## Results of Election of Directors

*To Member Banks in the Second Federal Reserve District:*

The election of directors to succeed FERD. I. COLLINS, class A director, and AUGUSTUS C. LONG, class B director, whose terms expire December 31, 1957, has been duly held in accordance with the requirements of section 4 of the Federal Reserve Act, as amended, and the provisions of Circular No. 4509, dated September 24, 1957.

The results of the election are as follows:

CYRUS M. HIGLEY, President and Trust Officer, The Chenango County National Bank and Trust Company of Norwich, Norwich, New York, was elected by member banks in Group 3 as a class A director of this Bank; and AUGUSTUS C. LONG, Chairman, Board of Directors, The Texas Company, New York, New York, was re-elected by member banks in Group 3 as a class B director of this Bank. Each was chosen for a term of three years beginning January 1, 1958.
