The following statement was made public today:

The Treasury Department today announced the subscription and allotment figures with respect to the current cash offering of \$2,250 million of 3% percent Treasury Certificates of Indebtedness of Series A-1958, and \$750 million of 3½ percent Treasury Notes of Series A-1960. Both issues are dated February 15, 1957, with interest from March 28. The certificates will mature February 14, 1958, and the notes on May 15, 1960.
