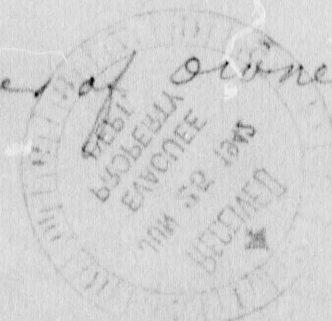

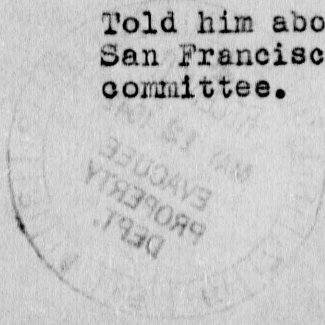

Action Taken: We informed Mr. Robinson that at the time of evacuation, all Japanese were informed by the Federal Reserve Bank of the storage facilities made available to them and at that time had the privilege of making their choice of storing privately or accepting the facilities provided by the Federal Reserve Bank. Also, that at the present time we had no provisions to accept property which had been privately stored by the Japanese.

We have no lands listed for sale in this district by the evacuees but it is our understanding that there may be some opportunities available in Santa Clara County.

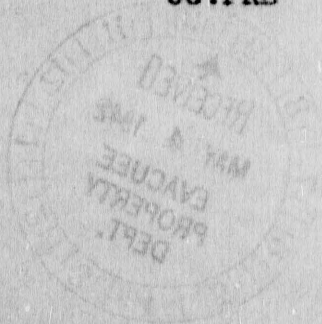
We would suggest that you write to the representative of the Farm Security Administration in charge of Japanese evacuation at the W. C. C. A. office in San Jose.

Reference is made to your letter dated March 15, 1942 regarding the leasehold interest of your father, R. Ruffino, and his partner, E. Bonino.

We believe it is highly questionable as to whether the evacuation order would excuse a lessee from his leasehold obligations and the responsibilities incident to them, but suggest that your attorney will be in a position to provide you with more detailed information along that line, as well as the information you request regarding the necessity of service of notice from the lessors. Where evacuation is in prospect, we have been suggesting that lessees endeavor to work out some equitable arrangement with their lessors and so far as possible endeavor to find some means of protecting any equities they may enjoy in the properties involved.

We are uncertain from the subject matter of your letter whether the lease has already been surrendered or whether such a step is merely in prospect. If the latter is the case you may wish to explore the possibilities of finding someone to take over the leasehold before any steps are taken toward evacuation, inasmuch we understand that no time limit has yet been set in that connection.

The Evacuee Property Department of this bank is establishing a Field Representative at the office of the U.S. Employment Service, 7 Natividad Street, Salinas, California. We suggest that you may wish to contact that office for a further discussion of your problem. A copy of your letter and of our reply are going forward to that office for its information.

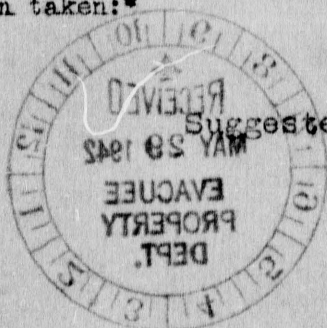
