MEMORANDUM

May 21, 1942

REFERENCE: Report at close of evacuation under Exclusion Order No. 74.
Clatsop and Columbia Counties, Oregon, through Civil Control
Station -- 599 Duane Street, Astoria, Oregon. May, 16-20, 1942.

1. Location of Civil Control Station used in evacuation.
599 Duane Street,
Astoria, Oregon. (Office of Oregon State Employment Service)
2. Number of Evacuees in project - 60.
3. Number of heads of families in project - 34.
4. Number of interviews referred to our representative at Civil Control Center - 8.

Note: - In line with the policy of the Federal Reserve Bank, and for the purpose of building a complete file on all evacuee cases, each family head was interviewed and a record made of such interview on the first, or registration visit. All second visits were likewise cleared through our representative, and additional visits and outside interviews were arranged as they appeared necessary. Outside of station interviews were made in three cases, two in regard to property of the Westport Steam Laundry, and one with a barber in Astoria, anticipating the necessity of storing his shop equipment, which was found later to be mortgaged and left in care of the building owner.

5. Number of motor vehicles taken into custody - 1.

Note: - A 1938 Buick Sedan was taken from Mr. T. Takemoto for storage and sale to the Army under Alternative 2, and placed in storage at the WCCA warehouse, 733 N.W. Everett Street, or Warehouse No. 5, Oregon Transfer Company, Portland, Oregon.



Space occupied - 45 feet.

All property is stored in warehouse of Oregon Transfer Company, warehouse No. 5, 733 N. W. Everett St., Portland, Oregon.

Conclusion: In view of the small amount of storage in this project, the Federal Reserve Bank representative arranged with Smart's Transfer Company of Astoria to pick up all items on their regular freight route and deliver the items direct to 733 N. W. Everett St., in Portland. Only two pickups were necessary, one in Astoria and the balance at Westport, Oregon. The Company was instructed in the use and disposition of our forms, and the billing to WCCA for their service.

A large percentage of evacuees in this project were aliens, and mostly singles with families in Japan, and were employees of fish packing companies and other large operators where group housing was provided. We believe this accounted for the unusually small amount of storage. Excellent work was also done prior to the evacuation by Mr. Clyde Tuel, manager of the Oregon State Employment Service office, who worked out many problems for these evacuees prior to evacuation.

Note - In line with the policy of the Federal Reserve Bank representatives, each family head was interviewed on the registration visit in order that a brief interview record could be taken for our files: All such interviews were completed at the time of the second visit and proper disposition noted by our representatives Howard Alger and E. J. Hughes. Where property problems, storage of furniture or motor vehicles were involved, proper notation of our action was made in closing the interview data. This work actually involved 80 first interviews, 78 second interviews (largely for clearing our records) making a total of 158 contacts with evacuees by our representatives, although only 10 of these were actually scheduled interviews.

