Memoranda Report,

To Mr. Balth ~~and~~ Mr. Watkins:-

Friday P.M. Mr. A. B. Leacock and I saw the local realtor, Mr. Howard Sater from whom Mr. Leacock leased a very desirable building for storage - 1025 Chapala St. Ample space and practically fire-proof. We then contacted and engaged a trucking firm -- employed a warehousman for a few days, possibly a week at \$7.50 per day. He will lay out the floor in "lot sizes" and paint the large front windows to above eye level so passersby can't see in. I will have lights turned on Monday. Have one or two good laborers spoken for at 5.00 per day to help store goods as they are brought in. Probably need only one. Will keep eye open for dependable night watchman (if we need him) who will sleep in bldg.

Don't believe will have more than a dozen cars left with us, possibly not that many. All along I've advised Japanese to sell some. Don't think there'll be as much household goods as was anticipated either. If not and you later want to bring some down from Santa Maria etc, there will have quite a bit of room for it.

Have been very busy and do not think there will be many unresolved problems or loose ends by the final day. Gordon Lantz, Jewell etc. -- will make proper type written report tomorrow or Monday.

Finally learned that Russell Bevins, Director of War Production Board, Office of Defense Transportation, Federal Building, Los Angeles has supervision over trucks. I called him long distance, the Abee paying the charge. Mr. Bevins said that if these people would make affidavit that they have to evacuate and file it with the Santa Barbara manager for the California Highway Department that Sacramento would permit the transfer of a truck under these circumstances.
