Civilian Exclusion Order No. 88

1. Pursuant to the provisions of Public Proclamations Nos. 1 and 2, this Headquarters, dated March 2, 1942, and March 16, 1942, respectively, it is hereby ordered that from and after 12 o'clock noon, P.W.T., of Wednesday, June 3, 1942, all persons of Japanese ancestry, both alien and non-alien, be excluded from that portion of Military Area No. 1 described as follows:

All of the Counties of Pacific, Wahkiakum, Cowlitz, Clark, Skamania and Lewis, State of Washington.

2. A responsible member of each family, and each individual living alone, in the above described area will report between the hours of 8:00 A. M. and 5:00 P. M., Wednesday, May 27, 1942, to one of the Civil Control Stations located at:

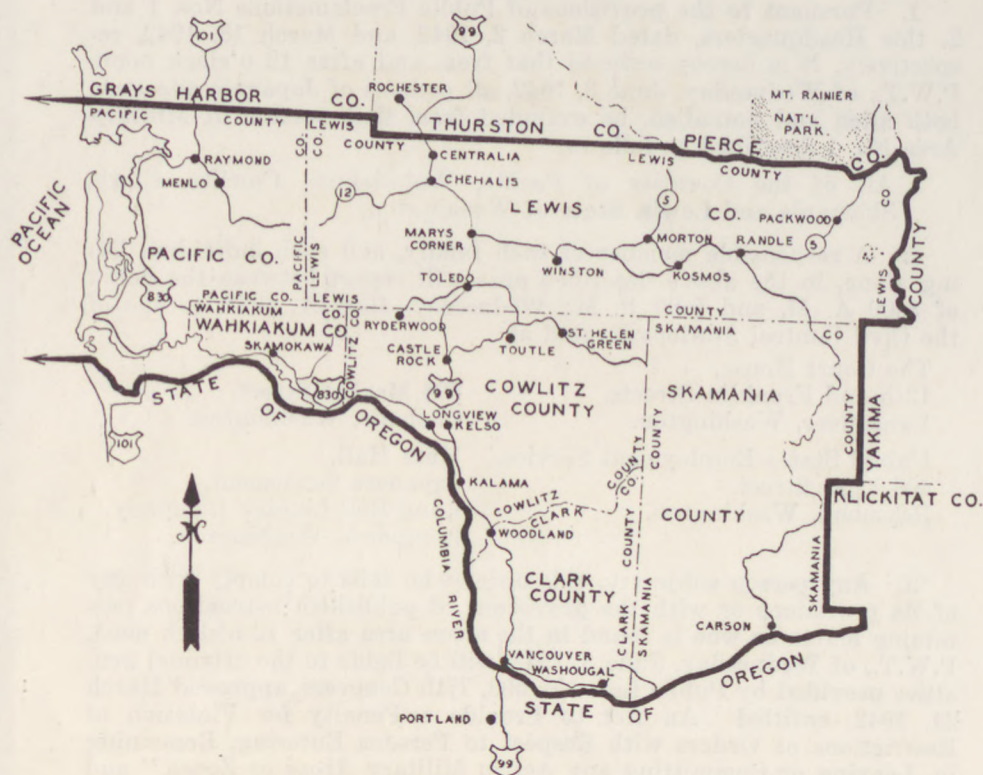
3. Any person subject to this order who fails to comply with any of its provisions or with the provisions of published instructions pertaining hereto or who is found in the above area after 12 o'clock noon, P.W.T., of Wednesday, June 3, 1942, will be liable to the criminal penalties provided by Public Law No. 503, 77th Congress, approved March 21, 1942, entitled "An Act to Provide a Penalty for Violation of Restrictions or Orders with Respect to Persons Entering, Remaining in, Leaving or Committing any Act in Military Areas or Zones," and alien Japanese will be subject to immediate apprehension and internment.

4. All persons within the bounds of an established Assembly Center pursuant to instructions from this Headquarters are excepted from the provisions of this order while those persons are in such Assembly Center.

INSTRUCTIONS TO ALL PERSONS OF JAPANESE ANCESTRY

LIVING IN THE FOLLOWING AREA:

All of the Counties of Pacific, Wahkiakum, Cowlitz, Clark, Skamania and Lewis, State of Washington.

Pursuant to the provisions of Civilian Exclusion Order No. 88, this Headquarters, dated May 23, 1942, all persons of Japanese ancestry, both alien and non-alien, will be evacuated from the above area by 12 o'clock noon, P.W.T., Wednesday, June 3, 1942.