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

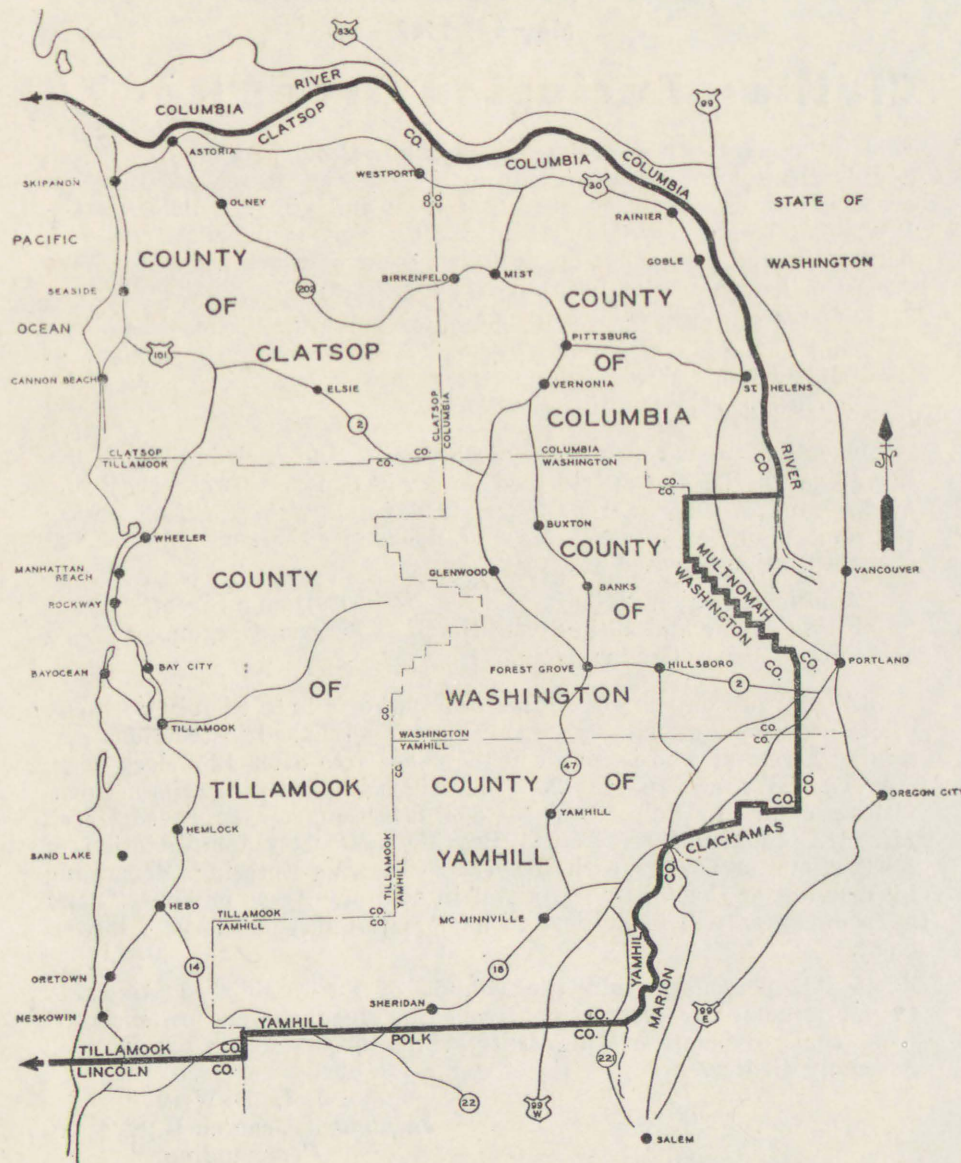

No Japanese person will be permitted to move into, or out of, the above area after 12 o'clock noon, P.W.T., Thursday, May 14, 1942, without obtaining special permission from the representative of the Commanding General, Northwestern Sector, at either one of the Civil Control Stations located at:

American Legion Hall, 599 Duane Street,
First Avenue and Main Street North, Astoria, Oregon.
Forest Grove, Oregon.

Such permits will only be granted for the purpose of uniting members of a family, or in cases of grave emergency.

The Civil Control Stations are equipped to assist the Japanese population affected by this evacuation in the following ways:

1. Give advice and instructions on the evacuation.
2. Provide services with respect to the management, leasing, sale, storage or other disposition of most kinds of property, such as real estate, business and professional equipment, household goods, boats, automobiles and livestock.
3. Provide temporary residence elsewhere for all Japanese in family groups.
4. Transport persons and a limited amount of clothing and equipment to their new residence.

