To all United States Employment Service offices issuing travel permits pending further clarification following instructions should be observed by all USESpersonnel issuing travel permits and conflicting advice from other sources except only Provost Marshall disregarded:

(1) Travel more than five miles for purpose of effecting bons fide change of residence within non-curfew hours except non-stop travel on common carriers for long distances may be authorized (a) for German and Italian aliens if destination not within any of areas prohibited by Attorney General without regard to whether applicant can show means of support or desirable plan for living at destination (b) For Japanese if destination not outside military area No. 1 and not in any of areas evacuated by attorney general or army and if applicant is not living in area then being evacuated under army order, without regard to questions of means of support. etc. (2) Travel within non-curriew hours of more than five miles for German and Italian aliens and Japanese to transact business preparatory to evacuation or because of personal emergency such as family illness or death or to secure medical service from regular physician may be authorized provided it is shown that request is bona fide and clear need for such travel exists but care must be exercised not to authorize travel for purely social purposes or to facilitate movement of traveling salesmen or collectors beyond limits of community or immediate locality of residence. General Dewitt tomorrow will issue the following proclamation implementing form WDCPM five (application for exemption for military evacuations) wherewith you are already supplied "to thepeople within the states of Washington Oregon California Montana Idaho Nevada Utah and Arizona and the public generally: whereas by public proclamation number one dated March two nineteen forty two this headquarters there were designated and established military areas numbers three four five and six and zones thereof and whereas the present situation within these military areas and zones requires as a matter of military necessity the establishment of certain regulations as set forth hereinafter: now therefore I J. L. Dewitt Licutement General United States Army by virtue of the authority vested in me by the president of the United States and by the secretary of War and my powers and perogatives as commanding General Western Defense Command do hereby declare and establish the following regulations covering the conduct to be observed by all alien Japanese all alien Germans all alien Italians and all persons of Japanese ancestry residing or being within the military areas above described: prior to and during the period of exclusion and evacuation of certain persons or classes of persons from prescribed military areas and zones, persons otherwise subject thereto but who came within one or more of the classes specified in A B C D E and F following may make written application for exemption from such exclusion and evacuation. Application form WDCPM five has been prepared for that purpose and copies thereof may be procured from any United States Post Office or United States Employment Service office in the Western Defense Command by persons who deem themselves entitled to exemption . The following classes of persons are hereby authorized to be exempted from exclusion and evacuation upon the furnishing of satisfactory proof as specified in form WDCPM five: A German and Italian Aliens seventy or more years of age. B In the case of German and Italian aliens, the parent, wife, husband, child of (or other person who resides in the household and whose support is wholly dependent upon) an officer, enlisted man or commissioned murse on active duty im the army of the United States or any component thereof, United States Navy, United States Marine Corps, or United States Coast Guard. C In the case of German and Italian aliens the parent wife husband child of (or other person who resides in the household and whose support is wholly dependent upon) an officer, enlisted man or commissioned nurse who on or since December 7, 1941 died in line of duty with the armed services of the United States indicated in the preceding subparagraph. D German and Italian aliens awaiting naturalization who had filed a petition for naturalization and who had paid the filing fee therefor in a court of competent jurisdiction on or before December 7, 1941. E. Patients in hospital or confined elsewhere and too ill or incapacited to be removed therefrom without danger to life.

Inmates of orphanages and the totally deaf dumb or blind. The applicant for exemption will be required to furnish the kinds of proof specified in form WDCPM five in support of the application. The certificate of exemption from compliance with curfew regulations, subject however to such future proclamations or orders in the premises as may from time to time be issued by this headquarters. The person to whoma such exemption from evacuation and curfew has been granted shall thereafter be entitled to reside in any portion of any prohibited area, including those areas heretofore declared prohibited by the Attorney General of the United States." Where above quoted instructaions vary from form WDCPM five these instructions prevail. New proclamation identified as "Fublic Proclamation Number Five". Please issue form WDCPM five only to persons clearly within classifications outlined. All others must conform strictly to previously issued proclamations awaiting some future order or permission for any medification. Interpretation of new proclamation solely military function to be performed by army officials or their designated representative.

