against Tachio Goya, M. Rikimaru, and Title Guarantee and Trust Company. The complaint is the foreclosure of the trust deed.

Due to the evacuation order of the Army, I have relocated myself in Heart Mt. Relocation Center. Under the present condition whereas I am making only \$19 per month, it is obvious that I would be unable to meet the demand of the plaintiff.

Since my failure to fulfill my promise to pay the note was not due to any malignant intent on my part, but due to unavoidable circumstances created by the military exigencies. I fell, therefore, that the present action taken by the plaintiff is taking unfair advantage of those people under unfortunate situation.

In order to protect my rights as a citizen, I wish to be informed as to what step I may take at this time to have the property frozen during the duratica.

Your immediate attention in regard to the above matter will be greatly appreciated.

Dear Sir:-

Thank you for your letter of April 18, which we thought had cleared up all our problems in regard to native-born Japanese and selectees in selling their 1942 automobiles.

Following the information which you gave me in your letter of April, the young Japanese citizen to whom I referred in my first letter to you, this morning went to the Highway Patrol office in Woodland to make the transfer of his car to the new owner. They refused to make the transaction, although I had given him the copy of my letter to you and your reply to same, in order to avoid any questions arising that might interfere with his selling his car.

Now, he has come back here asking what shall he do next? He does not want to send or leave his pink slip anywhere, for fear his evacuation order may come at any time and he will be unable to complete the transaction- he wants to transfer it now and have the matter over with.

Will it be possible for you to write to the Woodland Highway
Patrol office and straighter the matter out, with a carbon copy to
me here, or to the young man; his name is Hideo Sagara, Esparte,
Calif. He was told this morning the buyer had to have a priority
card before they could make the transfer. This information seems
to be general in the motor vehicle department offices, as the
selecteee also found it impossible to transfer his car, although he
took my word that you had written he could do so. Will you kindly
attend to this as soon as possible, as time is short for these two
boys to attend to the winding up of their affairs.

Dear Mrs. Grothe:

This is in reply to your inquiry of April 17, 1942.

If the Japanese to whom you refer is generally licensed (which merely means that he is not "blocked" by special order of the Treasury Department), he is at liberty to sell his automobile on any terms and for any price that he sees fit. No clearance through this office is necessary. The selectee to whom you refer is also at liberty to sell his car, unless his account has been "blocked". The only cases in which "blocking" occurs are where there is some reason to believe that the person involved is engaged in subversive activities. You can easily ascertain whether or not either of the persons to whom you refer has been blocked by inquiring at the bank with which each usually does business.

There has been much misinformation in regard to the right of Japanese to sell their property. There are no restrictions on such right of sale, save in the exceptional cases above mentioned. This bank is doing everything that it can to encourage generally licensed Japanese who are to be evacuated to dispose of their property interests before they leave. Any deal made must be on terms satisfactory to the Japanese.

Mr. Amos Roth, Rationing Administrator for Yolo County, has informed me that Japanese wishing to sell 1942 cars must clear through your office, therefore will you kindly tell us what procedure is to be followed in the setup we have here, viz:

We have a young American born Japanese man, who expects to be evacuated as a matter of course, and he wishes to sell his 1942 Chevrolet sedan; the young man is a farmer, and the prospective buyer is a farmer who badly needs a new automobile, as his old one is about 12 years old and almost beyond use. He had planned to buy one this year if crop prospects would allow it.; the car he wishes to buy has been driven about 8000 miles.

Since this is the first question of this sort to come before our Board, we would like advise as to the procedure. A selectee in this section would also like to do the same thing, dispose of a 1942 car, as he expects to be called soon.
