To all Banking Institutions, and Others Concerned, in the Second Federal Reserve District:

Reference is made to this bank's Circular No. 2347 dated December 31, 1941, transmitting a copy of Treasury Department Circular No. 674 dated December 15, 1941, relating to Treasury Notes of Tax Series A-1944 and Treasury Notes of Tax Series B-1944.

Section IV "Presentation in Payment of Taxes" of Treasury Department Circular No. 674 reads, in part, as follows:

"1. During and after the third calendar month from month of purchase . . . notes issued hereunder . . . will be receivable by the Collector (of Internal Revenue) . . . in payment of any Federal income taxes . . . or any Federal estate or gift taxes . . . assessed against the original purchaser or his estate . . . "

The Treasury Department has advised this bank that the month of purchase may not be considered as one of the three calendar months, for the purpose of computing when Treasury Notes of Tax Series A-1944 and Treasury Notes of Tax Series B-1944 will first be receivable in payment of taxes, in accordance with the provisions of Section IV quoted above; for example, notes purchased at any time during January, 1942, will not be receivable in payment of taxes until on or after April 1, 1942.
