Effective Date Postponed for Book-Entry Treasury Securities

*To All Banking Institutions, and Others Concerned,
in the Second Federal Reserve District:*

In our Circular No. 6022, dated August 21, 1967, we informed you of a notice of proposed rule making issued by the Treasury Department providing for the issuance of transferable Treasury securities in the form of "book entries," as well as in definitive (i.e., physical) form as at present.

We indicated in that circular that the earliest effective date of the book-entry procedure would be October 2. This date has been postponed while the Treasury Department considers comments received on the proposed changes. We will advise you when a new effective date has been established.
