


Spot check inventory of Santa Berbara werehouse

Pursuant to the suggestion contained in your memorandum of March 24, 1942, I have interviewed Mr. William B. Acton, representing the plaintiff, and Mr. Marshall Leahey, representing the defendant, and have obtained from each of them an oral statement of their respective contentions. I have also examined the letter dated March 21, 1942, addressed to your office by Mr. Acton.

In answer to the contentions made by Mr. Acton in his letter of March 21, the defendant alleges that as of January 1, 1941, Nishimura agreed with Mengola that he would perform services in selling rice on a straight drawing account basis of \$50 a week and that at that time it was agreed that Nishimura would not receive any further commissions on sales. Commissions then due Nishimura were paid during January 1941, but during the remainder of the year no commissions were paid because none were due. It is admitted that Nishimura repeatedly requested an accounting and that Mengola and the other officers of the rice milling company repeatedly stated that no accounting would be made because the drawing account covered full compensation. There was no written contract, no witnesses to the arrangement, and no statement of account has ever been prepared.

It is my opinion that, regardless of the merits of the contentions made by the respective parties, a meritorious dispute exists, and that this case is not one in relation to which freezing control should be exercised. I have so advised Mr. Acton by telephone. He stated that he appreciated our interest in the matter and could see the propriety of our position. He also agreed with me that, if his application for the appointment of a receiver was meritorious and was granted, such proceeding would fulfill substantially the same office as a freezing order. I believe that you can close the file in this case.

Attached is a letter addressed to us by Mr. Nishimura's attorney under date of March 21, 1942, which is self-explanatory.

Nishimura is asking us to assist him in making a settlement with the defendant who is represented by Mr. Marshall Lahey of this city. Obviously Mr. Nishimura's position is not a particularly clear one, but he reports that the parties have come very close to settlement on the basis of \$5,000 to Nishimura, together with the assumption of other indebtedness looking toward a total settlement of \$3,000. Negotiations were proceeding smoothly until this action was filed and have now broken down completely. Nishimura is moving for the appointment of a receiver although the motion has not yet been served.

The question arises as to how far we should proceed in affirmative assistance where the position of the plaintiff is not particularly clear.

It is believed that we would be willing to discuss the situation with the defendants through their attorney in the hope of pointing the road toward some equitable settlement, but would like your consideration of the matter for discussion.

Pursuant to your suggestion at our conference Thursday forenoon that we reduce the substance of our stayements to writing, we submit the following:

- 1. James T. Mishimura is an American citizen.
- 2. For some period of time he has been engaged in the rice business. In 1938 he entered into an agreement with GOERGE MENGOLA and GROWERS RICE MILLING COMPANY under which he was to purchase rice from the growers, sales were to be financed and profits divided equally between them. Nishimura was to receive a drawing account of \$35.00 per week. The other parties provided him an office adjoining their's, together with telephone service, etc. At the beginning of 1940, the weekly drawing account was increased to \$50.00.
- 3. No accounting has ever been made to lishimura. It might be suggested that Nishimura's share of the profits about equalled his drawing account. However, the outbreak of the war in the Pacific suddenly shot up the price of all rice. At the time war was declared these parties had on hand 70,000 bags of rice. The price increased by \$1.00 per bag. This resulted in an unearned increment of \$70,000.00, of which Nishimura was entitled to one-half.
- 4. Mengola, as President of Growers Rice Milling Company, when asked for an accounting, for the first time denied any agreement for an equal division of profits. We then filed suit for an accounting in our Superior Court.
- 5. We ask your office to assist us in preserving this American citizen's rights in this matter.

I am attaching the letter Mr. Nishio sent to Mr. R. R. Zellick, of the Anglo California National Bank; wherein, you will see that the flat has been rented according to Mr. George Watson. The Anglo California National Bank mentioned that this house is still vacant. Mr. Nishio mentioned that he knew Mr. Watson very well and that the latter visits Mr. Nishio very often at this Center. According to Mr. Watson, the third floor has been rented in the middle of June; the second floor, the first part of June; the front part of the first floor in the middle of June. It is apparent that the Anglo California National Bank appointed Tesluck Co., Real Estate Agent on Sutter between Fillmore and Steiner Streets, San Francisco, to take care of our property. The company does not disclose the entire business to the Bank.

Since our evacuation is set from September 15 to the end of September, I am hurriedly writing you to have this property looked into by you.

We have your letter of the 25th, and hereafter you shall receive a statement from us at regular intervals with respect to your property.

As you have placed certain restrictions as to the type of tenant for your property, we have been unable to rent the vacant flats up to this writing. The only tenants available in the district are Negroes, and as more and more Negroes are moving into the district, it is becoming increasingly impossible to obtain tenants of the Caucasian race. In many of the flats and properties under our control, we have obtained satisfactory Negro tenants, and should you feel, at any time, you would be willing to rent to this class of tenant, just so inform us.

Mr. Watson is living in the room about which he spoke to you, and we had presumed that he was receiving the rent free in view of his services in looking out for your property to the extent of preventing any vandalism or damage. If you wish to write him in reference to a charge, we would suggest it be made not more than \$5.00 to \$7.50 per month.




