

No Japanese person will be permitted to move into, or out of, the above area after 5:00 A. M., P.W.T., Saturday, May 23, 1942, without obtaining special permission from the representative of the Commanding General, Northwestern Sector, at one of the Civil Control Stations located at:

Such permits will only be granted for the purpose of uniting members of a family, or in cases of grave emergency.

The Civil Control Stations are equipped to assist the Japanese population affected by this evacuation in the following ways:

- 1. Give advice and instructions on the evacuation.
- 2. Provide services with respect to the management, leasing, sale, storage or other disposition of most kinds of property, such as real estate, business and professional equipment, household goods, boats, automobiles and livestock.
- 3. Provide temporary residence elsewhere for all Japanese in family groups.
- 4. Transport persons and a limited amount of clothing and equipment to their new residence.

THE FOLLOWING INSTRUCTIONS MUST BE OBSERVED:

- 1. A responsible member of each family, preferably the head of the family, or the person in whose name most of the property is held, and each individual living alone, will report to one of the Civil Control Stations to receive further instructions. This must be done between 8:00 A. M. and 5:00 P. M. on Wednesday, May 27, 1942. Should such individual reside over 30 miles from the nearest Civil Control Station and be unable to provide transportation to such Civil Control Station, he will telegraph or telephone on Tuesday, May 26, 1942, to the Manager of the nearest Civil Control Station for instructions.
- 2. Evacuees must carry with them on departure for the Reception Center, the following property:
 - (a) Bedding and liners (no mattress) for each member of the family;
 - (b) Toilet articles for each member of the family;
 - (c) Extra clothing for each member of the family;
 - (d) Essential personal effects for each member of the family.

All items carried will be securely packaged, tied and plainly marked with the name of the owner and numbered in accordance with instructions obtained at the Civil Control Station. The size and number of packages is limited to that which can be carried by the individual or family group.

- 3. No pets of any kind will be permitted.
- 4. No personal items and no household goods will be shipped to the Reception Center.
- 5. The United States Government through its agencies will provide for the storage, at the sole risk of the owner, of the more substantial household items, such as iceboxes, washing machines, pianos and other heavy furniture. Cooking utensils and other small items will be accepted for storage if crated, packed and plainly marked with the name and address of the owner. Only one name and address will be used by a given family.
- 6. Each family, and individual living alone, will be furnished transportation to the Reception Center. Private means of transportation will not be utilized. All instructions pertaining to the movement will be obtained at the Civil Control Station.
- Go to one of the Civil Control Stations between the hours of 8:00 A. M. and 5:00 P. M., Wednesday, May 27, 1942, to receive further instructions.

The legal owner of this property is Ami Kinoshita, Gresham Oregon who is now located at the International Live Stock Fair Grounds and about which case letter of explanation has been mailed to Federal Reserve Bank, Portland Branch. During the period of first Interviews with the Japanese people of this district there was no Farm Security representative at the control office therefore the writer covered all properties including one cranberry farm and several oyster bed holdings which are reported on by interview sheets enclosed. Most of the families having properties for disposal returned at least once and several of them made two or more trips to the control office for interviews on property disposal. Gentlemen: Herewith follows a report on project No. 109, Civilian Exclusion Order No. 88 concerning the office at 804 Market Street Chehalis, Washington, There was a total of nineteen families registered from family No. 19866 to 19884 inclusive totaling fifty-three individuals. Each family was processed and all of their property matters closed during registration on May 27th. Resulting storage from the entire registration consists of thirty-four items. All of these items with the exception of one are ready for pick-up at the Onalaska Depot, Onalaska, Washington. In view of the fact that the greater percentage of Japanese in the Chehalis area were laborers employed at the Carlisle Lumber Company, Onalaska, their property holdings were practically nil. There was, however, one family being family number 19883 and name Nakamura engaged in farming and since they have sold their automobile it seems necessary to pick up the one item stored by them at Rt. 4, Box 104, Chehalis. All in all the entire registration at Chehalis went very smoothly and the writer does not believe that any further storage problems will arise in that area. The Quick Transfer Company of Chehalis has been advised, however to pick up all property tagged with WCCA Form FRB 1 at the Onalaska Depot and to report to the Federal Reserve Bank for the writer in the event that all items do not tally with the listings left with said Quick Transfer Company. The Federal Reserve Bank Representative will receive the vehicle at such point and place it in a pbulic garage. The Evacuee is to execute four copies of * F.R.B. Forms 3 and 4; one copy to be delivered to Evacuee and the other three copies, together with documents, to be retained by the F.R.B. Representative, subject to telephone orders of Walter W. Hamilton. Since the Army desires to obtain motor vehicles, please endeavor to have the Evacuee voluntarily sign Option #2. This is not compulsory. Where Evacuees have stored their cars privately, try to show the address of the place of storage and the name of the owner of the property. Household goods and other personal property for storage with the FRB must be delivered by the Evacuee to some central point (such as JACL Halls) or Trading Centers, where it can readily be picked up by storage vans. The FRB Rep. should ascertain some suitable place to collect such goods for storage and arrange accordingly. Also investigate and ascertain the most suitable and economical manner to transport such goods to permanent storage, such as regular freight lines, private carrier etc., such information to be given to Mr. Hamilton when he telephones. The War Relocation Authority has requested that Evacuees be advised not to sell their tools and working equipment. The tools in all probability will be used by the Evacuees in the performance of their occupations and professions within a short time. Tools and equipment necessary for the performance of an occupation should be stored with the Federal Reserve Bank or with friends or responsible persons as the Evacuee wishes. Evacuees should be told that it is extremely inadvisable to sell this property inasmuch as tools, medical equipment etc. will be extremely difficult to procure in the near future. *Mr. Hamilton or someone for the Portland office will sign receipt for vehicles and mail a signed copy to Evacuee.

MEMORANDUM REGARDING REGISTRATION:

Attached is a sample sheet used as our "Interview Record" in registration of all Evacuees. Since we require a complete list of all Heads of Families, together with their Family Number, please keep a careful check on the registrants and see that they are recorded on this sheet. For convenience sake arrange these lists in numerical order. To do this obtain the numerical series from the StationManager before registration starts and put these Family Numbers down in order on the sheets shead of time. As each Family Head passes through, his number can easily be found and checked off. If, owing to a rush, the exact spelling of the Family Heads Name cannot be conveniently obtained, this can be checked later with the Station Manager before the Station closes. It is advisable anyway to check carefully the Names and Numbers later when there is time to do so, as an exact record is required.

The other headings on the Interview Record Sheet are self explanatory except under disposition, please mention whether or not the case is closed, or any other explanation that might be necessary with regard to storage disposition of property or other notations.