It was determined at conference with general DeWitt that full responsibility and authority in field exemptions licensing and exemptions from exclusion orders and curfew regulations is imposed in provost marshall Western Defense Command. This office will attempt to keep you currently advised on developments all interpretations all exceptions and licensing other than in individual cases meanwhile we will refer to provost marshall all inquiries received paragraph herewith follow approved answers several questions:

- Q. Sholesale Produce dealers Sacramento regularly receive deliveries from Japanese producers live more than five miles from city. Producers usually call on two or three wholesale dealers then return to their farms. No curfew angle involved. May these deliveries continue?
- A. Yes.
- Q. Japanese in grocery businesses who sought permission to make rounds of their debtors to collect outstanding bills been told would have to use white collectors. No curiew angle involved. May they make their own collections?
- A. Yes.
- . Same may Japanese collectors make one or two trips with white collectors to acquaint them with customers and routes?
- A. Yes.
- Q. Area around Sacramento has been dependent upon Japanese grocery and fish delivery routes in areas where no local stores located. Both Japanese and white customers affected. Such routes usually travels four or five towns.total distance twenty five to thirty miles. No curfew angle. Can these routes continue?
- A. Yes.
- 6. Some enemy aliens and citizens Japanese ancestry wish to travel more than five miles to buy food supplies. Is this premitted?
- A. No unless there are no stores there or within five miles and then only if making purchases while on normal business trips from homes to places of employment.
- Q. May enemy aliens and citizens Japanese ancestry travel more than five miles from homes if employed as traveling salesment
- A. NO.
- Q. May enemy aliens or citizens Japanese Ancestry travel more than five miles if employed as gardeners traveling throughout county?
- A. Yes, if they travel incident to carrying on their work in their own community and among their own former and regular petrons.

Please arrange now so confidential nature such advance notice will be protected. Compulsory registration for enforced evacuation will be undertaken by control centers manned by present WCCA officials plus representatives public health service. Persons Japanese ancestry should be encouraged meanwhile to place their affairs in order preparatory evacuation. Please make sure they understand they need not sell personal property unless desired but can store it under protection Federal Reserve Bank without charge. Todays interpretations include following.

- Q. Can we authorize travel between five miles limit for Japanese or enemy aliens meeting prospective buyers of land, machinery, etc?
- A. Yes.
- Q. If so who will issue authorization and on what forms?
- A. Employment service representative issue using form PM2 Revised indicating round trip.
- Q. Also explain authorization plans and forms for necessary travel in connection with changes residence within or without five mile limits of present address and within military area one.
- A. Use Forms PM1 PM2 just as before. Boundary military area one cannot be crossed without special permission military authorities.
- Q. Is form WDCPM five to be used now for all exemptions from evacuation and curfew?
- A. Only for classifications outlined in proclamation five sent you yesterday.
- travel from ranch to ranch.
- A. Yes.
- Q. Can WCCA office issue permit for Japanese woman attend funeral her husband distance more than five miles from her home but allwithin military area one. No curfew angle.
- A. Yes (This is modification of earlier ruling)
- Q. Can German or Italian enemy alien obtain permit to change residence place in community or within military area one?
- A. Yes using forms PML PM2 issued by Employment Service Representative
- Q. Does definition cameras as contraband include heavy nonportable studio portrait machines which previously exempted on individual application by United States Attorneys.

REFERENCE:

Reference is made to our letter of August 6, 1942 wherein we requested you to proceed in accordance with a memorandum from the Wartime Civil Control Administration dated August 3, 1942.

We are enclosing a copy of a memorandum dated August 29, 1942 forwarded to us by the Western Defense Command and Fourth Army signed by Wm. A. Boekel, Lt. Col. F. A. Asst. A. C. of S. The original memorandum to us was accompanied by War Department Form SP-41, 4/16/42 entitled "Submission of Proposal for Requisitioning and Disposal of Property under Act, October 16, 1941 as amended". Of the thirteen questions contained in this form it is only necessary that we furnish the answers to numbers 1 to 4 inclusive. We have prepared and are in the process of printing the entire form. Questions 5 to 13 inclusive will be answered in a uniform manner and will therefore be printed into the form. We are enclosing a supply of the page containing the questions to be answered by this bank. It is necessary that the original and six copies be executed for the War Department and therefore you should prepare a total of eight copies for each vehicle in order that one copy may be retained in your office.

