

It is my understanding that the Oregon Alien Property law was passed during the month of August 1920, and became effective 60 days after the signing of the law by the Governor. It is my understanding that this law also contains a penalty clause providing that in case any alien shall acquire property in violation of this law that said property shall escheat to the State of Oregon.

K. Kawaji and H. Uyento purchased the Lake County Steam Laundry on August 24, 1920, prior to the date that this law became effective; however, on March 27, 1923, K. Kawaji purchased from H. Uyento all his right, title and interest in this business (a 1/2 interest). It would seem to me that according to the above mentioned Oregon Alien Law that this 1/2 interest purchased in 1923 would actually belong to the State of Oregon.

MEMORANDUM Mr. George Kido of Route 4, Box 1281, City, called at this office regarding an account held by Gill Seed Company in the amount of \$128. Mr. Kido states that the Gill Company are threatening suit. He also states that this balance was owing by his father who passed away in 1934. The original amount of this bill was \$200 and since the death of the father, George Kido has reduced this amount to \$128. He states that he is not sure that this debt was owing by the father. He also states that he is now 27 years old. Referring this to Mr. Crouch, he suggested that I contact Gill Seed Company for their side of the story. I spoke to Mr. Gill who informed me that this account was put in the name of the son about three years before the father passed away. The boy has since been purchasing seed and materials from them and has kept his account in reasonably good shape, meanwhile making the reduction on the old account. He states that since the father died, the boy has purchased his own place. Mr. Gill informed that he offered George Kido \$85 for a cabbage planter but George Kido refused to sell to him saying he had promised this cabbage planter to another party. Our final advice to George Kido was to see Mr. Gill personally and make arrangements for the settlement of the account, suggesting that if he were unable to pay this, he should give M r. Gill a note if he felt that he owed the account or as a second way of settling this he might offer Mr. Gill a sum of cash, the amount of which to be determined between themselves. Dear Dr. Kinoshita: Reference is made to your letter of April 1, 1942 addressed to the Wartime Civil Coordinating agency. This office has no information as to the length of time evacuees will be given to arrange their affairs after the evacuation order is issued, but judging from previous experience the time may be short. The Federal Heserve Bank is arranging for the pick up and storage at government expense at the sole risk of the owner of the more substantial household items such as ice boxes, washing machines, planes and other heavy furniture. Cooking utensils and other small items will be accepted if crated, packed and plainly marked. Bric-a-brac will not be accepted. We understand that ovacuous may carry with them on departure for the assembly center bedding and linens (no mattress), toilet articles, extra clothing and other essential personal effects for each member of the family. The size and number of packages undoubtedly will be limited to that which can be carried by the individual or family group. Short-wave radio receiving sets having a frequency of 1,750 kilocycles or greater or of 540 kilocycles or less may not be taken. Evacuees may provide their own transportation to assembly centers. However, should this method of transportation not be available the Civil Control office should be notified. We have no information as to the type of house that is to be allocated at the permanent resettlement area nor is any information available as to the extent of the furnishings. You may, if you so desire, dispose of your office furniture in Portland on any reasonable basis you see fit. However, if you prefer, the storage facilities offered by this bank will be available to you. Dear Sir: Until very recently, I have been in the employ of the War-CCC Department and Have been reading the papers concerning the coming evacuation of aliens and citizens of Japanese Ancestry from the Pacific Coastal Areas. However, I have been unable to obtain any informations concerning the evacuation and the regulations governing such evacuation. I will greatly appreciate it, therefore, if you will clarify some of the things I wish to know, after I have submitted the following information conserning myself: I am an American Citizen of Japanese Ancestry, age 36 years, my wife is of the Caucasian race, and I have one son 6 years of age. I have been a Reserve Officer of the United States since 1929; my present rank is Captain, Medical Reserve. I have applied for active duty but as yet have not received a reply from the Commanding General Ninth Corps Area. I have been employed by the War-CCC Department, as camp surgeon and Assistant District Surgeon since May 18,1936. I am licensed to practice Medicine and Surgery in Oregon . I have served as Civil Service examining physician for the 11th Civil Service District and as Official C.M.T.C. Examiner. At present I am serving as Examining Physician for Douglas County Selective Service Board No.1. I have not disposed of my household goods or furniture as yet. I have my office furniture stored in the Gerlinger Building Portland, Oregon. The following informations will be appreciated: The procedure and regulations governing the coming evacuation (the date and the probable resettlement area) How long a time will we get to ready ourselves after notice of date of evacuation is received? What furnitures as washing machine, stoves, refrigerator, gooking utensils, beddings, radio, light fixtures, will each family/allowed to bring with them? Who will furnish the facilities for transportation? What type of house is to be allocated at the permanent settlement area for the duration? Will these houses be furnished? What facilities for earning a living will be provided for a professional man's family? Will my son have a chance to continue his schooling? Will my wife who is/the white race be permitted to withdraw from such areas? will she be able to eat the type of food furnished or are food to be provided each family? (a list of things we are allowed to take with us, will be helpful). I have my office furniture in Portland. Will I have to take them along or should I sell them as soon as possible? Thank you. If I can be of service to the Government and to the unfortunate exacuees, my services are at your command.

