The Coast Fishing Company owes a balance of \$1,598.44 to the brother of the case name who has departed from this country.

Incident to settlement, the Japanese making the inquiry, informs us that he has expended some \$2,000.00 on behalf of the brother, presently in Japan, and an agreement between the two parties is to collect the amount due from the Coast Fishing Company and apply it on this advance. He has no document in his possession which would constitute authority from his brother in Japan to collect the amount now due from the Coast Fishing Company.

This matter was discussed by telephone with Mr. Drayton of the San Pedro office, and we informed him that unless the brother, residing here, could prevail upon the Coast Fishing Company to apply for a special license to pay the amount of money still owing to him for the account of his brother, there are no further steps to be taken. This verifies the decision reached by Mr. Drayton.



Perhaps you will kindly inquire for my family and friends if the townspeople of Las Vegas would protest to American born Japanese and their parents ~~to~~ resettle on their own property about five miles outside of the city, or forward this letter to someone who could advise me on the matter.

This particular property of 160 acres is owned by Tagami and Ogimachi who purchased the land some 25 years ago. Both families have sons serving in the U. S. Army. (To give you some idea of the location, this is part of the description:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$:N $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 5 T 21 R 62)

Since San Pedro, our present home, is in the prohibited zone with evacuation notices due any time, our only resource is to turn to the land which my brothers own.

If the town has no bitter objections as to the people of Japanese lineage coming to its vicinity, we want to leave here voluntarily, without undue trouble and expense to the government at this time. We plan farming for vegetables and as my friends are experienced farmers we would like to ask them along.

Your earliest possible answer to our urgent need would be most gratefully appreciated. I am enclosing an air mail stamp for this reply.