THE FOLLOWING INSTRUCTIONS MUST BE OBSERVED:

1. A responsible member of each family, preferably the head of the family, or the person in whose name most of the property is held, and each individual living alone, will report to either one of the Civil Control Stations to receive further instructions. This must be done between 8:00 A. M. and 5:00 P. M. on Saturday, May 16, 1942, or between 8:00 A. M. and 5:00 P. M. on Sunday, May 17, 1942. Should such individual reside over 30 miles from the nearest Control Station and be unable to provide transportation to such Control Station, he will telegraph or telephone on Friday, May 15, 1942, to the Manager of the nearest Control Station for instructions.

2. Evacuees must carry with them on departure for the Assembly Center, the following property:

- (a) Bedding and linens (no mattress) for each member of the family;
- (b) Toilet articles for each member of the family;
- (c) Extra clothing for each member of the family;
- (d) Essential personal effects for each member of the family.

All items carried will be securely packaged, tied and plainly marked with the name of the owner and numbered in accordance with instructions obtained at the Civil Control Stations. The size and number of packages is limited to that which can be carried by the individual or family group.

3. No pets of any kind will be permitted.

4. No personal items and no household goods will be shipped to the Assembly Center.

5. The United States Government through its agencies will provide for the storage, at the sole risk of the owner, of the more substantial household items, such as iceboxes, washing machines, pianos and other heavy furniture. 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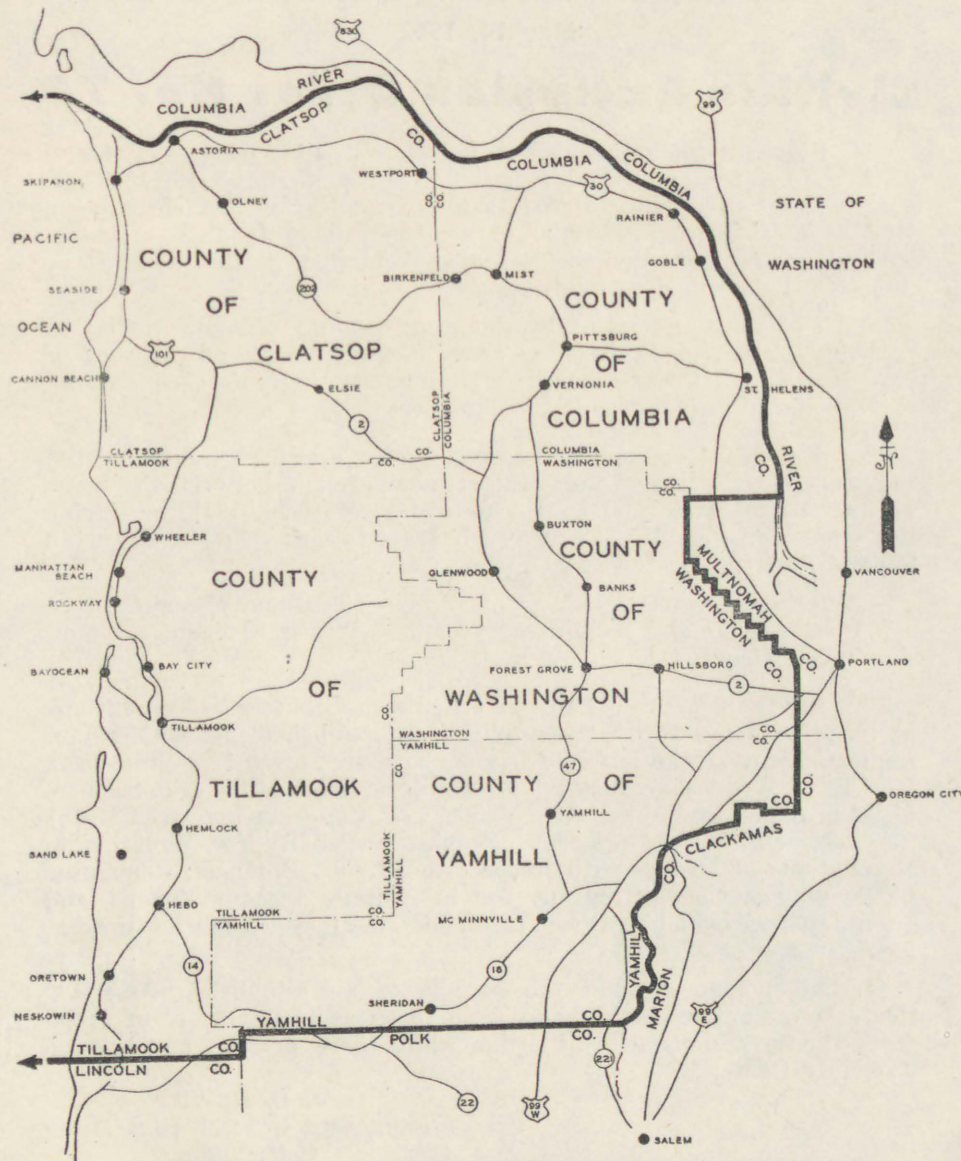

