Stolen Government Checks Recovered

*To all Member Banks, in the Second
Federal Reserve District:*

According to information from the Treasury Department the men who were responsible for the forging and cashing of certain Government checks recently stolen from the Department of Justice at the Federal prison, Leavenworth, Kansas, have been arrested and 130 blank checks in their possession have been recovered. Notice of the theft was sent to you on September 12th in our circular No. 398. The checks were disbursing officer checks, serial numbers 3846-4000, symbol number 32009.

The Secret Service expresses its appreciation in the circular for help given by the banks.