No Japanese person will be permitted to move into, or out of, the above area after 5:00 A. M., P.W.T., Saturday, May 23, 1942, without obtaining special permission from the representative of the Commanding General, Northwestern Sector, at one of the Civil Control Stations located at:

12th and Franklin Streets,
Vancouver, Washington.

Such permits will only be granted for the purpose of uniting members of a family, or in cases of grave emergency.

The Civil Control Stations are equipped to assist the Japanese population affected by this evacuation in the following ways:

1. Give advice and instructions on the evacuation.
2. Provide services with respect to the management, leasing, sale, storage or other disposition of most kinds of property, such as real estate, business and professional equipment, household goods, boats, automobiles and livestock.
3. Provide temporary residence elsewhere for all Japanese in family groups.
4. Transport persons and a limited amount of clothing and equipment to their new residence.

THE FOLLOWING INSTRUCTIONS MUST BE OBSERVED:

1. A responsible member of each family, preferably the head of the family, or the person in whose name most of the property is held, and each individual living alone, will report to one of the Civil Control Stations to receive further instructions. This must be done between 8:00 A. M. and 5:00 P. M. on Wednesday, May 27, 1942. Should such individual reside over 30 miles from the nearest Civil Control Station and be unable to provide transportation to such Civil Control Station, he will telegraph or telephone on Tuesday, May 26, 1942, to the Manager of the nearest Civil Control Station for instructions.

2. Evacuees must carry with them on departure for the Reception Center, the following property:

- (a) Bedding and linens (no mattress) for each member of the family;
- (b) Toilet articles for each member of the family;
- (c) Extra clothing for each member of the family;
- (d) Essential personal effects for each member of the family.

All items carried will be securely packaged, tied and plainly marked with the name of the owner and numbered in accordance with instructions obtained at the Civil Control Station. The size and number of packages is limited to that which can be carried by the individual or family group.

3. No pets of any kind will be permitted.

4. No personal items and no household goods will be shipped to the Reception Center.

5. The United States Government through its agencies will provide for the storage, at the sole risk of the owner, of the more substantial household items, such as iceboxes, washing machines, pianos and other heavy furniture. Cooking utensils and other small items will be accepted for storage if crated, packed and plainly marked with the name and address of the owner. Only one name and address will be used by a given family.

6. Each family, and individual living alone, will be furnished transportation to the Reception Center. Private means of transportation will not be utilized. All instructions pertaining to the movement will be obtained at the Civil Control Station.

Go to one of the Civil Control Stations between the hours of 8:00 A. M. and 5:00 P. M., Wednesday, May 27, 1942, to receive further instructions.

The writer called Walter W. Hamilton, Federal Reserve Bank Representative at the Raymond, Washington Civil Control Station at 10:00 A. M. on June 2, 1942, and received the following report:

Families registered - 13

Individuals registered - 44

Autos - None

Storage - 1 Family; 40 pieces, which Pacific Highway Transport will pick up at 2:30 P.M. on June 2, 1942 for delivery by the Portland-Seattle Auto Freight in Portland on June 3, 1942.

Mr. Hamilton is today writing a letter to the Portland Branch regarding one boat and one scow now being used on Willapa Bay by Booth Fisheries of Seattle. Mr. Hamilton stated that the boat and scow is owned by an evacuee now in the North Portland Assembly Center by the name of Aime Kinoshita, formerly of Rt. 1 Box 19, Gresham, Oregon, and is being operated by the Booth Fisheries under an oral agreement. A sister of the owner reported this information to Mr. Hamilton with the view in mind that we contact the owner in the North Portland Assembly Center suggesting that possibly some written agreement should be made regarding the use of the equipment.

Dear Mr. Risberg:

I wish to report as follows in addition to report submitted to you under date of May 28, 1942, concerning Project No. 109, Civilian Exclusion Order No. 88 at the offices in Chehalis, Washington.

As of 4:00 P. M. Tuesday, June 2, there was a total of 97 Japanese checked on to the train at the station in Chehalis, 53 of which were from Chehalis, and 44 of which were from Raymond. No further property problems developed at that time, except however, that there was a reduction of storage items by the Kiyono family under No. 19867.

You will notice in the report of May 28, that there were 24 items reported stored for this family. You are now advised that there were but 20 items as the result of the exclusion of a box of books, one bed, and other items which could not be identified. The Quick Transfer Company picked up the 20 items however, and the head of the Kiyono family was not able to identify the excluded items but nevertheless admitted that there were only 20 items for storage purposes.

