UNITED STATES WAR SAVINGS BONDS, SERIES E  
Symbol Required on Special Penalty Envelopes Used by Issuing Agents

*To All Issuing Agents in the Second Federal Reserve District  
Qualified for Sale of United States War Savings Bonds, Series E:*

The Post Office Department has issued instructions to the effect that all special penalty envelopes used by issuing agents on and after July 1, 1945, must bear the identifying symbol "PMGC" in parentheses centered beneath the words "Penalty for Private Use to Avoid Payment of Postage, \$300". All special penalty envelopes furnished by us to issuing agents during the last several months bear this symbol.

In the event you should have on hand on July 1, 1945, any special penalty envelopes which do not bear the symbol "PMGC", you should endorse such envelopes by rubber stamp or otherwise so that the symbol will appear in parentheses directly beneath the penalty clause.
