Dear Mr. Bold:

Since receipt of your letter yesterday morning asking a complete check-up on all interview records involving Evacuee property interests, we have contacted all except five, and letters have gone out to them, so we should have all records completed within a few days.

Contact by phone and in a few instances by person has revealed the fact that practically all have made disposition of their property interests. And the few cases pending indicate they will be completed within a few days.

Mr Randall, of the F.S.A. just advises me that he has successfully transferred 761 acres out of a total of 1175 under his jurisdiction, and has about 200 acres pending which should be completed soon.

In accordance with your letter we will follow up each interview case to its successful conclusion, and make final report thereon.


SUBJECT: CONTRABAND ITEMS.

On January 3, 1942, the Office of the United States Attorney, sent to all state and local Police authorities, a notice calling their attention to the fact that the President had, by his proclamations of December 7 and 8, 1941, directed in the interests of national safety that alien enemies should not possess or use various items, such as firearms, weapons, ammunition, short-wave radio sets, signal devices, etc. The notice stated further it was necessary to require alien enemies to deposit such prohibited articles with law enforcement agencies and asked for the help and cooperation of the local police authorities throughout the country.

Public Proclamation No. 3, dated March 24, 1942, issued by J. L. DeWitt, Lieutenant General, U.S. Army, carries a provision that after March 31, 1942, no persons of Japanese ancestry shall have in his possession similar items.

We have determined locally that in many instances after the first order was given, Japanese aliens delivered such contraband to American citizens of Japanese ancestry, and the question therefore arises as to the amount of such contraband which has not as yet been deposited with state and local Police authorities.

In order that we might better be able to visualize this condition, we ask that each of our Field Representatives contact such law enforcement agencies in their particular territory, ascertaining in a general way the amount of such contraband now in their hands, and report their findings to the Office of the Federal Reserve Bank with which they are affiliated. Any information developed in instances where the amount on deposit would seem to indicate that there was still a considerable quantity remaining in the hands of U.S. citizens of Japanese ancestry, will be of great assistance.





Complying with instruction letter #7 regarding contraband items held by Japanese aliens, I have contacted George Franzen, Chief Criminal Deputy, Orange County Sherriff's Office and Captain Lawrence Rhodes, Intelligence Officer, United States Air Corp Replacement Center, Santa Ana.

These officers advised me that in their opinion no contraband items are being held by American born Japanese. A large number of radios, cameras and guns and other contraband material is held in the local Sherriff's office, and City Police of all communities in the County have also made a collection of contraband goods.

In two or three instances, it is known that alien Japanese have delivered contraband goods to American citizens for safe-keeping. Police authorities are making a check on these cases to determine that the goods can not be recovered by the alien owners.







The latest Japanese census figure in San Diego County discloses a population of 1,982, of which 711 are registered aliens. The balance of 1,271 indicate Japanese of the second generation and they would most likely be U.S. citizens. The great majority of these citizens are children of aliens, and are living in family groups with the registered aliens. In such cases the Federal Bureau Of Investigation has seized contraband items from the entire family, however, the local law enforcement agencies feel that there is considerable contraband items still in the possession of Japanese.



Some radios have been dismantled as far as the short wave connections were concerned and returned to the Japanese not included in the above tabulations.

All of the above were turned in voluntarily. No drive was put on in this County towards enforcement of the original order by any agency. Confidentially, the Sheriff informed me off the record that he would judge less than 50% of the items ~~listed~~ had been actually turned in. He has information that a good many guns were turned over to citizen Japanese by aliens and not as yet turned in in pursuance of Public Proclamation No. 3 of Gen. DeWitt. Immediately after Pearl Harbor, there was a very definite spread of violence amongst the Filipinos in the Valley against all Japanese and several Japanese were killed. As a result, most of the Japanese who owned guns kept them handy for self protection (not openly of course) which is the reason for so many items still out.



Sir:

The above letter was received this morning and I immediately contacted the sheriff of Ventura County. He gave me the attached invoice of contraband articles which have been surrendered to him or picked up by him from local Japanese up to this date. He believes that while there may be some other contraband articles in the hands of American-born Japanese that it would only be a small amount.

In a telephone conversation with the Chief of Police of the City of Ventura he says he has a few articles that have been turned over to him but not many. This is natural since these Japanese would probably go to the sheriff before going to the Chief of Police.

The Chief of Police of Santa Paula, California says he has quite a lot of contraband articles and that he will make me a list of them and mail it to me. The Chief of Police of Oxnard says he has also a few articles but not many and indicated that he might send me a list of them.

The Chiefs of Police of these three towns seem to believe that there probably is a good deal of contraband in the hands of Ventura County American-born Japanese. As soon as I get these additional lists above mentioned I will send them in along with any other information that I may have in the matter.




