DEPOSITS OF CASH ITEMS AT THE HEAD OFFICE OF THIS BANK

To All Member Banks in the Head Office Territory of the Second Federal Reserve District, and Others Concerned:

Incident to the relocation of our New York City Check Processing Department to 99 William Street on Tuesday, August 26, 1980, the deposit location for various categories of cash-item deposits will be:

- I. Items to be delivered to the Federal Reserve Post Office Station at 33 Liberty Street, 5th floor.
- —Immediate-credit city items and deferred-credit country and interdistrict items. Such items are to be separately packaged and all packages placed in one bag, whenever possible, clearly labeled "HEAD OFFICE PROCESSING."
- —Treasury checks—for banks that currently sort, separately package, and deliver to the Check Processing Department—clearly labeled "TREASURY CHECKS."
- —Postal Money Orders (PMOs)—for banks that currently sort, separately package, and deliver to the Check Processing Department—clearly labeled "PMOs."
- —RCPC items accepted for transshipment to our Cranford, Jericho, or Utica Office, separately packaged for each Office and clearly labeled "CHECK PROCESSING" followed by the name of the RCPC.
 - -All items accepted for Consolidated Shipment.
 - II. Items to be delivered to the Check Processing Department at 99 William Street (Home Insurance Building), 10th floor.
- —All deposits of Manhattan, Bronx, and Brooklyn Collection Arrangement (MB&B) items, Thrift Institutions Collection Arrangement (TICA) items, and return items currently delivered to the Check Processing Department at 33 Liberty Street, 4th floor.
 - —Disbursing Officer Certificates of Deposit (CDs).