It is intended to requisition all the cars remaining in our possession even though the registered or legal owner might be located in Japan, which would be divulged in the last part of the second question opposite the caption "Last known address", and question 3.

The written memorandum referred to in paragraph 5 of the Wartime Civil Control Administration directive will be uniform in all instances, therefore no action is necessary on your part.

As quickly as questions 1 to 4 can be completed we will appreciate your forwarding the original and six copies for each vehicle to this office in order that they may be properly assembled and submitted to the attesting officer with as little delay as possible.

You will observe that if a voluntary sale of the vehicle is made to the Army in the interim the requisition may be cancelled.

In referring to paragraph ll of the memorandum we shall be pleased to have you inform us as early as possible of instances where the appraised value of the vehicle is less than the amount due the legal owner.

Prompt attention to the completion of these forms has been urged by the Wartime Civil Control Administration and we are anxious to cooperate with them to the fullest extent possible.

MEMORANDUM TO: Federal Reserve Bank of San Francisco

SUBJECT: Requisitioning of Vehicles Owned by Japanese Evacuees

- 1. It is desired that the Federal Reserve Bank of San Francisco take immediate steps to acquire without previous notice, at the appraised value and without bonus, the remaining Japanese-owned vehicles now under custody of the Federal Reserve Bank.
- 2. The Army, through the Bank, will requisition the aforesaid vehicles. The authority to requisition is exercised under the Act of August 16, 1941 (55 Stat.742).
- 3. In order to requisition the vehicles, it is necessary that certain forms be executed covering each vehicle. (Submission of "Proposal for Requisitioning and Disposal of Property Under Act of October 16, 1941, As Amended.") Pursuant to previous discussion and arrangement these forms will be mimeographed by the Bank, the attached form of which is an example. Information under paragraphs 5 to 13, inclusive, is a repetition in each case and may be included in the mimeographing process in order to simplify and expedite the completion of same.
- 4. The appropriate information concerning each vehicle or owner will be entered by the Bank in paragraphs 1 to 4, inclusive.
- 5. The Bank will attach a written memorandum referring to (e) setting forth the fact that the individual owner was contacted previously and that an effort was made to induce the owner to sell the vehicle voluntarily.
- 6. The original and six copies will be executed for each vehicle requisitioned.
- 7. When the forms have been completed, they will be forwarded to Wartime Civil Control Administration for proper dispatch to the War Department, Services of Supply, Washington, D. C.
- 8. The requisition itself is signed by the Under-Secretary of War, returned to Wartime Civil Control Administration, and dispatched to the Federal Reserve Bank for service on the holder of the property.

Subject: Requisitioning of Vehicles Owned by Japanese Evacuees 9. The owner may be served by registered mail and a receipt secured as evidence. 10. If a voluntary sale of the vehicle is made to the Army in the interim, the requisition may be cancelled. 11. Should the appraised value of the vehicle be less than the amount due the legal owner and if the legal owner elects to take possession of the vehicle in lieu of payment, the Bank is authorized to make such delivery upon his request. 12. When notice is served upon the owner, the Wartime Civil Control Administration will notify the Department of Motor Vehicles that the Army has requisitioned and taken possession of the vehicle, and that the records of that Department should be changed accordingly. 13. It is contemplated that payment for the property will be made by the Finance Office, U. S. Army, through the Inspection and Fiscal Division, Wartime Civil Control Administration. (Requisitioning of automobiles owned by Japanese evacuees.)

TFERENCE:

Reference is made to our letter of August 6, 1942 wherein we requested you to proceed in accordance with a memorandum from the Wartime Civil Control Administration dated August 3, 1942.

