Pursuant to your visit at our office with a proposal to move some 230 families in the Watsonville area to Mesa Orchard, Idaho, we have checked with the office of the War Relocation Board. As indicated by our representatives, Mr. Berden and Mr. Murray, the chances are remote that anything will be done prior to the evacuation and removal of your group to an assembly center. Authority to issue such a permit, of course, is not within our jurisdiction. However, we are willing to discuss the provision of storage space for the property belonging to your group in such a manner that it could be readily picked up and shipped to you when, as and if the project has been explored and a permit approved.

We have discussed this by telephone with our representative in Watsonville, Mr. F. W. Ruppert, whose office is at 21 West Lake Avenue. He informs us that some arrangements have been made for storage of the belongings of your group in the Presbyterian church. We would suggest that you call upon Mr. Ruppert and discuss this problem with him regarding location, crating requirements, etc. He is of the opinion that only a small percentage of your organization have called upon him to explore the picture, or availed themselves of those services he offers.

May we suggest that you circularize your organization so that they may be advised of the existence of this office in your area?

Outside of some of the cars that the Japanese here have not sold, I think this will complete the program up to the time of the Evacuation. I have a place for what cars will be turned in to me, that will be a nominal cost of rent. It will not be necessary to maintain a watchman, as it is an enclosure.

Reference is made to your letter dated April 14, 1942 regarding the possible sale of a Chevrolet truck, the purchase of which you have financed.

From the information contained in your letter it appears that a substantial equity in this automotive equipment exists in favor of the purchaser. The alternatives which will be open to him with respect to this equipment will be to store the truck under conditions which might subject it to rapid deterioration, or to tender it for sale to the Army on the basis of an appraised value established by two disinterested appraisers or at blue book wholesale, whichever is lower. These alternatives will be available at the time Mr. Arao is evacuated.

We have been suggesting to evacuees that they make their own arrangements for the disposal of motor vehicles if it appears that they will be able to realize more than they would under the Army purchase plan mentioned above, and it would seem that in the present case Mr. Arao would benefit through a private sale transaction if the opportunity presents itself.

In any case, no arrangements could be made for sale to the Army until the area in which Mr. Arao is situated is evacuated.

No doubt your customer will have your cooperation in attempting to find a buyer for the equipment, which, from the information presented, should result in a sale at an excess of the blue book wholesale figure which would be the maximum Army purchase price.






At the request of Messrs. John M. and Susumu Hada we wish to report the existence of certain personal property included in a list of articles which the United States government has placed under the control of government representatives.

Safe Deposit Box No. 1190 in our vaults is rented to John M. Hada, Susumu Hada, Katsu Hada, Sam I. Hada, and Mrs. T. Sugimoto. Included in the contents of this box are three or four cameras. A complete description of the contents of this box is not now available inasmuch as all of the renters are no longer residents of this city.

After consulting the local chief of police and the alien property custodian, and at the request of the Hadas and Mrs. Sugimoto, access to the box is being denied the renters except when accompanied by an officer of this bank. Further, it is distinctly understood that government controlled articles shall not be removed from the box so long as the restrictions remain in effect. Due to the dual control system in effect on safe deposit boxes it is not possible for either the bank or the renters to open the box without both keys to the lock. Inasmuch as our clients are now residing some distance from this city, and as there is little likelihood of their returning in the immediate future, it was felt that it would be wise to handle this case in the manner outlined.

The Hadas and Mrs. Sugimoto have indicated their desire to cooperate and meet all government requirements applicable to the property referred to, and we shall in turn be conscientious in our efforts to adhere to the rules and regulations and any instructions which we may receive from the United States government or its duly authorized representatives.

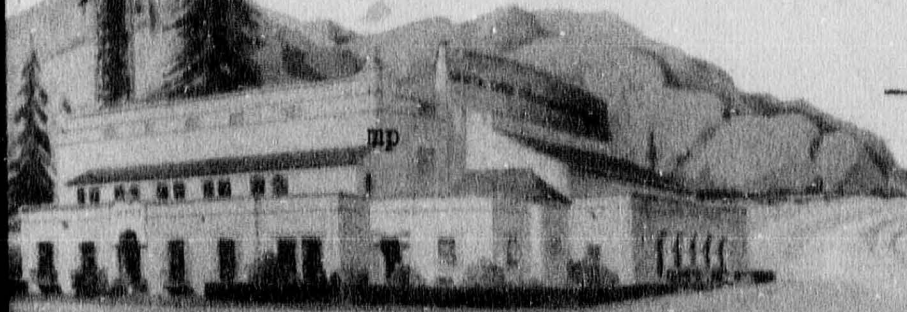
