Results of Bidding for TVA Power Notes

To Certain Commercial Banks, Trust Companies, and Dealers in Investment Securities:

The following statement was authorized by the Tennessee Valley Authority for issuance today, announcing the auction results of its recent offering of Power Notes:

The Tennessee Valley Authority sold at auction today \$110 million par value of 119-day discount notes at an average price of 98.761, which results in a rate of discount of 3.748 percent per annum on a 360-day basis. The notes are dated January 27, 1972 and mature on May 25, 1972.

Accepted bids ranged from a high price of 98.787 (3.670 percent discount) to a low of 98.753 (3.772 percent discount). Sixty-four percent of the total amount bid for at the low price was accepted. Total bids received were \$726 million, of which \$110 million were accepted.