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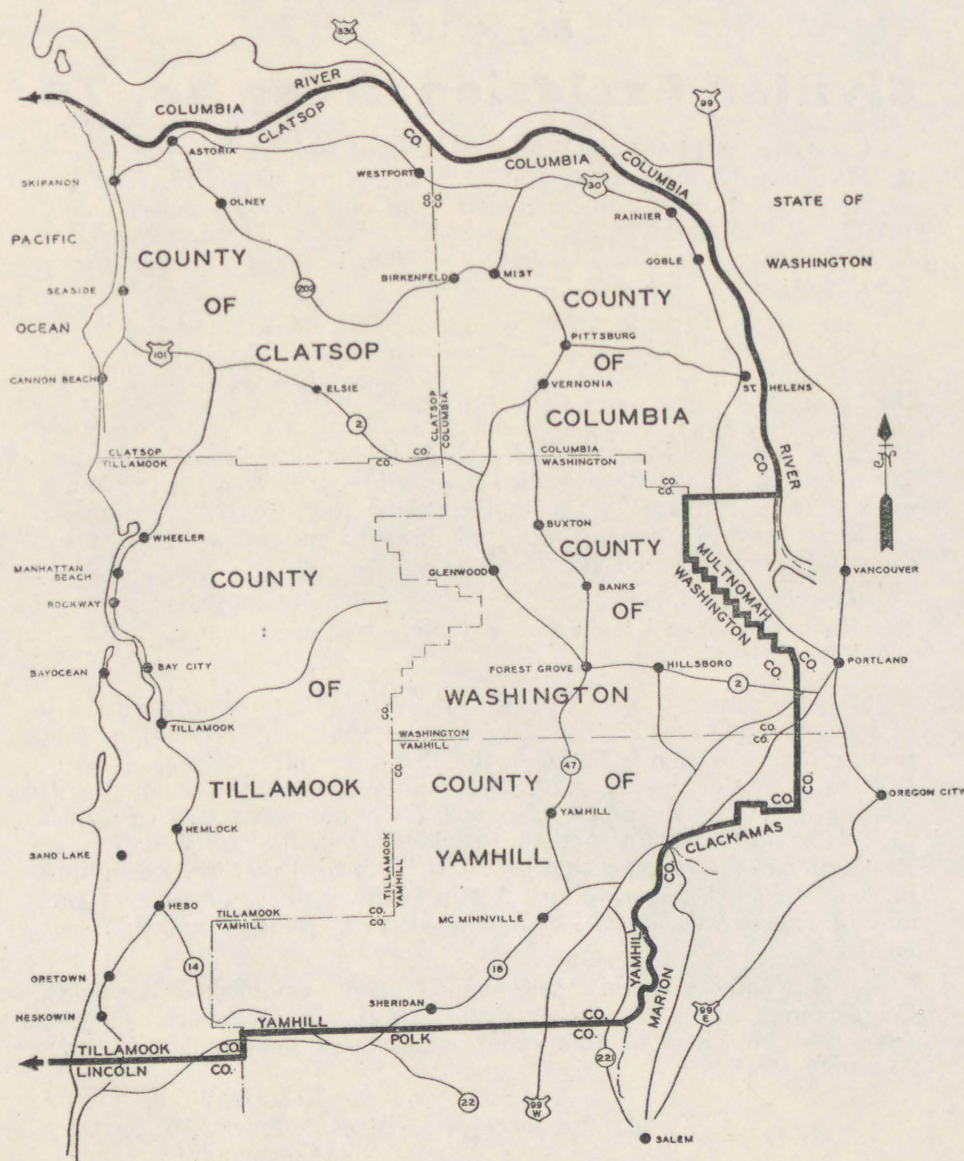

