Your letter of April 13th addressed to Mr. Ernest Sutton, Riverside, California, was referred to Mr. F. C. Bold, Federal Reserve Bank representative at this office. Mr. Bold has turned this correspondence over to me.

I talked to Mr. W. Palmer Fisher, the attorney for the Affiliated Merchants in Los Angeles, who represents the creditors of the evacuee, Harry Nakamura, P. O. Box 164, Indio, California. A Mr. Hall is handling this particular litigation for Mr. Fisher. He informed me that it would be impossible for the truck or automobile to be released to Mr. Nakamura without some plan of liquidation of the debt. A release of this equipment would be considered if a satisfactory plan for repayment of the debts, for which this equipment has been taken as security, is submitted.

You state that there are thirty-three acres of very high-priced speculative crops, but do not give the names and acreages. If you can give me some definite information with a workable plan for the repayment of these debts, I shall be glad to try to assist you in this matter. It seems to me that perhaps the better thing to do would be to get a satisfactory replacement operator on this property.

I have in my hands this morning a report concerning interests of a prospective evacuee, Harry Nakamura of P.O. Box 164, Indio, California. Mr. Nakamura both owns and leases land, has 33 acres of very high priced speculative crops. His present crops are financed to the extent of \$2500.00 with Tocchini & Dianda while another company by name of Citizens Produce Company claims \$2644.98 from past due finances. The latter Los Angeles firm evidently an American born Japanese corporation, has been forced to evacuate and has turned its accounts over to Attorney W. F. Fisher (354 South Spring Street, Los Angeles, phone Michigan 8783X) representing the Affiliated Merchants (Los Angeles) which is a collection agency. The action number is 474951, Superior Court, Los Angeles County.

Accordingly, a 1½ ton GMC truck and a 1938 Plymouth car were immediately attached and impounded. This action concerns me from a farm operations viewpoint in that it has deprived Mr. Nakamura of transportation facilities in handling of crop produce and farm supplies. It will no doubt concern you from a custodial point of view.

In my opinion, this impounding action is a definite obstruction to the war effort and should be corrected immediately. If there is anything further that you wish me to do, please advise.

Reference is made to your interview report dated March 26 in the name of Rauchi H. Ooka. It is noted that the status of the Japanese alien as to his re-entry into the United States and whether he is operating under a Treasury License is unknown, and that your advice was to the effect that there were no restrictions in dealing with Japanese.

We presume you understand that this would not apply to a blocked national of Japan. That is, a national who has entered the United States since June 17th, 1940 or has been out of this country since that date. In such a case it would be necessary to apply for a specific license, TFE-1 (revised) with the Federal Reserve Bank in San Francisco in order to engage in any transaction such as liquidating his assets.



Dear Mr. Button:

Referring to your letter of April 24, 1942 relative to a demand made by the H.O.L.C. on Mrs. Johanna Yonkers for past due payments on her loan, wherein they threaten to foreclose unless past due payments are brought up to date within ninety days.

From the facts in your letter, it would appear that the H.O.L.C. is strictly within their rights and can, if they so desire, demand that the past due payments be brought up to date, and if not, institute foreclosure proceedings. It would appear that Mrs. Yonkers should either consider selling or leasing the property in order to protect her equity.

Reference is made to your letter dated March 17, 1942 requesting information as to the time limit in the evacuation of Japanese from the military areas and the availability of other labor to replace the Japanese in your locality.

We have no information beyond that appearing in the press from time to time with respect to when evacuation must be accomplished, and are unable, therefore, to provide you with any advice in that regard.

We naturally appreciate your problem and regret that we are unable to offer the information you desire.

As to the availability of replacement labor, we believe that the Farm Security Administration is dealing with that situation and feel that it would be helpful if you contacted the representative of that agency, who, together with a representative of this bank and of the Federal Security Agency, has offices in the office of the U.S. Employment Service at 3409 Main Street, Riverside, California. It may be possible for you to obtain additional information from that source.

We are referring copies of your letter and of our reply to our Los Angeles Branch for the benefit of itself and our Riverside Field Representative, as well as to the Farm Security Representative at this office, in order that they may be apprised of your situation.

Gentlemen:

Replying to your letter of the 14th, will say that we will do all that we can to assist the evacuees in the disposal of their property if they are compelled to leave our section.

The few Japanese in our district have no property other than their interest in their crops which they have well started. We would even be willing to buy their crops ourselves if we could have any assurance that we could secure labor to bring them to completion. As you know, it is very hard to get Americans to do the work that these boys do with such crops as onions, which is the main crop here. An American wants about twice the money the producer can afford to pay for this kind of work.

According to the last information we had, this district was marked as a restricted district, but we have had no information as to what the restrictions would consist. If you have any definite information as to whether or not the Japanese here will be evacuated we would appreciate your advising us, as it would make considerable difference in our dealings. The prospects are that the Japanese in our vicinity will produce more than 100,000 bags of 100 pounds of onions this year and, of course, in time of war food is one of the essentials.

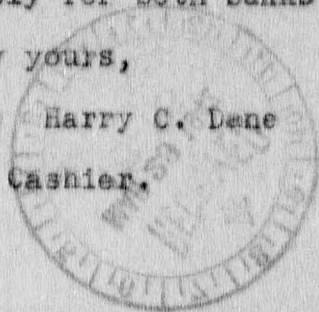
Any information you can give us as to labor to take the place of the Japanese if they are moved, and whether or not they will be moved from this district will be appreciated.







SUBJECT: Storage of property in advance of controlled
evacuation operations.

Dear Sir;

This office has encouraged the Evacuees to sell their furniture if they could dispose of it at a reasonable price or to arrange for their own storage.

Mr. England the Public Assistance Worker of the Social Security Board at this office who has taken a social record of practically every Evacuee calling at this office, states that in his opinion, quite a percentage have either sold or provided storage for their furniture, others have prepared as much of their furniture for storage as they could get along without until evacuation.

Mr. England states that he has not made an actual survey and that his opinion is based on what the Evacuees have told him.

As to how successful we would be in persuading the Evacuees to provide a central storage at their own expense until actual evacuation is started, we could not venture an opinion, until we have talked to some of the evacuees.

Mr. Paul R. Frink of the W.F.A. at the W.C.C.A. office in Indio where the Federal Reserve does not have a Field Representative has contacted this office several times about the storage of furniture.

He states there are about 30 Japanese families in the vicinity of Indio who are not opposed to providing a central storage at their own expense until evacuation takes place.
