**New Counterfeit \$50 Gold Certificate**

*To all Banks, Trust Companies and Savings Banks  
in the Second Federal Reserve District:*

The Treasury department in its circular letter No. 540 describes a new counterfeit \$50 Gold Certificate as follows:

“Series of 1913; plate number indistinct, either 13 or 43; Houston B. Tehee, Register of the Treasury; John Burke, Treasurer of the United States; portrait of Grant.

“This counterfeit is apparently printed from very poorly etched plates on genuine paper obtained by bleaching a bill of smaller denominations. The counterfeit is so poor that it hardly warrants a more detailed description.”