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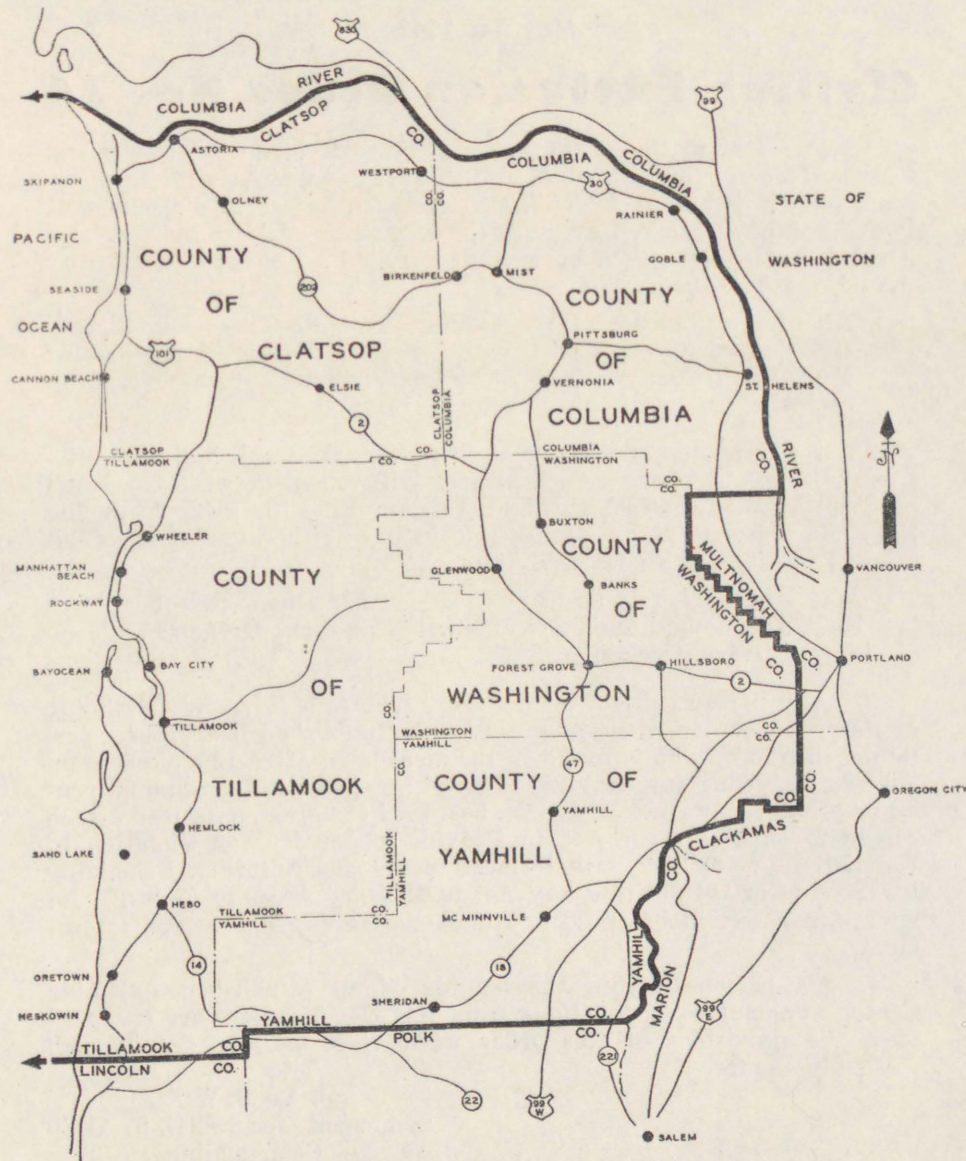

