NEW COUNTERFEIT \$5 FEDERAL RESERVE NOTE.

On the Federal Reserve Bank of New York, N. Y.; series of 1914; W. G. McAdoo, Secretary of the Treasury; John Burke, Treasurer of the United States; portrait of Lincoln; check letter "D;" face plate number indistinct, may be either 55 or 56.

Photomechanical on one piece of paper, ink lines being used to imitate the silk fiber. The plates from which the note is printed measure $3/8$ inch longer than the genuine plates. Number of the specimen seen is B9313900A.
