The Comptroller of the Currency has advised us that a certificate of authority to commence business has been issued to SUBURBAN BANK OF LIVINGSTON, NATIONAL ASSOCIATION, Livingston, N. J., effective September 6, 1966. This bank converted from a nonmember State bank to a national bank and, by virtue of its being a national bank, has become a member of the Federal Reserve System. The capital of the bank is \$440,000 and its surplus, \$350,000.
