
Reference is made to your inquiry of July 23, 1942 addressed to our former representative, Mr. McFarland of Sacramento.



According to our information on the application, the assured was born in Japan, October 12th, 1903. According to the evidence just submitted, he was born in Hawaii on that date and is a United States citizen. We have been asked to make sure that there is no question of nationality involved, that is to say that the interested parties are exempt, either because they are United States citizens or because they have resided in the United States since June 17th, 1940. We would appreciate having the enclosed declaration signed by the beneficiary to the effect that she has resided continuously in the United States since June 17th, 1940.

We are responsible to our Head Office for the securing of the two enclosed forms properly completed before delivery of the check. To save time we are sending the papers and the check to you, but would ask that you have the Discharge of Policy and the declaration form both signed by Mrs. Kinuyo Daijogo before releasing the settlement check.



Reference is made to your inquiry of June 17, 1942 concerning one Takashi Sato formerly of Turlock, California.


Our files disclose nothing concerning this evacuee which would indicate that he had sought our assistance concerning the sale of any equipment nor that he is a blocked national which would complicate such a sale as you indicate. We must, therefore, conclude that your informant was in error in stating that we had in any way entered into or blocked the sale of the threshing machine. We would suggest, if you propose to go ahead with the sale, that you ascertain from his bankers whether the account might be blocked. If such is the case, they will be able to inform you as to the method of procedure in such sale.

Please be advised that the evacuees have lost none of their civil rights by virtue of evacuation.

Some time before going to the Center he gave me a bill of sale on a certain Case Threshing Machine so that I might conveniently handle the sale or use of the machine in his absence, and he has now instructed me to sell it for him.

In trying to arrange a sale I was informed that at one time he had a sale arranged to the Turlock Peanut Growers for the sum of \$800 but that the Federal Reserve Bank refused to permit the sale, contending that \$850 was the lowest price that should be paid for the machine. I am wondering if there is any truth to this and whether or not the machine's sale is blocked, because it does not appear that the machine can now be sold for more than about \$800.



You asked me to give you information concerning one Tsuneo Deguchi, Route 2, Box 2995, Sacramento, California;

About November, 1940, Mr. Deguchi placed an order with us for a "Caterpillar" 15 tractor, Killefer disc and Killefer combination unit, the total sale, including sales tax, amounting to slightly over \$1400.00. By December, 1941, he had paid this contract down to \$627.00. After the down payment of \$360.00 the first payment was due July 1, 1941, in the amount of \$350.00 of which he paid one-half promptly, the other half being carried forward to November. On December 1st another payment of \$350.00 fell due, and this is still past due.

We wrote Mr. Deguchi some letters, sent him notices and made four or five calls out there endeavoring to find out what could be done. We received a very odd story concerning relatives coming back from San Francisco, and we left an invitation for him to come into the office and talk things over. Nothing having happened, and he having failed to present an appearance, on March 24th we sent our truck out and picked up this equipment, and on March 25th he came into the office. Mr. Pahl's memorandum of the conversation at that time is as follows:

"Came in to see why we picked up their tractor, disc, etc. Explained to them that they did not keep their promises and we picked it up so they would come in and get their account in shape. Will be in soon and advise what can be done. Told them we would hold the equipment for 30 days."

What can be done from now on to reinstate Mr. Deguchi remains up to him; we are willing to work things out with him, but his record has not been good even going back as far as July of last year, and since December 1st when the other note fell due has been considerably worse. Under the circumstances we felt there was nothing else for us to do to protect our interests.



Gentlemen:

On Saturday, May 16th, one of the families to come before my desk in Gilroy was a Filipino named Sebastian Dequin married to an American-Japanese woman named Haru with a United States born 3 year old son named Dan, the family number being 30,556. The Filipino was middle-aged and the Japanese woman was quite young and apparently without friends among the Japanese people.

The Filipino husband insisted that he must go into the camp in order to take care of his wife and child and of course, this was arranged for him by his signing a declaration and a waiver at the desk of the Army's representative, Lieutenant Morrison.

The Filipino did not wish to go to camp nor did he wish his family to go there, which was natural. He wanted to know could I do something to help him? He is a very small lease farmer near Gilroy.

We had not had a case like this before and neither had the camp manager in Salinas. The lieutenant did not seem to think anything could be done about it so I telephoned first to the Provost Marshal at San Jose then to the Residio in San Francisco. I finally talked to Major Steele there who said that there was no present method of making exceptions for the evacuation of the Japanese now in the area and that if the husband wished to go, he had the right to do so with the Army's permission which could be obtained by signing the proper papers.

This decision was communicated to Mr. Dequin and we also notified the camp manager here, Mr. E. A. Rose, that this mixed family was coming so that he could make the best arrangements possible under the circumstances, as he had asked us to do so.


Relevant to your letter of March 23rd informing us as to your alien status and property problems, we would suggest the following procedure:

Presumably, most of your business relationships are with the Bank of America and we feel that as they are conversant with your affairs and have dealt with you in the past, they would be a more appropriate agent to expedite any problems that you may have, than the Federal Reserve Bank. If, in your opinion, there is another bank or business organization with whom you have dealt which is more familiar with your property problems, we recommend that such parties be contacted.

From your letter, it appears that you misapprehend our status in helping evacuees. Our function, primarily, has to do with people who are leaving restricted areas, voluntarily or otherwise, but who do not come under the general classification of enemy aliens. The custodianship and jurisdiction for the problems facing enemy aliens are delegated to the office of the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation with local headquarters in the Hotel Whitcomb, San Francisco.

We would, therefore, suggest that you address a letter to the Alien Property Custodian at this address and outline briefly to them your major problems.

I ask for your immediate intervention on the matter to have, for the present, frozen all 1st Mortgages and all modernization loans. Be established

3/ in account with Bank of America (Fillmore - Port Branch) where is my present checking account as a Trust fund for the administration of status as follows:

- 1°) all payments due to me from rentals be paid direct to bank from tenants
- 2°) Mrs Barnwell living in my property at 1523 Golden Gate Ave and working at Speckels Companies, 1 Pine Street, has collected rents on my behalf from Feb 22 to date in \$290⁰⁰ less authorized payments for which no report has been given, presumably about \$175⁰⁰ - Balance in her hand \$115 (about) to be deposited by her to said account. (I am asking her now to give statement of collections and payments, balance deposited).

from such fund current monthly payments be made as follows:

- 1°) On the 5th of each month pay car installment in \$36⁰⁰ to Bank of America (Fill-Port Br.)

PROBLEM:- Nakamura family wants something around \$150:00 for work done and Dusterberry willing to pay \$75:00/.

Action taken:* Suggested they were too close to a settlement for any

further argument; further suggested they meet later in the day, both conceding a little and report back to this office 4/14/42.

Dusterberry returned today at 1:40 P.M. stating deal all closed to satisfaction of all. Displayed receipt signed by Nakamura in the sum of \$100:00 which closes deal.
