## Appointment of Directors

### *To all Member Banks in the Second Federal Reserve District:*

Supplementing Circular No. 893 of December 1, 1928 announcing the election of Class A and B directors of this bank, the Federal Reserve Board has reappointed GATES W. MCGARRAH as a Class C director of this bank for a term of three years from January 1, 1929, and has redesignated him as Chairman of the Board and Federal Reserve Agent for the year 1929.

The Federal Reserve Board has also redesignated OWEN D. YOUNG as Deputy Chairman of the Board for the year 1929.

The Federal Reserve Board has reappointed EDWARD A. DUERR, chairman of the Community National Bank of Buffalo, as a director of the Buffalo Branch for a term of three years from January 1, 1929.

The board of directors of this bank has appointed JOHN T. SYMES, president of the Niagara County National Bank and Trust Company of Lockport, New York, as a director of the Buffalo Branch for a term of three years from January 1, 1929, to succeed FRANK W. CRANDALL, president of the National Bank of Westfield, New York, whose term expired on December 31, 1928.

RAND, president of the Marine Trust Company of Buffalo, as a director of the Buffalo Branch to fill the unexpired term ending December 31, 1930, of ELLIOTT C.