Walter Fawbush informs me that he has offered \$6400 for the Oana Bros. ranch at Willow Flat, and asks my opinion.

This is a hard question, as, first of all, our assessments on land are high (considered to be 67% rather than 50% of actual value) and seemed because of the distressing values placed by the Federal Land Bank, conciliators for the Frazier Lampke set up, etc.

The State Tax Commission had a very competent appraiser here for a couple of months last year, but he could not come to any satisfactory figure on values.

Some have one idea, some another. Truth is that Hood River Valley is more like a suburban, than a rural area, and few people care to sell except as a last resort.

I am starting my twelfth year as assessor, and during several of those years most people were ready to sell out, but were just too heavily involved to do so.

Mr. Fawbush might go ahead and net \$6400 on the place this year, and again he might go head over heels. I think his offer is reasonable. The buildings are not much, and there is not any domestic water, and 34 acres in brush above the irrigation ditch.

On the other hand it is in the most frost free section of the Valley, and his varieties are good.

Twenty-seven (27) acres is all that can be considered and at \$6400 that is about \$230 per acre.

I am sending a set of maps which you map keep for your use as long as you wish, I was going to send some data to the San Francisco office, but it seems that they are pretty well supplied with information.



William Koida, Route 11, Box 851, Milwaukie, Oregon, called at this office today and stated that the business "Joe Koida, Florist" at the above address formerly belonged to Joe Koida, that Joe Koida left in 1935 for Japan and has been there since that time, that he no longer has any interest in the business but requested that it be continued to be carried on in his name.

William Koida, who is a nephew of Joe Koida, attempted to deposit five checks totaling \$129.47 in the First State Bank of Milwaukie (Oregon) in the account "Joe Koida, Florist". This is the name of the account used by William Koida. The Milwaukie bank refused to accept the deposit on the grounds that the interest of a national of Japan is involved and also because the checks are payable personally to Joe Koida. In discussing the account by telephone with the First State Bank of Milwaukie, we were informed that William Koida has been sending Joe Koida in Japan \$25 per month, which is the limit allowed under the previous general license.

The writer gave William Koida a set of application blanks (form TFE-1) and suggested that he apply for a general license. The checks were returned to William Koida.

It is the writer's opinion, after discussing this account with William Koida and with the First State Bank of Milwaukie, that there is considerable likelihood that Joe Koida, a national of Japan, still has a substantial interest in the firm and possibly owns all of it. It is believed that this business should be investigated.



FEDERAL RESERVE BANK OF SAN FRANCISCO, Portland Branch (acting as a fiscal agent of the United States of America), hereinafter referred to as "the bank",

IN CONSIDERATION of the mutual covenants and agreements hereinafter contained,

WITNESSETH: That,

I.

The warehouse company will maintain, available for the exclusive use by the bank, a minimum of forty thousand (40,000) square feet of floor space in that certain building of the warehouse company situated on the Northeast corner of N. W. Park Avenue and N. W. Everett Street, in the City of Portland, County of Multnomah, State of Oregon, and also known as No. 733 N. W. Everett Street in said city, and hereinafter referred to as "the warehouse," for a period of time beginning the ______ day of April, 1942, and ending six (6) wonths after a formal declaration of the cessation of the present war between the United States of America and the Empire of Japan. It is understood and agreed that said forty thousand (40,000) square feet of space and such additional space as may be acquired as hereinafter provided, shall constitute such area or areas on said premises which shall be satisfactory to the bank.

II.

The bank agrees to pay the warehouse company Thirteen hundred dollars (\$1,300.00) per month for the exclusive use of said forty thousand (40,000) square feet of space and warehouse company's services in warehousing all articles of the bank stored or warehoused therein and thereon during said period. The first monthly payment hereunder shall be made on the day of ______, 1942, and subsequent payments on or before the ______ day of each month thereafter.

The warehouse company agrees that it will at all times accept, store and warehouse any articles delivered by the bank to it for storage and warehousing in said space, and render such service in a good and workmanlike manner and in accordance with recognized standards of good warehousing for articles of the kind so delivered to it; and will place all articles constituting a given lot thereof so that all articles of one lot will be contiguous and of convenient access from time to time, and will mark or letter the same with such distinguishing marks or letters as the bank may from time to time direct, and when received will issue to the bank receipts therefor prepared by the bank and containing such descriptive numbers or letters or combinations thereof as the bank shall require. Said goods and packages shall be stored at the bank's risk of damage by moths, rust, water, fire, depreciation by time and ordinary wear and tear in handling. The warehouse company shall be held to the exercise of ordinary care in storage and handling of the goods and its liability shall be limited to Ten (10) Cents per pound, the rental agreed upon being based upon such valuation. The bank agrees to protect and save harmless the warehouse company from any loss or expense that it may sustain by reason of any claim or demand of the owners of the goods and the bank will defend the warehouse company in any and all suits and actions which may be instituted against the warehouse company by the owners of the goods or any of them.

