STOLEN TREASURY CHECKS

*To All Banking Institutions
in the Second Federal Reserve District:*

Following is the text of a notice issued by the Federal Reserve Bank of Cleveland:

We have been informed by the U.S. Secret Service that 218 blank Treasury checks have been reported stolen from the Navy Finance Center in Cleveland.

The checks can be identified by a symbol number 5178 and serial numbers in the range 67,439,015 through 67,439,232. The checks contained no names, dollar amounts, signatures or issue dates.

This information is being provided so that you may be aware of the existence of these checks in the banking community. Appearance of any of the checks at your banks should be immediately reported to the nearest office of the U.S. Secret Service.

We would appreciate your cooperation in this matter.
