

Dear Mr. Bold:

In answer to your kind letter of the 15th, I am happy to state that I managed to sell my food market intact as a going business. Just this week I turned over the business to my successor, and I am awaiting conclusion of the escrow the first part of next week. Thanks to your advice and suggestions, I was able to hold down my loss to a minimum and complete my transaction under terms which my friends describe as remarkable in the light of existing circumstances.

I wish to take this opportunity to express my sincere thanks and gratitude for your advice and guidance in the matter which made possible the eventual disposal of my business. The knowledge that the Federal government was standing behind me was reassuring, to say the least.

Now, there is another matter on which I would like your advice and help. A few weeks ago, before the ban on voluntary evacuation went into effect, four families of my personal friends moved to Utah to start life anew. ~~Originally~~ Originally, my family and I had planned to move with them. In fact, the idea was mine, and the others were really band-wagon jumper-owners. But since I could not get my business affairs in order before the voluntary evacuation deadline, my friends went on, with the understanding that we were to follow just as soon as we were able.

Well, now that my affairs are in order, I am not permitted to leave, even though I have a definite place to go and the means to provide amply for myself and my family. At the time that my friends were leaving, I was given to understand by a consultant in your office that I would be given a permit to join them later. I was told that the ban on voluntary evacuation was aimed at curbing ~~an~~ aimless evacuation by people who had neither the means of supporting themselves or a ~~an~~ place to go. But, I was assured, since I had a place to go and since my friends were depending on my being able to go there, I would be given a special travel permit.

But now that permit is not forthcoming. My family and I are all ready to leave for Utah. My friends there are waiting for us. The twenty-acre tract of farming land that I leased is waiting for me. I have sufficient balance in the bank to maintain me and my family for three or four years if necessary. I have sold my furniture, stored some more. All I've left are a few personal belongings, my truck, and a car, which I intend to use in my projected business in Utah. In ~~fact~~ fact, everything is in readiness, except my permit.

I appreciate the fact that the Army makes no exceptions. However, it is my humble opinion that the authorities can, and should, give special consideration to cases like mine. After all, it costs money to send people to reception centers, feed them, clothe them, care for them. Granting me and my family a special permit to travel to Utah will save the government considerable money in the long run, and who can deny that economy isn't important these feverish days? If you have a little time to spare, I would appreciate your looking into the matter and advising me regarding it. I would be deeply grateful.

Dear Colonel Boekel:

There is enclosed a copy of a letter from Mr. J. H. Takeda which we think has previously been brought to your notice by Mr. Everson of the Federal Reserve Bank of San Francisco. Under date of April 22, Mr. Everson telegraphed us that you had informed him that the fact that Mr. Takeda would not be joining relatives in Utah would not be a factor in connection with granting a permit if it could be established that he made a commitment with respect to the Utah property before Military Area No. 1 was frozen. Mr. Everson also informed us that it was your suggestion that Captain Dennis contact you direct if further explanation was required.


For your information, we discussed this subject with Captain Dennis and he suggested to Mr. Takeda that he take the subject up with Colonel Severin in Pasadena. In a telephonic conversation with Colonel Severin this morning, he informed us that he did not feel justified in issuing the permit but stated that he had no objection to our pursuing the matter further with you. We endeavored to contact you this afternoon by telephone but talked with Major Coombs who suggested that we write you, giving you the full details and our recommendation.

We are informed by Mr. Takeda that he leased sixty-five acres of farming land near Draper, Utah and that the entire transaction was consummated prior to March 29. On March 24 Mr. Takeda entrusted to his friends one thousand dollars to cover the leasing of this property and is naturally quite interested in being permitted to go to Utah to protect his interests.

On March 16 Mr. Takeda called at this office and informed us that he had a market at 2624 West Slauson Avenue and other property which had an approximate value of \$10,000. We suggested to him that he give this matter his attention and try to dispose of the property at the earliest possible moment. You will observe from the enclosed copy of Mr. Takeda's letter that the transaction has been completed but after the time permitting voluntary evacuation.

It is our opinion that there are extenuating circumstances surrounding this case. Mr. Takeda enjoys an excellent standing in his community and is a high type individual in every respect, and, if consistent with regulations, it would be our opinion that he should be permitted the privilege of going to Utah to take care of his property. He has been informed that the plowing has already been done and that everything is in readiness for planting, and that his presence and attention to the management problems of the farm are urgently needed.

I have been consulted by the above named, TAKEJIRO TAKEUCHI, relative to his lease of property located at #7104 Beverly Boulevard, Los Angeles, California, where he has been operating a Chop Suey Restaurant under the name of "Mah Jong Restaurant"; it appears that said lease continues to July 15th., 1942 at a stipulated rental of \$150.00 per month and that you now hold a deposit of \$500.00 to cover the rental for the last two months of the term.