It is agreed that the bank shall have on demand the exclusive use of an additional area of 10,000 square feet of floor space in said warehouse, to be selected and used by it for the same purposes and under the same conditions herein provided for the use of the said 40,000 square feet; provided, however, that if the bank elects to exercise the right to additional floor space, the monthly payments hereinabove stipulated shall be increased to \$1,500 per month.

IV.

The warehouse company hereby agrees that it will provide and furnish such labor as may be required to receive all articles of the bank delivered to the warehouse for storage therein, and place and properly store them within the area set apart for the exclusive use of the bank in said warehouse, and when said articles or any part thereof are withdrawn from the warehouse by the bank, to provide and furnish such labor as may be required to move said articles so withdrawn from the area in which they are warehoused and stored to such ground floor door in said warehouse at a point where they may be conveniently placed for delivery to the bank; and the bank agrees to pay the warehouse company for such services in addition to the amounts hereinabove provided, at the rate of \$1.50 per man hour for such labor; provided, however, that if the present union labor scale for said services shall be increased or decreased during the term of this contract, said basic rate of \$1.50 per man hour shall be adjusted accordingly; and provided further, that the warehouse company shall at all times receive, in addition to said basic rate of \$1.50 per man hour, such additional amounts as the warehouse company shall be required to pay for overtime, if any, in accordance with the union labor scale prevailing when such overtime services are rendered. Claims for said labor services as aforesaid shall be presented to the bank and in form satisfactory to the bank, within thirty (30) days after such labor services are rendered, and shall be payable by the bank within thirty (30) days after the same are received by it.

V.

The warehouse company agrees that it will at all times accept,

Instructions to Owner

To be accepted for storage by the United States Government, the motor vehicle must be in proper running order.

The procedure for registering and storing a motor vehicle is as follows:

- (a) The State Motor Vehicle Registration Certificate for this vehicle must be submitted at the Civil Control Station, and three copies of this form (FRB-3) will then be prepared.
- (b) Two copies of this form, together with the Registration Certificate, will be handed to the evacuee for his retention until arrival at the designated Assembly Center. The third copy will be retained at the Civil Control Station.
- (c) The evacuee will be given an identification tag which he will tie securely to the steering apparatus of the motor vehicle.
- (d) On arrival at the Assembly Center the evacuee will deliver to the representative of the Federal Reserve Bank of San Francisco the two copies of this form, the Registration Certificate, and the keys to the vehicle.
- (e) The representative of the Federal Reserve Bank of San Francisco will check all numbers on the form and if found to be correct will acknowledge receipt of the motor vehicle by signing one copy of the form and delivering it to the evacuee.

If the motor vehicle described in this form is lost, damaged, or destroyed as the result of negligence while it is in the possession or custody of the United States, or any agency acting for it, the Congress of the United States will be asked to take appropriate action for the benefit of the owner.

and warehouse any articles delivered by the bank to it for storage and warehousing in said space, and render such service in a good and workman-like manner and in accordance with recognized standards of good warehousing for articles of the kind so delivered to it; and will place all articles constituting a given lot thereof so that all articles of one lot will be contiguous and of convenient access from time to time, and will mark or letter the same with such distinguishing marks or letters as the bank may from time to time direct, and when received will issue to the bank receipts therefor, in terms and form provided by the Uniform Warehouse Receipt Act of the State of Oregon, and in describing the goods or packages containing the goods described therein, shall add to such descriptions such descriptive numbers or letters or combinations thereof as the bank shall require.

VI.

It is agreed that the bank shall have the right to designate agents and representatives to be present on the premises during any time when articles or goods of the bank are being delivered to and initially stored by the warehouse company, and when any articles or goods of the bank warehoused therein are being withdrawn therefrom, and that said agent or representative shall have access to any part of the warehouse building wherein the articles or goods of the bank being so delivered or withdrawn then are.

VII.

It is further agreed that the bank may terminate this agreement at any time upon giving ninety (90) days' written notice to the warehouse company of its intention so to do.

VIII.

Wherever the words "articles of the bank" or "goods of the bank" are used herein, they shall mean and include all articles and goods delivered by the bank to the warehouse company for warehousing and storing hereunder, and irrespective of whether or not the bank has any right, title, lien or interest therein or holds possession of the same under custodian agreement or otherwise.

Dear Reverend Kuroda:

Reference is made to your letter dated April 2, 1942.

For your information the Federal Reserve Bank is arranging for the pick up and storage, at the sole risk of the owner, of the more substantial household items such as ice boxes, washing machines, pianos and other heavy furniture. Cooking utensils and other small articles will be accepted if crated, packed and plainly marked. Bric-a-brac will not be accepted. It is contemplated that such storage facilities will be located in Portland, Oregon.

At the present time we have no information as to whether or not property may be sent to your new abode in case it is needed.

This office has no information relative the American Aid Committee referred to in your letter. The problem of storage of course, will be one for you to determine. If you do not wish to avail yourself of any of the storage facilities offered you may dispose of the property to your own satisfaction on any reasonable basis.
