For your information we quote below the text of Revocation of General Ruling No. 6A, dated September 3, 1943, issued by the Treasury Department:

REVOCATION OF GENERAL RULING NO. 6A UNDER EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 8389, AS AMENDED, EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 9193, SECTIONS 3(a) AND 5(b) OF THE TRADING WITH THE ENEMY ACT, AS AMENDED BY THE FIRST WAR POWERS ACT, 1941, RELATING TO FOREIGN FUNDS CONTROL.\*

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General Ruling No. 6A, issued March 13, 1942, is hereby revoked.

Any United States or foreign currency to which General Ruling No. 6A was applicable prior to this revocation shall continue to be subject to the provisions of General Ruling No. 5, as amended.
