A general license is hereby granted authorizing banking institutions within the United States to make all payments, transfers and withdrawals from accounts in the name of any of the following: Javasche Bank, Nederlandsche Handelmaatschappij, Nederlandsch Indische Handelsbank and Nederlandschindische Escompto Maatschappij.

Banking institutions within the United States making such payments, transfers, or withdrawals shall file promptly with the appropriate Federal Reserve bank weekly reports showing the details of the transactions during such period.
