Dear Sirs:

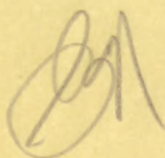
I am writing to ask you if you have a small place evacuated by Japanese, in this vicinity, that my wife and I could handle, and I work elsewhere eight hours a day.
