The writer spent an hour and a half at the above camp this morning to gather certain information first hand to answer certain questions asked by evacuees and to stop certain rumors going about.

There have been reports that clashes had occurred between Japanese and soldiers as the result of the Japanese receiving more money for doing nothing than that received by the soldiers. The Japanese do not have occasion to come in contact with soldiers; there are no soldiers in the camp, all being stationed on the outside as guards. Mr. Wilbur informs me that the Japanese are releiving no money for services performed at the camp.

Laundry facilities are about completed that will be handled by their own people and there will be clothes lines and places for their individual laundry work. There is a certain amount of gambling among the Japanese, and it is not advisable to take any great amount of cash with them; checks can be cashed at camp subject to collection within a few days. Mail is being well distributed promptly. There are recreation centers in and around the grandstand for the children as well as adults.

In view of the possible short stay at camp no education arrangement has been made. It is expected that the camp will be cleared on or about October 1st, 1902, as this is a temporary camp. Several kindergarten classes were being taken care of by Japanese girls. I talked with several families and inspected their quarters; they were quite pleased at our coming out and were apparently well satisfied with their surroundings. They advise bringing all the clothes possible and curtain material for the windows and the partitioning off the interior seems to be in order. Wash basins and pails for washing clothes are essential. In the mess hall they are furnished with cups, builte, fork, speen and plates with food already on them. is very good. Five dollars cash will last a person a month, as all one can buy are eigarettes, candy and ice creem. Within a short time milk stations will be open 24 hours a day and people with small babies can by ration cards get what is necessary for their children.