We are enclosing a copy of a memorandum dated August 29, 1942 forwarded to us by the Western Defense Command and Fourth Army signed by Wm. A. Boekel, Lt. Col. F. A. Asst. A. C. of S. The original memorandum to us was accompanied by War Department Form SP-41, 4/16/42 entitled "Submission of Proposal for Requisitioning and Disposal of Property under Act, October 16, 1941 as amended". Of the thirteen questions contained in this form it is only necessary that we furnish the answers to numbers 1 to 4 inclusive. We have prepared and are in the process of printing the entire form. Questions 5 to 13 inclusive will be answered in a uniform manner and will therefore be printed into the form. We are enclosing a supply of the page containing the questions to be answered by this bank. It is necessary that the original and six copies be executed for the War Department and therefore you should prepare a total of eight copies for each vehicle in order that one copy may be retained in your office.

It is intended to requisition all the cars remaining in our possession even though the registered or legal owner might be located in Japan, which would be divulged in the last part of the second question opposite the caption "Last known address", and question 3.

The written memorandum referred to in paragraph 5 of the Wartime Civil Control Administration directive will be uniform in all instances, therefore no action is necessary on your part.

As quickly as questions I to 4 can be completed we will appreciate your forwarding the original and six copies for each vehicle to this office in order that they may be properly assembled and submitted to the attesting officer with as little delay as possible.

You will observe that if a voluntary sale of the vehicle is made to the Army in the interim the requisition may be cancelled.

In referring to paragraph ll of the memorandum we shall be pleased to have you inform us as early as possible of instances where the appraised value of the vehicle is less than the amount due the legal owner.

Prompt attention to the completion of these forms has been urged by the Wartime Civil Control Administration and we are anxious to cooperate with them to the fullest extent possible.

MEMORANDUM TO: Federal Reserve Bank of San Francisco

SUBJECT: Requisitioning of Vehicles Owned by Japanese Evacuees

- 1. It is desired that the Federal Reserve Bank of San Francisco take immediate steps to acquire without previous notice, at the appraised value and without bonus, the remaining Japanese-owned vehicles now under custody of the Federal Reserve Bank.
- 2. The Army, through the Bank, will requisition the aforesaid vehicles. The authority to requisition is exercised under the Act of August 16, 1941 (55 Stat.742).
- 3. In order to requisition the vehicles, it is necessary that certain forms be executed covering each vehicle. (Submission of "Proposal for Requisitioning and Disposal of Property Under Act of October 16, 1941, As Amended.") Pursuant to previous discussion and arrangement these forms will be mimeographed by the Bank, the attached form of which is an example. Information under paragraphs 5 to 13, inclusive, is a repetition in each case and may be included in the mimeographing process in order to simplify and expedite the completion of same.
- 4. The appropriate information concerning each vehicle or owner will be entered by the Bank in paragraphs 1 to 4, inclusive.
- 5. The Bank will attach a written memorandum referring to (e) setting forth the fact that the individual owner was contacted previously and that an effort was made to induce the owner to sell the vehicle voluntarily.
- 6. The original and six copies will be executed for each vehicle requisitioned.
- 7. When the forms have been completed, they will be forwarded to Wartime Civil Control Administration for proper dispatch to the War Department, Services of Supply, Washington, D. C.
- 8. The requisition itself is signed by the Under-Secretary of War, returned to Wartime Civil Control Administration, and dispatched to the Federal Reserve Bank for service on the holder of the property.

Subject: Recuisitioning of Vehicles Owned by Japanese Evacuees 9. The owner may be served by registered mail and a receipt secured as evidence. 10. If a voluntary sale of the vehicle is made to the Army in the interim. the requisition may be cancelled. 11. Should the appraised value of the vehicle be less than the amount due the legal owner and if the legal owner elects to take possession of the vehicle in lieu of payment, the Bank is authorized to make such delivery upon his request. 12. When notice is served upon the owner, the Wartime Civil Control Administration will notify the Department of Motor Vehicles that the Army has requisitioned and taken possession of the vehicle, and that the records of that Department should be changed accordingly. 13. It is contemplated that payment for the property will be made by the Finance Office, U. S. Aray, through the Inspection and Fiscal Division, Wartime Civil Control Administration.
