To All Banking Institutions, and Others Concerned, in the Second Federal Reserve District:

Banking institutions in Connecticut and New Jersey will be closed on Friday, January 15, 1982 (Martin Luther King's Birthday). Accordingly, cash items and noncash items that are payable by, at, or through institutions in these States and that would otherwise be presented by this Bank on that day will be presented on the next business day, Monday, January 18, 1982. Corresponding delays will also occur in the return of unpaid items and in the forwarding of advices of nonpayment of such items.

Credit for cash items drawn on banking institutions in New Jersey served by our Cranford Office that are received at our Head Office after 12 noon on Thursday, January 14, will be given on Monday, January 18. There will be no change in the usual availability of credit granted for any other cash items deposited at the Head Office of this Bank.
