**Appointment of Directors**

*To Member Banks in the Second Federal Reserve District :*

The Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System has appointed JAMES DECAMP WISE a Class C director of the Federal Reserve Bank of New York for the unexpired portion of the term ending December 31, 1961. Mr. Wise is Chairman of the Board of the Bigelow-Sanford Carpet Company, New York City.