In view of the restrictions recently placed upon Japanese, it has become necessary for Mr. Takeuchi to take steps to liquidate his business; he has an opportunity to sell his fixtures and business to a prospective purchaser who is of the Chinese race, provided that an equitable arrangement can be made with you regarding the present lease, and a new lease can be effected with the prospective purchaser at an equitable rental.

I am advised that offer has been made to enter into a new lease, at a graduated rental commencing at \$60.00 per month and increasing to \$70.00 and then \$80.00 per month, with the understanding that the amount of the present deposit be applied on future rentals; it would be impossible to secure a purchaser to take over the lease and business of the present tenant just for the remainder of his term, without having a definite understanding as to future rentals.

Under a recent order issued by William A. Day, President of the Federal Reserve Bank it has been announced that in the event that a Japanese evacuee has endeavored to effect a fair settlement with his creditor, and such creditor has insisted upon an inequitable course and has refused to enter into a fair settlement, the Federal Reserve Bank may determine to FREEZE the particular property and designate the same as Special Blocked Property, in order to protect the rights of said Evacuee.

While Mr. Takeuchi has not yet received an order to evacuate, such order is anticipated in the near future, and unless some fair and equitable arrangement can be made regarding the matter in question, it will become necessary to call upon the Federal Reserve Bank to take such action as may be necessary to protect his interests; such action might result in the property being placed in a category of Blocked Property which might result in considerable inconvenience and loss to you.

Mr. Takeuchi has been a good tenant for approximately six years past, and in view of the fact that present conditions have arisen through no fault of his, I feel that you should be willing to make some concessions and enable him to realize some fair and reasonable amount on the fixtures in which he has invested a considerable amount of money; nor would suffer any loss, as you would be securing a new tenant for the property at a fair rental.

I trust that you will give this matter your immediate attention, and an equitable settlement may be effected, and that it may not be necessary to resort to extraordinary measures; I shall appreciate your getting in touch with Mr. R. P. MILES, the broker who has heretofore been negotiating with you regarding the proposed new lease, and that I may hear from you in this regard without delay.

I have received your letter of May 8th, and a thousand pardons for this delay in answering. I received the letter at Santa Anita on the 15th after some delay, and we were shifted from one district to another, so we weren't actually settled until a few days ago.

In regards to the parking lot which I discussed with your department, Mr. Learned has been most helpful to me. I have turned the lot over to the Real Estate Management Co, which Mr. Learned recommended highly. I have found their services to date most satisfactory.

Under the present circumstances in regards to tire rationing, I really don't know for certain how long the present tenant will stay on the premises, as his business has dropped considerably.

I still have a debt of \$3900.00 to the Capital Co., but to date all obligations have been met, but in the event that I would be unable to meet these obligations, then they may take foreclosure proceedings. If worse comes to worse, I would like to have the Federal Reserve Bank make some adjustment so that I would not suffer any loss.



Mr. Taniguchi leased an hotel building at 519 Temple Street, Los Angeles, from a Mr. Swantek of 529 California Street, Los Angeles, the lessee owning the furniture and fixtures. Lease provided that written consent must be had in case of a transfer or sale of lease. Mr. Swantek refused this on several occasions and made counter offer to buy furniture for \$200, after having refused to allow the Japanese to close a deal on the basis of an offer of \$1800.

We called Mr. Swantek in and he refused to discuss this matter, stating that we had not business in this deal. We suggested that he think the matter over and explained the freezing order to him. He returned in several days and made an offer of \$750.00 for the furniture. This we refused and told him (on advice of Taniguchi) that the lowest price we would accept was \$1,350. The following day he agreed to this price and put up his check for \$1,350.

Mr. Taniguchi appeared in behalf of his wife, Mrs. Taniguchi who is the lessee of a 39 room, furnished apartment hotel, located at 519 Temple Street, Los Angeles, California, in which they own the entire furnishings. The owner of this property is Mr. Swantek of 529 California Street, Los Angeles, California.

Mr. Taniguchi advises that he had a cash buyer for the furniture, but due to a clause in the lease that provided for written consent of any transfer, Mr. Swantek refused to consider the proposed purchaser and in turn offered to buy the furniture for consideration of \$400. Mr. Taniguchi refused and submitted the case for our arbitration.

On April 7, 1942 we called Mr. Swantek and asked that he come in to this office to discuss this matter. Mr. Swantek did come in to this office and made an offer of \$750, for the furniture at that time. He seemed to be very much against allowing a transfer of this lease to anyone that might be acceptable to Mr. Taniguchi.

We in turn submitted this to Mr. Taniguchi and he again refused, saying that the Action taken: offer was not enough and that he had an offer at the present time of \$1250. On April 9, 1942 we advised Mr. Swantek of this offer and requested under the threat of the freezing order that he either make a better offer or grant permission to the lessee for a transfer of interest in the lease.

Mr. Swantek came in on April 10, 1942 with Mr. Taniguchi and offered to buy the furniture for \$1350, and to give a written release of any further liability under the terms of the lease. When presented to Mr. Taniguchi, he considered it very acceptable and the deal was closed to the satisfaction of all concerned.


