Results of Election of Directors

To Member Banks in the Second Federal Reserve District:

The election of directors to succeed BURR P. CLEVELAND, class A director, and LANSING P. SHIELD, class B director, whose terms expire December 31, 1953, has been duly held in accordance with the requirements of section 4 of the Federal Reserve Act, as amended, and the provisions of Circular No. 4020, dated September 24, 1953.

The results of the election are as follows:

JOHN R. EVANS, President, The First National Bank of Poughkeepsie, Poughkeepsie, N. Y., was elected by member banks in Group 2 as a class A director of this Bank; and LANSING P. SHIELD, President, The Grand Union Company, East Paterson, N. J., was reelected by member banks in Group 2 as a class B director of this Bank. Each was chosen for a term of three years beginning January 1, 1954.