MEMORANDUM :

T. Takemoto - 1938 Buick Sedan for storage, Alternative 2.

At the Civil Control Station in Astoria, Mr. T. Takemoto, of Clatskanie, arranged for storage of his 1938 Buick sedan, under alternative 2, (sale to Army) and completed all copies of WCCA-FBR 3 and 4 forms, signing all copies, and all copies were retained by the Federal Reserve Bank representative since the owner could not, under army travel orders, drive the car to Portland for storage. It was arranged that he deliver the car be delivered to the Tourist Garage in Clatskanie, with the keys, where it could be picked up and driven to Portland for him on the day of evacuation, (May 20th, 1942) A temporary memorandum outlining this procedure was given the owner by the Federal Reserve Bank representative, stating that a receipt would be given the owner when the car was actually received for storage at Portland.

It was further arranged that for the convenience of the owner, a driver would be furnished, being either Mrs. Thelma Davis or Mrs. Helen Johnson, or both of them, both employees of the Social Service Department in the W.C.C.A. office in Portland, and returning to Portland from Astoria on the day of evacuation. This arrangement was discussed by telephone about 1:25 P.M. on Tuesday, May 19th, with Mr. Risberg at the Portland office, and the plan appeared in order

On arrival at Clatskanie, following the army convoy, about 10:45, the car was found at the appointed location, with the key at the garage desk, and was found to be in acceptable condition and running order tho no mechanical check was made as the owner stated previously that the car was in good condition, which it appeared to be. Mrs. Thelma Davis with Mrs. Helen Johnson checked with the army representatives when the convoy busses stopped to pick up additional evacuees, and learned that three Astoria evacuees were suffering from car sickness. With the consent of Lt. Rizzo and Lt. Tuttle, in charge of the convoy, Mrs. Sunada, and two sick Japanese children were permitted to ride in the Takemoto car, and with Mrs. Davis driving, the car proceeded to St. Helens where a lunch stop was scheduled.

At St. Helens at the time of departure for the Assembly Center about 12:30, it was learned that additional car sick evacuees were in need of attention, and it was arranged with the consent of Lt. Rizzo and Lt. Tuttle, that Mrs. Sunada, Mrs. Hyashi, Mrs. Pizarro, Irene Pizarro and ~~Maria~~ ^{Margie} Kobayashi should ride in the Takemoto buick, with Mrs. Helen Johnson and Mrs. Davis, driving. Also at the request of the army representatives, the car was placed in the convoy at this point directly behind Smart's transfer truck, and ahead of the following army car, and proceeded in that fashion toward Portland.

On North Portland Blvd. about half a mile from the Assembly Center the convoy slowed or halted to the extent that the Smart Transfer truck was forced to make a sudden and complete stop, and the Takemoto Buick, driven in close order by Mrs. Davis, likewise forced to stop was found to have insufficient braking power on the down grade where the stop was made to stop the car before it contacted the trailer of the Smart truck, and some damage was done to the left front fender, the hood ornament and tire rack on the left fender well. No injury of any nature was suffered by occupants, and the car proceeded in the convoy to the Assembly Center. The occupants were released under observation of the army officers as planned, and the car left at the Assembly center, and picked up within about two hours by Federal Reserve Bank representatives, driven to the warehouse at 733 N.W. Everett Street, and placed in storage.
