Results of Bidding for TVA Power Notes

To Certain Commercial Banks, Trust Companies,  
and Dealers in Investment Securities:

The following statement was authorized by the Tennessee Valley Authority for issuance today, announcing the auction results of its recent offering of Power Notes:

The Tennessee Valley Authority sold at auction today \$120 million par value of 126-day discount notes at an average price of 97.754, which results in a rate of discount of 6.417 percent per annum on a 360-day basis. The notes are dated September 24, 1970 and mature on January 28, 1971.

Accepted bids ranged from a high price of 97.778 (6.349 percent discount) to a low of 97.733 (6.477 percent discount). Twenty-two percent of the total amount bid for at the low price was accepted. Total bids received were \$620 million, of which \$120 million were accepted.