It will undoubtedly therefore, be necessary to revise the property forms left with your office when the particular items arrived from Chehalis.

Herewith follows a report on project No. 109, Civilian Exclusion Order No. 88 concerning the office at 804 Market Street Chehalis, Washington.

There was a total of nineteen families registered from family No. 19866 to 19884 inclusive totaling fifty-three individuals. Each family was processed and all of their property matters closed during registration on May 27th. Resulting storage from the entire registration consists of thirty-four items. All of these items with the exception of one are ready for pick-up at the Onalaska Depot, Onalaska, Washington.


In view of the fact that the greater percentage of Japanese in the Chehalis area were laborers employed at the Carlisle Lumber Company, Onalaska, their property holdings were practically nil. There was, however, one family being family number 19883 and name Nakamura engaged in farming and since they have sold their automobile it seems necessary to pick up the one item stored by them at Rt. 4, Box 104, Chehalis.

All in all the entire registration at Chehalis went very smoothly and the writer does not believe that any further storage problems will arise in that area. The Quick Transfer Company of Chehalis has been advised, however to pick up all property tagged with WCCA Form FRB 1 at the Onalaska Depot and to report to the Federal Reserve Bank for the writer in the event that all items do not tally with the listings left with said Quick Transfer Company.

There is herewith attached the original interview record of the writer together with five storage forms in triplicate in respect to the following family numbers - 19867, 19875, 19876, 19879 and 19883 these being the total of the families requesting storage. The storage tags attached to said forms are merely samples of those used by the respective families at the request of the writer. There is also herewith attached six original interview sheets of family numbers 19867, 19870, 19875, 19876, 19879 and 19883. These were the only interviews recorded on sheets and all problems recorded have been closed to the satisfaction of the evacuee.



The men in charge of the latter three offices are to mail or deliver the records and reports for their station to Walter W. Hamilton, to be embodied by him in a complete report of the project.

Japanese Evacuees from these centers will go to California. Household goods and motor vehicles will be stored in Portland.

Motor vehicles for storage or sale to the Army will be received by the Federal Reserve Bank only at the point of train or bus embarkation. The Federal Reserve Bank Representative will receive the vehicle at such point and place it in a public garage. The Evacuee is to execute four copies of * F.R.B. Forms 3 and 4; one copy to be delivered to Evacuee and the other three copies, together with documents, to be retained by the F.R.B. Representative, subject to telephone orders of Walter W. Hamilton. Since the Army desires to obtain motor vehicles, please endeavor to have the Evacuee voluntarily sign Option #2. This is not compulsory. Where Evacuees have stored their cars privately, try to show the address of the place of storage and the name of the owner of the property.

Household goods and other personal property for storage with the FRB must be delivered by the Evacuee to some central point (such as JACL Halls) or Trading Centers, where it can readily be picked up by storage vans. The FRB Rep. should ascertain some suitable place to collect such goods for storage and arrange accordingly. Also investigate and ascertain the most suitable and economical manner to transport such goods to permanent storage, such as regular freight lines, private carrier etc., such information to be given to Mr. Hamilton when he telephones.

The War Relocation Authority has requested that Evacuees be advised not to sell their tools and working equipment. The tools in all probability will be used by the Evacuees in the performance of their occupations and professions within a short time. Tools and equipment necessary for the performance of an occupation should be stored with the Federal Reserve Bank or with friends or responsible persons as the Evacuee wishes. Evacuees should be told that it is extremely inadvisable to sell this property inasmuch as tools, medical equipment etc. will be extremely difficult to procure in the near future.

*Mr. Hamilton or someone for the Portland office will sign receipt for vehicles and mail a signed copy to Evacuee.

If, owing to a rush, the exact spelling of the Family Heads Name cannot be conveniently obtained, this can be checked later with the Station Manager before the Station closes. It is advisable anyway to check carefully the Names and Numbers later when there is time to do so, as an exact record is required.

The other headings on the Interview Record Sheet are self explanatory except under disposition, please mention whether or not the case is closed, or any other explanation that might be necessary with regard to storage disposition of property or other notations.

