REFERENCE: Report at close of evacuation under Civilian Exclusion Order No. 87 covering Lane, Douglas, and Coos Counties, Oregon through Civil Control Station located at 34 West 6th Avenue, Eugene, Oregon, commencing May 27, 1942.

- 1. Control station was located at the office of the Oregon State Employment Service, 34 West 6th Avenue, Eugene, Oregon.
- 2. Number of evacuees interviewed 4. None of these were heads of families all being students at the University of Oregon.
- 3. Number of motor vehicles to be stored None.
- 4. Number of evacuees with personal effects for storage None.

 Two of the evacuees had small amounts of personal effects which they arranged for storage with local friends.

General: Owing to the fact that the local postmaster had issued a number of travel permits and exemptions to other students of the University who evacuated themselves to eastern points, there was only this small number to be taken care of. No problems of any sort presented themselves as they owned no motor cars or furniture. Three of the individuals were sent to the Assembly Center, North Portland, Oregon, and one, a boy from Santa Clara, California, was sent to the Reception Center at Tule Lake where, it was hoped, he could rejoin his family. All were American born and were handled as individuals only.



Pursuant to the provisions of Civilian Exclusion Order No. 87, this Headquarters, dated May 23, 1942, all persons of Japanese ancestry, both alien and non-alien, will be evacuated from the above area by 12 o'clock noon, P.W.T., Wednesday, June 3, 1942.

No Japanese person will be permitted to move into, or out of, the above area after 5:00 A. M., P.W.T., Saturday, May 23, 1942, without obtaining special permission from the representative of the Commanding General, Northwestern Sector, at either one of the Civil Control Stations located at:

45 North Fir Street, Medford, Oregon. 34 West Sixth Avenue, Eugene, Oregon.

Such permits will only be granted for the purpose of uniting members of a family, or in cases of grave emergency.

The Civil Control Stations are equipped to assist the Japanese population affected by this evacuation in the following ways:

- 1. Give advice and instructions on the evacuation.
- 2. Provide services with respect to the management, leasing, sale, storage or other disposition of most kinds of property, such as real estate, business and professional equipment, household goods, boats, automobiles and livestock.
- 3. Provide temporary residence elsewhere for all Japanese in family groups.
- 4. Transport persons and a limited amount of clothing and equipment to their new residence.

THE FOLLOWING INSTRUCTIONS MUST BE OBSERVED:

- 1. A responsible member of each family, preferably the head of the family, or the person in whose name most of the property is held, and each individual living alone, will report to either one of the Civil Control Stations to receive further instructions. This must be done between 8:00 A. M. and 5:00 P. M. on Wednesday, May 27, 1942. Should such individual reside over 30 miles from the nearest Civil Control Station and be unable to provide transportation to such Civil Control Station, he will telegraph or telephone on Tuesday, May 26, 1942, to the Manager of the nearest Civil Control Station for instructions.
- 2. Evacuees must carry with them on departure for the Reception Center, the following property:
 - (a) Bedding and lineus (no mattress) for each member of the family;
 - (b) Toilet articles for each member of the family;
 - (c) Extra clothing for each member of the family;
 - (d) Essential personal effects for each member of the family.

All items carried will be securely packaged, tied and plainly marked with the name of the owner and numbered in accordance with instructions obtained at the Civil Control Station. The size and number of packages is limited to that which can be carried by the individual or family group.



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

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
