

We are including in this lot the enclosed letter from Mr. L. S. Wetmore, Manager of Libby, McNeill & Libby Canal Ranch at Thornton, California.

It is interesting to know that of forty-six Japanese People evacuated from this Ranch, over one-half of them were born on the Ranch, and they represent more of a complete ranch family unit than may be found in most organizations of the kind.

With reference to Mr. Wetmore's fourth item in the letter, he has just reported that Charles Sofye sold his 1942 Ford Super Delux Sedan to Albert A. Maria for \$1000, the purchaser assuming Pacific Finance Company contract of \$869 and paying Sofye \$131 cash for his equity.

If you would wish to have forms (S-5055) made out for each of the cases mentioned by Mr. Wetmore, we suggest that you so instruct us when you return copy of the letter.





No real problem yet, but considerable complications may arise as a result of the following.

Mr. Donnally was here this morning. He telephoned the Manager of Tule Lake Center. Then told Tom Yego and other Japanese to forget restrictions on baggage (150 lbs. per adult) as recited in Exclusion Order #102. Told them could take sewing and washing machines, refrigerators, and trunks - no limit on weight or size. Told them to broadcast the news.

Result - Japanese are rearranging plans for baggage and storage, planning to take almost all belongings. If successful, our storage problem will be nil. 



This evacues called upon our Bayward, California, field office under date of April 18, 1942 with reference to certain delinquent monthly payments due under a lease between herself as the owner and Mesers. Grossman and Lerman. This lease was terminated to the satisfaction of both parties through the efforts of our Hayward field representative. We subsequently learned that this property is unimproved, is situated in the tire and automobile section of Cakland near 26th Street and Broadway, and that an offer was made for the property of \$2500 a few months ago, which was declined by the evacues. There is a remote possibility that an offer in excess of the amount due under foreclosure sale can be secured within the next few days, in which event it will be transmitted to you promptly.

We are also enclosing a copy of a notice of trustee's sale and registered mail notice sent by the Security Trust & Savings Bank at San Diego, California, as trustee.

Two daughters with monthly incomes of \$80.00 each have been suspended by the State of California. Also, the son has been suspended from a defense job, stopping all possible means of revenue for the family.

Action Taken:

Arranged for relief through Social Service for their requirements until evacuation.

Mr. Levy, attorney for Western States Life Insurance Company, explained Action taken:* by telephone to Mr. Mahoney that at present rate of commissions on business written and renewals, it would take six months to clear present advances. However, because of his willingness to cooperate, he arranged for a further advance of \$150.00 which was paid to Stanley Sugiyama for clearing up bills. This payment constitutes the only funds available through any source for the family excepting through Social Service.
