Shipments of Paper Currency

New Small-Size To Be Separated From Old Large-Size Notes

To all Banks and Trust Companies in the Second Federal Reserve District:

In order to facilitate the handling of the two sizes of currency now in circulation, you are requested, in making shipments to this bank, to separate the new small-size from the old large-size currency, according to denominations. Not more than one hundred notes of either size should be enclosed in one strap.

Your cooperation in this matter will be greatly appreciated.
