FRAUDULENT PRESENTMENT OF TREASURY CHECK

*To All Banking Institutions
in the Second Federal Reserve District:*

The Federal Reserve Bank of Atlanta has announced that there is a possibility that a \$500,000 Treasury check--symbol number 4872--may be presented by an imposter. Following is the text of the Atlanta Reserve Bank's notice:

This is to advise you of the possibility of a \$500,000 Treasury check being presented by an imposter, under an unauthorized endorsement. Payment of the check has been ordered stopped. A description of the check is as follows:

Check Number	-	226,388
Date	-	December 5, 1974
Payee	-	F. Railsback 1908 Morningside Street Jacksonville, Florida 32205
Amount	-	\$500,000

Presentation of the Treasury check should be immediately reported to the nearest office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation and advise that office to contact the FBI in Jacksonville (their file number 29-1284) or the FBI in Atlanta (their file number 29-2136).