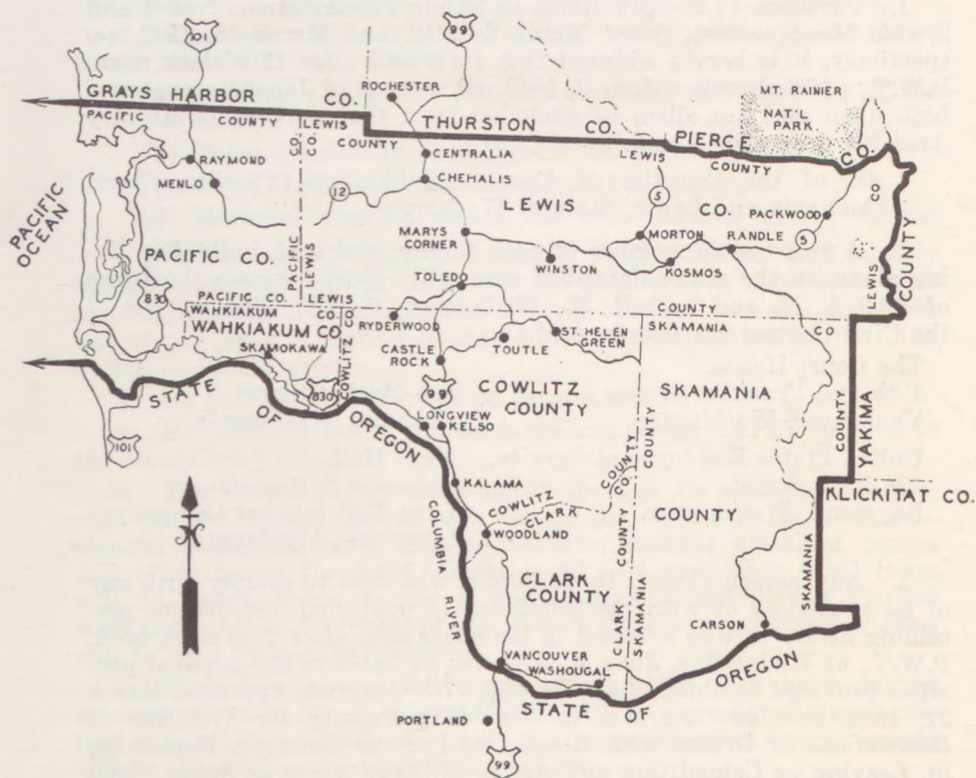

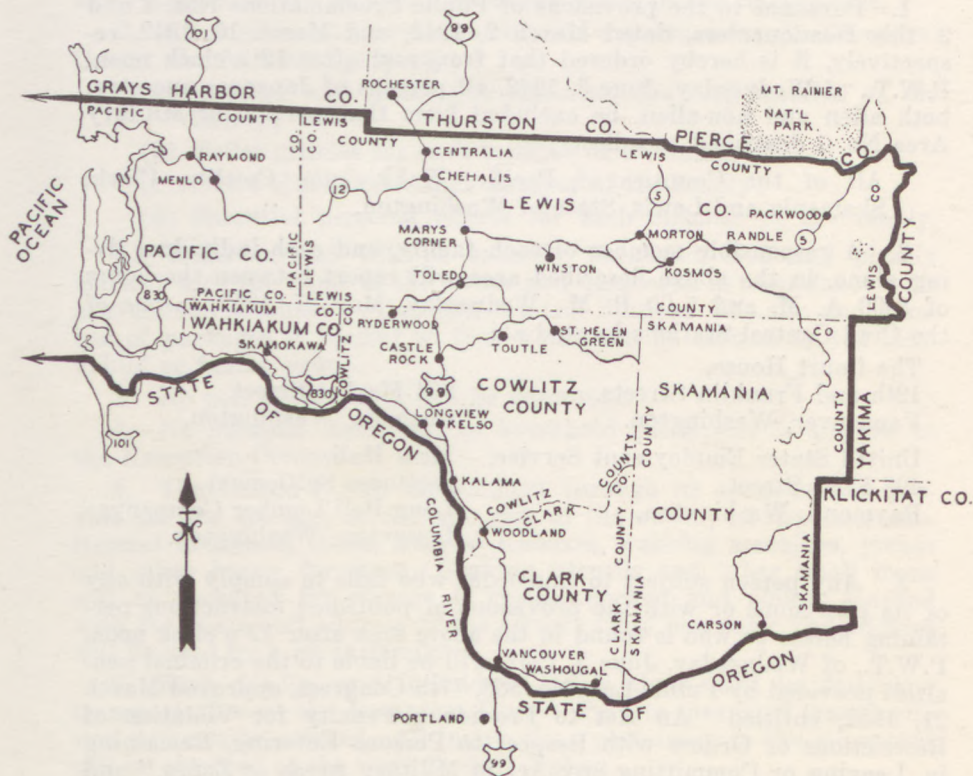


